This letter is a response to a request from the Agency for more information regarding our Notification to add "optional marketing phrases" to the label of the above registration.

The Agency's questions center on the addition of the phrases:

-Reorder information: -Company name and Address -Phone Number -Website address

There seems to be a question as to the purpose of these phrases.

Spartan sells product through distributors. These distributors are independent companies which sell products from many manufacturers. Our distributors sell <u>Spartan brand</u> products to the end user.... <u>not supplemental registrations</u>.

The added phrases above are designed to allow the addition of a "Reorder Section" to the label which tells the end user where he or she can buy the product when it is time to reorder. The website address in this "reorder" section would be the website of the distributor.... and would change with each distributor.

What we are envisioning is a text box on the lid of the carton. The text inside the box would say something like:
