### X. TÍNH TỪ ĐI VỚI GIỚI TỪ

1. Adj + to

• acceptable to: có thể chấp nhận.

Ex: Is this opposal acceptable to you?

• accustomed to: quen.

Hay dùng: get accustomed to.

Ex: I soon got accumtomed to his stange ways.

• agreeable to: có thể đồng ý, thích hợp với.

Ex: He said the terms were not agreeable to him.

• applicable to: có thể ứng dụng.

Ex: "It is not safe to infer that the results of experiments on animals will be applicable to human beings," I said.

• appropriate to: thích hợp.

Ex: It's necessary for the homicide to incur a punishment appropriate to his cruelties.

• addicted to st: say mê cái gì, nghiện.

Ex: Children are often addicted to fairy stories.

• bad to st: có hại cho, không tốt cho.

Ex: Staying up late is bad to us.

• contrary to: trái với.

Ex: Contrary to his expectations, he found the atmosphere exciting.

• clear to: rõ ràng.

Ex: You could see clear to the bottom of the lagoon.

• close to: gần.

Ex: He spent close to 30 years in jail.

• dedicated/devoted to: hiến dâng, tận tụy.

Ex: I am dedicated to making this world a better place.

She is devoted to her job.

• engaged to: đính hôn.

Ex: She was engaged to a lecturer.

• equal to: đủ sức, đủ khả năng.

Ex: I just don't feel equal to the challenge that I'm facing now.

• essential to/for: cần thiết.

Ex: Food is essential to/for life.

• harmful to: có hại.

Ex: Smoking is harmful to health.

• **faithful to = loyal to**: trung thành.

Ex: He remained faithful to the ideals of the party.

These brave soldiers are always loyal to their ideal.

• grateful/thankful to sb for st: biết on ai.

Ex: I'm grateful/thankful to you for all your help.

• important to sb: quan trọng đối với ai.

Ex: It's important to me that you should be there.

• indifferent to: thờ ơ, lãnh đạm.

Ex: The government cannot afford to be indifferent to public opinion.

• kind to sb: tử tế với ai.

Ex: He was very kind to me when the children were ill.

• likely to: có khả năng/có thể thích hợp.

Ex: He is not likely to come now.

• married to: kết hôn.

Ex: Ali is married to Salma.

• necessary to:cần thiết, thiết yếu.

Ex: Sleeping is necessary to health.

• open to: cởi mở.

Ex: The system is open to abuse.

• opposed to: bất đồng.

Ex: He was bitterly opposed to the war.

• polite to: lịch sự.

Ex: You must be more polite to the customers.

• related to: liên quan đến.

Ex: He was related to that crime.

• responsible to sb:chiu trách nhiệm với ai.

Ex: The head of state is responsible to his people and must obey the law.

• similar to: tuong ty.

Ex: Your hat is similar to mine.

• sensitive to/about: nhay cam.

Ex: She is very sensitive to other people's feelings.

• used to: quen với.

Ex: I'm used to getting up early.

2. Adj + of

• afraid of: sợ hãi.

Ex: Are you afraid of snakes?

• ashamed of: xấu hổ, bối rối.

Ex: She was deeply ashamed of her behaviour at the party.

• aware of: nhận thức về cái gì >< unaware of.

Ex: He was well aware of the problem.

• capable of: có khả năng về cái gì.

Ex: He is capable of anything if it furthers his ambition.

• careful of/with/about sth: can than.

Ex: He was very careful of his reputation.

• certain of/about: chắc chắn về cái gì.

Ex: You don't seem too certain of it.

• characteristic of: đặc trưng cho tính cách của ai đó hoặc của vật nào đó.

Ex: Enthusiasm is characteristic of him.

• conscious of: nhận thức, chú ý đến.

Ex: She's very conscious of the problems involved.

• desirous of: khao khát.

Ex: The Pope was desirous of peace in Europe.

• doubtful of/about: nghi ngò.

Ex: I was doubtful of my judgement.

• envious of: ghen ti = jealous of.

Ex: He was envious of the local boys who could see her every day.

Other girls were jealous of her good looks.

• fond of: wa thích.

Ex: I'm fond of cooking.

• frightened of: sợ hãi.

Ex: I've always been frightened of snakes.

• full of: đầy.

Ex: The bin needs emptying, it's full of rubbish.

• guilty of: cảm thấy có lỗi, hối lỗi.

Ex: She was guilty of a serious error of judgement.

• hopeful of/about : hi vong.

Ex: She is hopeful of returning to work soon.

• incapable of: không có khả năng.

Ex: Professors who seem incapable of any original thought.

• innocent of: ngây thơ, vô tội.

Ex: She was found innocent of any crime.

• independent of: độc lập.

Ex: The study is totally independent of central government.

• nervous of/about: lo lắng.

Ex: He's always been a little nervous of speaking in public.

• proud of: tự hào về.

Ex: They are proud of their daughter.

• respectful of/for : lễ phép, tôn trọng.

Ex: I'm respectful of your opinion.

• **be/get** + **rid of**: tống khứ.

Ex: We got rid of all the old furniture.

• sick of: chán ngấy.

Ex: I'm sick of waiting around like this.

• scared of: sơ hãi.

Ex: All small children are scared of ghost.

• sure of: chắc chắn.

Ex: I'm not sure of the results.

• suspicious of/about: nghi ngò.

Ex: He was suspicious of/about her motives.

• tired of: chán vì cái gì.

Ex: I am tired of studying all the time.

• terrified of: cảm thấy khiếp sợ.

Ex: I'm terrified of spiders.

• typical of: điển hình.

Ex: This meal is typical of local cookery.

• unaware of: không nhận thức được.

Ex: He was unaware of my presence.

3. Adj + for

• anxious for sb about st: lo lắng.

Ex: Parents are naturally anxious for their children.

• appreciated for: được đánh giá cao.

Ex: I was appreciated for my help.

• available: có sẵn, sẵn sàng.

Ex: The Prime Minister was not available for comment.

• bad for st: có hai cho.

Ex: Staying up late is bad for our health.

• convenient for: thuân tiên, thuân lơi.

Ex: Will it be convenient for you to start work tomorrow?

• difficult for: khó.

Ex: The questions are too difficult for the children.

• eager for: hào hứng.

Ex: I am eager for my next trip.

• eligible for: đủ điều kiện.

Ex: Only those over 70 are eligible for the special payment.

• enough for: đủ.

Ex: Have we got enough sandwiches for lunch?

• important for: quan trọng cho.

Ex: Oxygen is important for our lives.

• famous for: nổi tiếng.

Ex: Hanoi is famous for "pho".

• grateful/thankful for s.th: biết ơn.

Ex: I was grateful for the light so I could see.

I hold my babies tight and I am thankful for every moment I have with them.

• late for: muôn.

Ex: He was ten minutes late for school.

• necessary for: cần thiết.

Ex: She hasn't the experience necessary for the job.

• perfect for: hoàn hảo.

Ex: It was my favorite little black dress that I thought would be absolutely perfect for my date with Rick.

• prepared for st: chuẩn bị.

Ex: The troops were being prepared for battle.

• qualified for: đủ điều kiện, đủ khả năng.

Ex: He is qualified for this dangerous mission.

• responsible for st/ving: có trách nhiệm.

Ex: You must be responsible for paying these bills.

• ready for: sẵn sang.

Ex: I'm ready for the exam.

• sorry for st/V.ing: lấy làm tiếc, hối hân.

Ex: Aren't you sorry for what you've done?

• suitable for: thích hợp.

Ex: This programme is not suitable for children.

• sufficent for: đầy đủ.

Ex: He had a small private income which was sufficient for her needs.

#### 4. Adj + at

• amazed/astonished + at/by : ngac nhiên.

Ex: My parents looked astonished at my news.

• amused at/by: ngạc nhiên, thích thú.

Ex: Everyone is amused at/by the clown's comic gestures.

• angry at/about st: tức giận.

Ex: I was very angry at how rainy it was.

• annoyed at/about st: bực mình cái gì.

Ex: He was beginning to get very annoyed at/about my carelessness.

• bad at: không giỏi về, dốt.

Ex: I'm bad at Maths.

• clever at: thông minh.

Ex: She's clever at getting what she wants.

• delighted at/by/with: vui ve, hai long.

Ex: She was delighted by/at the news of the wedding.

• excellent at: xuất sắc.

Ex: My teacher is excellent at English.

• furious at: giận dữ, điên tiết.

Ex: They were furious at not being invited to the party.

• good at: giỏi.

Ex: I'm good at English.

• hopeless at: không còn hy vọng, vô vọng.

Ex: I'm hopeless at science.

I am hopeless at paying my bills on time.

• lucky at: may mắn cho cái gì.

Ex: I'm lucky at winning this trip.

• proficient in/at: thành thạo.

Ex: I was proficient at my job.

• quick at: nhanh.

Ex: He is quick at solving mathematical problems.

• slow at: châm.

Ex: She is frequently slow at making up her mind.

• shocked at/by: sốc.

Ex: I was shocked at the news of her death.

• skillful at: khéo tay, tài giỏi.

Ex: He is skillful at inventing excuses.

• surprised at/by: ngạc nhiên.

Ex: We were surprised at your behavior.

#### 5. Adj + with

• acquainted with : quen với cái gì. (Hay dùng: get acquainted with)

Ex: The students are already acquainted with the work of Shakespeare.

• associated with: cộng tác với, liên quan tới.

Ex: He no longer wished to be associated with the party's policy on education.

• annoyed with sb at/about st: khó chiu.

Ex: Kelly was annoyed with him.

• bored with = fed up with: chán.

Ex: I'm bored with my job.

In the end, I just got fed up with his constant complaining.

• busy with sth/doing st (hoặc busy doing sth).

Ex: Irina and Marcus were busy with preparations for their wedding.

• content with : bằng lòng với cái gì.

Ex: She seemed quite content with her results.

• careful with/about/of sth: can than.

Ex: Please be careful with my glasses.

• connected with: kết nối với, liên hê với.

Ex: The fall in retail sales is directly connected with the decline in employment.

• crowded with sth = packed with: đông đúc, đầy.

Ex: a room crowded with books.

• disappointed with/at/by/in : thất vọng.

Ex: I was very disappointed with myself.

• dissatisfied with: không hài lòng.

Ex: He has been very dissatisfied with his life in recent months.

• delighted at/by/with: vui ve, hai long.

Ex: I was delighted with my presents.

• familiar with: quen thuộc.

Ex: He is familiar with me.

• friendly with: thân thiện.

Ex: I am very friendly with the people.

• generous with: rộng rãi, rộng lượng.

Ex: To be generous with your time.

• gentle with: lịch thiệp.

Ex: He is gentle with women and children.

• involved with: liên quan đến.

Ex: Angela told me she was involved with someone else.

• pleased with: hài lòng với.

Ex: It took a long time to complete the work, but I'm very pleased with the results.

• patient with: nhẫn nại.

Ex: Susan's very patient with the children.

• popular with: được yêu thích bởi số đông.

Ex: These policies are unlikely to prove popular with middle-class voters.

• satisfied with: hài lòng với.

Ex: He felt satisfied with his job.

• troubled with: bồn chồn, lo lắng.

Ex: Don't be troubled with that.

• wrong with: sai về.

Ex: There's something wrong with the printer.

6. Adj + in

• disappointed at/by/with/in : thất vọng.

Ex: I'm disappointed in you. I really thought I could trust you!

• experienced in: có kinh nghiệm về cái gì.

Ex: He's very experienced in looking after animals.

• honest in: trung thực.

Ex: Always be honest in whatever you do.

• involved in: liên quan đến; dành nhiều thời gian, sự chú ý.

Ex: We need to examine all the costs involved in the project first.

I was so involved in my book I didn't hear you knock.

• interested in: quan tâm, thích thú.

Ex: I'm interested in football.

• proficient in/at: thành thạo.

Ex: She felt reasonably proficient in Italian.

• rich in: giàu.

Ex: Many vegetables and fruits are rich in vitamins.

• successful in: thành công.

Ex: Finally, they were successful in putting out the fire.

• weak in: kém về.

Ex: He is the student who is weak in algebra.

7. Adj + from

• absent from: vắng mặt.

Ex: Most pupils were absent from school at least once.

• derived from: bắt nguồn từ cái gì.

Ex: In fact the word "fiction" is derived from the Greek "fictus", which means to shape.

• different from: khác.

Ex: Their tastes are different from mine.

• distinct from : khác biệt.

Ex: Man is distinct from animals.

• free of/from: không chứa hoặc không bị ảnh hưởng bởi thứ gì đó độc hại, không tốt

Ex: free from difficulty/doubt/fear.

free from artificial colours and flavourings.

• far from: cách xa.

Ex: My house is far from my school.

• isolated from = separate from: tách biệt.

Ex: He was isolated from all the other prisoners.

Criticism of one can and should be kept entirely separate from the other.

#### 8. Adj + about

• anxious about sth/for sb: lo lắng.

Ex: He seemed anxious about the meeting.

• confused about: bối rối, nhầm lẫn.

Ex: She was utterly confused about what had happened.

• careful with/about/of sth: can than.

Ex: I'm very careful about washing my hands before eating.

• concerned about sth: quan tâm về cái gì.

Ex: The President is deeply concerned about this issue.

• crazy about: điện cuồng vì cái gì.

Ex: It's pretty obvious he's crazy about you.

• certain about/of: chắc chắn về cái gì.

Ex: You don't seem too certain about it.

• curious about: tò mò, hiếu kỳ.

Ex: She was curious about what had happened.

• doubtful about: hoài nghi, không chắc chắn.

Ex: Rosy was doubtful about the whole idea.

• excited about: có hứng thú với.

Ex: I'm very excited about the news.

• enthusiastic about: hứng thú.

Ex: You don't sound very enthusiastic about the idea.

• glad about: vui mừng.

Ex: She wasn't going to leave, and he was glad about that.

• happy about/with: hạnh phúc, hài lòng.

Ex: If there's anything you're not happy about, come and ask.

• hopeful of/about: hi vong.

Ex: He is not very hopeful about the outcome of the interview.

• nervous of/about: lo lắng.

Ex: She was nervous about walking home so late.

• optimistic about: lac quan >< pessimistic.

Ex: Peter is not optimstic about the outcome.

Doctors are pessimistic about his chances of making a full recovery.

• serious about: nghiêm trọng, nghiêm túc.

Ex: I'm serious about my work.

• suspicious of/about: nghi ngò.

Ex: I'm always suspicious about his kindness.

• upset about: buồn về.

Ex: I was upset about losing my money.

• worried about: lo lắng.

Ex: He is always worried about his wife.

## 9. Adj + on

• based on: dựa trên cái gì.

Ex: This novel is based on a real story.

• dependent on: phụ thuộc vào, dựa vào..

EX: Success is dependent on how hard you work

• keen on: thích thú.

Ex: The kids are mad keen on computer games at the moment.
