## 5 Tab Book

Cut the strips along the solid outer lines. If there is a rectangle piece in the right corner of the strip, cut it off as indicated ("remove this area"). Stack your strips in order with cover on top and staple where indicated.

Cut cover and pages out on solid lines. Stack pages together with cover on top and staple on the left side.

## Square Petal



You are looking at the inside of the book. Cut shape out as one piece. Fold flaps in using the dotted lines as your guide. Tuck the last flap under so that book will stay closed.

## Hexagon Petal



Cut shape out as one piece. Write one fact on each petal. Fold flaps in using the dotted lines as your guide. Tuck the last flap under so that book will stay closed.

## Triangle Petal Large

Cut shape out as one piece. Write one fact on each petal. Fold flaps in using the dotted lines as your guide. Tuck the last flap under so that book will stay closed.

You will only be able to type on the center portion of this book. You will have to write or add pictures to the petals.


## Triangle Petal Small

Cut shape out as one piece. Fold flaps in using the dotted lines as your guide. Tuck the last flap under so that book will stay closed.

You will only be able to type on the center portion of this book. You will have to write or add pictures to the petals.


## Pentagon Petal



Cut shape out as one piece. Write one fact on each petal. Fold flaps in using the dotted lines as your guide. Tuck the last flap under so that book will stay closed.

You will only be able to type on the center portion of this book. You will have to write or add pictures to the petals.

## Pop-Up Book

## Print next two pages on cardstock.

This is a pop-up book. First, print book on cardstock. Mountain fold the book in half on the dotted line. Snip the two solid lines. Fold that flap down towards you on the dotted line.

Now, valley fold the book in half, on the dotted line, popping the box to the inside of the book.

Cut out the small rectangle on the next page and paste or draw a picture on it.

On the box marked "glue" glue the item you want to pop-up sitting level with the paper. Make sure it lies flat when closing the book.



Write a title on this page and glue it on as a cover.

## Folder Pocket

Cut on solid lines. Fold in half on the dotted line. Fold bottom tab and glue down. Fold side tab and glue down. Use the cards on the next page, if desired.

## Pocket (fits $4 \times 6$ cards)

Cut pocket out as one piece. Fold back up. Wrap flaps around the back and glue down.


## Small Side Pocket

Cut pocket out as one piece. Fold flap on right side under. Fold top and bottom flaps under. Glue the back of the pocket to your lapbook. Store cards (found on next page) in pocket.

## Small Pocket

Cut pocket out. Fold back flap up and wrap side flaps around the back and glue down. Glue the back of your pocket into your lapbook.

## Small Trifold (vertical)

Cut on solid lines. Fold (like a pamphlet) on dotted lines.

## Hexagon Trifold

Cut book out on solid black lines. Fold in thirds on dotted lines.

## Large Hexagon Accordion

Cut out shapes on solid black lines. Fold on dotted lines like an accordion (back and forth). Glue back of last piece to your lapbook.

## Accordion in My Pocket

Instructions on next page. You can't type on this page (only on the next).

Cut the strip (to the left) out as one piece. Fold up like an accordion.

Cut the envelope (on previous page) out as one piece. Cut the slit (dotted lines) with an exact-o knife). Fold sides in. Fold bottom up and fold top down and tuck in to flap. Open envelope. Glue the back of the last piece of the accordion to the inside of the envelope.


PRINT ON CARDSTOCK. Cut each piece out on the solid black lines.
Attach with brass fastener where indicated.

Flag Fan
PRINT ON CARDSTOCK. Cut each piece out on the solid black lines. There will be five pieces in all. Attach with brass fastener where indicated.


## Hexagon Fan

## Four Flap (Horizontal)

Cut out book as one piece. Fold left side in. Fold right side in. Open book. Cut on dotted line to form four flaps. Refold book.

## Small Five Flap (Vertical)

Cut out book as one piece. Fold left side under. Fold right side under (it is the cover). Unfold book. Cut on the lines to form five flaps.

## Large Five Flap (Vertical)

Cut out book as one piece. Fold left side under. Fold right side under (it is the cover). Unfold book. Cut on the lines to form five flaps.


## Six Flap (Vertical)



Cut out book as one piece. Fold left side in. Fold right side in. Open book. Cut on dotted lines to form six flaps. Refold book.

## Seven Flap (Vertical)

Cut on solid lines. Fold on dotted lines (like a pamphlet).


Shutterfold Cut on solid lines. Fold on dotted. www.h $\Theta$ mesch $\odot \odot$ lshare.c $\odot m$


## Shuttertied Horizontal

Print onto card stock and cut out. Punch holes where indicated. Fold on dotted lines. To secure book, string a ribbon through the holes and tie with a bow on the front.

This will be the top of your book.


Shuttertied Vertical


## Folded Shutterfold

Cut book out as one piece. Fold right side under. Fold left side under. Unfold and cut on dotted lines. Refold. Fold book in half so that "Dialect" is on the front cover.

## Shutteriold Three Areas

Cut along solid lines. Fold top flap under. Fold bottom flap under. Unfold bottom and cut on solid line to form two flaps.


Shutterflap Six Areas cut on solid lines. Fold on dotted.


## Three Circle Book

Cut out the three circles. Fold each one in half.

Glue the back of the left half of the first circle to the front of the left half of the second circle.

Take the third circle. Glue the back of the left half of the third circle to the back of the right half of the first circle. Fold so that you can open the book once to the right and once to the left. So, the "middle section" is actually the front of your book.

This is a good book to use when you have two answers to a question or two possible outcomes.

## Three Triangle Book

Cut out the three triangles. Fold each one in half.

Glue the back of the left half of the first triangle to the front of the left half of the second triangle.

Take the third triangle. Glue the back of the left half of the third triangle to the back of the right half of the first triangle. Fold so that you can open the book once to the right and once to the left. So, the "middle section" is actually the front of your book.
