





#### What is the Meaning of Life? - Discover Christ

We just finished one of our ChristLife series and as you can see by the smiling faces of our participants (*see photo to the right*), the Zoom format is working very well. It is time effective and gives options for everyone to be able to participate in the comfort of their own home.

We would like to offer Discovering Christ this April! Discovering Christ, the first part of the ChristLife series, is open to people of all denominations or no faith at all. Each week you will watch a 30-minute online video at home prior to the Zoom meeting. Once in our Zoom meeting we will break into small discussion groups to answer questions about the information you heard and how you felt about it. You will stay in the same group each week. Everyone's opinion is respected.



Some comments from people who have attended: "No one wanted it to end, no one wanted to leave their group, everyone wanted the course to go on!" and "the videos were outstanding."

The program runs for seven weeks with a retreat. Try it for three weeks and see what you think! 
#### Easter Sunday

It may not be a theological connection, but it certainly was one we experienced as the joy and happiness of Easter replaced the solemnity of Lent.

One way we can celebrate is practice a little renewal in our own lives. Lent ends, but the results of our sacrifice and penance should remain. We share in the Lord's victory over sin and death in small ways, conquering our own faults and failings with God's grace. "I AM the way, the truth and the life." —John 14:6


**Reflection:** Jesus is the WAY, because He is the TRUTH and LIFE. The Son of God came into the world to destroy the works of the devil, and as John


