General Rules For All Racing Classes

- Entries must be be Buick powered.
- When having the track personnel tech your car, with the car number, please add the race class you plan to qualify for.
- Saturday's choices include BCO, Ladies Race, TSM or blank for Test & Tune.
- Sunday's choices are B1, B2, TSO, Quick 16 for V6 & V8, blank for test & Tune or one of the tracks classes.
- Display the *number from the daily tech card*. You will need to go through tech inspection each day.
- It is your responsibility to comply with appropriate Safety Rules.
- Your car will be tech inspected for how fast you say it runs. Running quicker will be frowned upon.
- Competitors in the same class may report any rule violation to the class Director.
- Due to track constraints, you may receive limited time trial runs on Sunday prior to elimination runs.
- A full 0.50 second tree will be used for bracket racing and a 0.40 second Pro-tree for heads ups.
- Delay box use is up to the other racers in the class.
- Line locks and/or transmission locks are allowed except as noted in the specific class race.
- Staging lanes may close 15 minutes after a class is called.
- All winnings must be picked up before track closing on Sunday.

Quick 16 Rules

- Quick 16 races will be bracket racing events.
- Cars must comply with safety rules or be disqualified.
- Racers must register by 12:00 noon Saturday.
- The \$50.00 entry fee is non-refundable.
- Quick 16 cars may use their lowest ET (on a time slip) to qualify.
- Nitrous will be allowed in the Quick 16s.

Racing Payouts

- The 11th Annual Midwest Buick Challenge Sponsors are providing the payouts, the amounts will be posted
- at the Chicagoland Chapter Tent.
- The Quick 16 racers need to apply at the Chicagoland Chapter tent with the \$50.00 entry fee. We will also be collecting these fees in the staging lanes at the time of qualifying rounds.
- The TSM & TSO race series have separate entitlements associated with the race series, with the CCGSCA
- contributing \$250.00 as a sponsor to each event for participating at the MWBC.
- Bracket payouts based on 20 cars in each bracket & minimum of 16 cars in Quick 16.

BCO racing was Introduced at the 2006 BPG Nationals in Salem, OH. There is no index in the racers car, but the bracket is based on the fastest of 3 times trials. The race utilizes a 0.4 second pro-tree.
