

## PARISH MEMBERSHIP

TO REGISTER: Please complete the CENSUS UPDATE/REGISTRATION FORM that can be found in the magazine rack in the vestibule of the church or pick one up at the parish office. You can drop the completed CENSUS UPDATE/REGISTRATION FORM in the collection basket or drop it off at the parish office.

### NEED A CERTIFICATE TO BE A SPONSOR/GODPARENT????

We will be happy to provide a certificate form to complete if you are a registered parishioner (registered means active, that you belong - you have your own unique envelope number, you are taking part in the parish life). If you are not receiving envelopes with your name on them - you are not a registered parishioner exceptions are the elderly sick, or those in nursing homes

EVERYONE OVER THE AGE OF 18 IS REQUIRED TO REGISTER SEPARATELY PER CANON LAW.

You must be an active parishioner for at least 6 MONTHS before you can qualify for any certificate, Baptism, Marriage, Sponsorship, etc. THANK YOU FOR YOUR UNDERSTANDING IN THIS MATTER!

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Baptisms are held by previous arrangement with the priest. Registered parishioners may begin arrangements by calling the Parish Office during normal business hours for information.

Baptism preparation classes are mandatory. Parents and godparents must attend this class. Pre-registration is required. Call the Parish Office to register. (A date is set for the Baptism during the preparation class.)

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: Arrangements should be made with the Pastor at least one year in advance and at least one member of the couple must be a registered parishioner for six months. All couples planning marriage must attend a Marriage Preparation Program.



## ADVENT GIVING TREE

This year, like previous years, we are having a special Advent Giving Tree. Since St. Joseph's Nursing Home requested that all of the gifts should be the same, the Social Concerns Committee is going to buy all of

them. Therefore, we will be asking for your monetary donations to subsidize all the expenses. All you have to do is pick one of the envelopes from the tree and return it in the Collection Basket. We are hoping for donations of about \$10 in each envelope (or more if your means allow). Envelopes can be placed in the Collection basket.

### ADVENT: EXERCISING GOOD STEWARDSHIP OF OUR SPIRITUAL LIVES

How can we keep Advent in such a way that it is a time to focus on the fundamentals of stewardship; of spiritual growth and preparation for the coming of Jesus Christ? Here are a few suggestions, not meant to be another to-do list, but rather a way to remind ourselves daily of our call to prepare a way for the Lord in our lives.

• Begin with a list to prioritize what you really want spiritually, and in relation to friends and family, from Advent. Discard all the "extras" and the fantasy of the perfect Hallmark Christmas. List clear goals that bring growth and peace and quality time.

• Take time to read the daily readings each day of Advent. The beautiful words of Isaiah are guaranteed to inspire, and the commitment will guarantee you a bit of quiet and reflective time.

• Go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This will encourage you to reflect on your life, your gifts and where you fail to utilize them for the good of others. It's a beautiful preparation for the coming of Jesus and the beginning of a new year.

• Pray for patience. As you drive over icy streets or navigate through a crowded store, take time to pray for those around you and for those who struggle with much less. Become aware of people around you and lift them in prayer rather than see them as obstacles to your goals.

• In the midst of a season of abundance, do not forget the poor in your community. Christ is calling us to be good stewards of all that we have and all that we are.


Our Annual Cookie Sale, sponsored by the OLC Rosary Altar Society, will take place **next weekend**.
