## Hayle Open Air Swimming Pool

After the hottest summer on record the pool finally closed on 8 September, which rounded off a very successful 2018 season. The solar covers ensured the balmy water temperature tempted even the most timid of swimmers to enter the pool. **Consultation: Former Hawkins Motors Site – Hayle Terrace**

It is not too late for you to get involved and send in your ideas. We anticipate that this site will formally be transferred to the town council later in the year, in accordance with the Section 106 agreement that was put in place when the planning permission for the development of the houses was originally passed. The developers of the site are also obliged to give the Town Council the sum of £30,000 for the purpose of enhancing the immediate area. *The council wishes to consult with the local community and asks you to submit your ideas for what you would like to see at that spot. Given its proximity to the main road no consideration will be given to a children’s play area.*

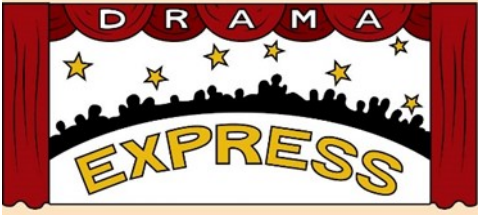

I think we will all be sorry when winter strikes. Let's hope it is not a harsh one.

Morning walks around Copperhouse Pool are so pleasurable. It is still, and quiet, and the bird calls are plainly heard. Curlew calls are rather plaintive, as if they are sad about something. Oystercatchers sound bossy. Robins, blackbirds and thrushes add musical tints to the sounds. The graceful egrets, four of them, strut among the pools left by the receding tide, and, it has to be said, engage in occasional spats, wings flapping, and their long legs not so elegant after all. I can't let the Canada geese go unmentioned. They are not truly wild birds, but feral, released by a farmer in St Erth years ago. But their V shaped skeins above the town are beautiful to see, sometimes hundreds of them flying together, communicating as they go. There seem to be greater numbers of them this year, and they certainly provide a show which is enjoyed by earthbound passers-by.

Leader Steve and his team of volunteer litter-pickers were back in force last weekend. Good for them! What a difference it makes when all the flotsam and jetsam is removed from our water ways and beaches. ## Harvey's Foundry Trust Phase 3 Completed

Thanks to grants totalling £4 million from the Heritage Lottery Fund, Heritage England, Garfield Weston and Cornwall Council, two major buildings at Harvey's Foundry have been fully restored and converted to offices. After opening in April, already over 60% of the units are leased with strong interest for those remaining. The income generated from these units will provide support for the Heritage Centre – and we have big plans for developing this over the next few years.

Walk up Foundry Lane and you will be amazed that the Plantation Store, which had no roof and had almost collapsed, is now a beautiful building. ## Millpond Update

In our previous update we referred to the state of the

Lower Pond and we truly apologise to our visitors for its general need of a proper programme of maintenance. Come on, Council, this is an important historical and ecological site only two minutes from Foundry Square where the Harvey's Foundry was first created in 1776. Be proud of it!

Work has been carried out on the Garden Tower to repair the roof so at least that will keep out the winter rains.

The equinox is arriving along the Rope Walk. Some of the ground cover has come back and small saplings have also grown during the summer. Ferns have recovered and made quite good growth which has improved the appearance of the Walk, which was left looking very bare after the excessive clearance by English Heritage. We hope the regrowth will continue during the autumn and winter.

Some of our autumn birds are also returning. Long-tailed tits and goldfinches have arrived and we have the first of the black-headed gulls back from Wales.

The water lilies are still a fantastic feature on the Swan Pool. The water is very clean and the big fish are still fly-hunting. The turtles are also more visible since the heat wave has become more liveable with. They

### **Copperhouse gate refurbishment will ensure Hayle continues to be protected from flooding**

This autumn the Environment Agency will carry out refurbishment work on the Copperhouse Gate. The gate is a critical part of the Angarack Flood Alleviation Scheme which provides flood protection to 138 properties in the Copperhouse area of Hayle. The refurbishment will ensure that the existing level of flood defence is maintained for a further 30 years.

Work will be carried out by Environment Agency contractors BMMJV and will begin this November. Refurbishment of the gate will take approximately 7 weeks and during this time an area of the North Quay will not be accessible to the public.

Throughout the programme of works there is the potential for minor traffic disruption with the requirement for plant and materials to be delivered to site to enable these works.

The existing steel structure will be repainted, this will require a compressor to be running on site which may generate some noise during normal working hours.

On completion of the painting and maintenance of the existing support structure the tidal gate will be removed and a new gate installed in its place.

The project, being led by the Environment Agency, is funded by central government through a flood defence grant in aid from the Department for Environment, Food, Agriculture, and Rural Affairs. These

works are being undertaken as part of the Environment Agency six year programme to deliver improved flood risk protection to at least 300,000 homes by March 2021.
