Program Objectives

At the 14th World Congress of the ISDE, the learning objectives are:

- Describe the management of GERD, Hiatal Hernia, Barrett's Esophagus, and Esophageal disorders/adenocarcinoma
- Understand the pathogenesis of eosinophilic esophagitis and various treatment modalities ranging from elimination diet to immunosuppression with both topical and systemic preparations
- Select and implement a treatment method for the care of patients with extra-esophageal GERD, including pulmonary and otolaryngology issues
- Describe the use and evaluation of various techniques used in motility, manometry, ablation, stent and stricture management
- Explain the diagnostic tools utilized in evaluating esophageal disease
- Apply technological tips in the operative treatment and evaluate the outcome of both medical and surgical therapy for benign esophageal disorders
