## 2016 Perkins-Tryon Summer Band Camp

FULL BAND will report on Monday, August 1 and go through Friday, August 19<sup>th</sup> (Monday-Friday only). It is essential for **EVERYONE** to be in attendance at these rehearsals. Your success and activities depend on your reliability to attend **all** rehearsals, not only before school starts, but throughout the year as well. Please work your schedules out so that you will be in attendance.

We will start band camp on the first day in the band room to go through expectations for the duration of the camp. Other than that, all rehearsals will begin on the practice field unless otherwise noted from rehearsal to rehearsal.

It is imperative that students be on time to all rehearsals. All students must be in their places ready to begin at the determined rehearsal start time. If you are 10 minutes early, you are on time. If you are on time, you are late. (That's a good rule to remember!)

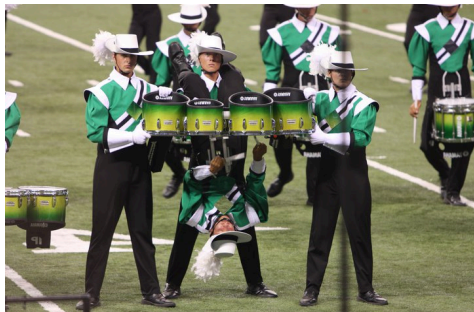
