Day 1 Australia - Helsinki, Finland

Today depart from either Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide or Perth for Helsinki, Finland! Fly with award winning airlines such as Swiss Airways, Singapore Airlines, Etihad Airways or Thai Airways to name a few (subject to availability).

Day 2 Arrive in Helsinki

Welcome to Helsinki, upon arrival be met by a representative and transferred to the hotel.

Make a photo stop at the impressive Voringfossen falls, one of the highest waterfalls in Norway. Continue along the picturesque Hardangerfjord, the fourth longest fjord in the world, and the second longest fjord in Norway. Arrive in Bergen in the evening.

THE ITINERARY

Scandic Ornen Hotel, Bergen Meals included: Breakfast

Day 9 Bergen City Tour - Sognefjord - Flåm Railway - Laerdal

This morning meet your local guide at the hotel and enjoy a city tour of Bergen; Norway's second largest city, which is surrounded by mountains and fjords. Enjoy a guided walk along the famous UNESCO listed Bryggen Wharf, featuring colourful wooden houses on the old wharf, once a centre of the Hanseatic League's trading empire. Afterwards ride up Mount Floyen on the Floyen Funicular. At the top is an outstanding view of Bergen (weather permitting). In the afternoon travel through the Sognefjord area, one of the longest and deepest fjords in the world and one of its arms, the Nærøyfjord is on the UNESCO's World Heritage List. The surrounding mountains are among the most majestic in Norway. Continue the journey to Voss, board the train for Myrdal, taking the famous Flåm Railway to the village of Flåm; located by the Sognefjord and one of the most popular ports in Norway. Afterwards continue by coach to Laerdal via Aurland and travel the Laerdal Tunnel - a 24.51km long road connecting Laerdal and Aurland in Sogn og Fjordane. It is the longest road tunnel in the world succeeding the Swiss Gotthard Road Tunnel.

Day 10 Laerdal - Alesund

After breakfast you will be transferred to the port to take a short ferry ride across the Sognefjord from Fodnes to Mannheller (approx. 30 min). Once on land, continue via Fjaerland and Hellsylt, a village that lies at the head of the Sunnylvsfjorden, which is a branch of the Storfjorden to take another ferry between Sykkylven and Magerholm (approx. 15 min) before arriving in Alesund, the Art Nouveau Town.

Day 11 Alesund City Tour - Trollstigen road - Geiranger (approx.

108km day)

In the morning enjoy a locally guided panoramic city tour of Alesund, the Adventure Capital of the Fjords to see the main sights of this charming city before travelling to Geiranger via the Trollstigen Road. This steep mountain road, with a series of hairpin bends, takes its name from the ancient Norwegian sagas and today is one of Norway's most popular tourist attractions. Afterwards take a short ferry ride from Eidsdal to Linge before arriving in Geiranger in the afternoon - located by the UNESCO listed Geiranger fjord. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Geiranger Union Hotel, Geiranger

Day 12 Geiranger - Lillehammer (approx. 390km day)

Today drive up the Dalsnibba Mountain where you will have a beautiful view of the Geiranger fjord and the surrounding area (weather permitting). Continue to Lillehammer via Lom and the Gudbrandsdalen Valley, surrounded by the national parks of Jotunheimen, Rondane and Dovrefjell. Arrive in the afternoon in the Olympic City (1994) of Lillehammer. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure in Lillehammer renowned for its arts scene, and a vibrant community of local artists from whom you can buy unique work.

Hotel Lillehammer, Lillehammer Meals included: Breakfast

Day 13 Lillehammer - Oslo (approx. 180km day)

After breakfast leave Lillehammer and travel back to Oslo. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure in the Norwegian Capital, fringed by forests, ringed by hills, surrounded by lakes, Norway's capital is something of an undiscovered gem. Throw in some great bars, cosy cafes and excellent restaurants, as well as a large and visible immigrant community who add their own colourful touches to the city, and the result is a thoroughly attractive place.

THE ITINERARY

After breakfast depart for Gothenburg, a major city in Sweden, situated off the Göta älv river on the country's west coast. An important seaport, it's known for its Dutch-style canals and leafy boulevards like the Avenyn, the city's main thoroughfare, lined with many cafes and shops and the Liseberg - a popular amusement park with themed rides, performance venues and a landscaped sculpture garden (entrance not included). Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Day 15 Gothenburg - Copenhagen, Denmark - City Tour (approx. 320km day)

After breakfast travel to Copenhagen, on your way cross the Oresund Bridge, a combined railway and motorway bridge across the Oresund Strait between Sweden and Denmark. On your arrival enjoy a city tour of the city with a local guide to see the main sights of the Danish capital. Drive down Hans Christian Andersen Boulevard, which runs past the Tivoli Gardens, a world-famous amusement park. Cross the picturesque canal and drive past the Christiansborg Palace, the seat of the Danish Parliament. Pass the beautiful old Stock Exchange and see Kongens Nytorv with its Royal Theatre. Continue to Nyhavn, a street well known for the variety of its nightlife. See the Amalienborg Palace, the Danish Royal Family's winter residence. The tour continues to one of the most famous sights in Copenhagen and one of the symbols of the city, the Little Mermaid statue, located in the harbour. Proceed past the Rosenborg Castle, built in Dutch Renaissance style by Danish King Christian IV as a summer residence. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

TOUR GUIDE vs TOUR LEADER Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all TripADeal travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

COACH TOUR:

Meals:

Daily breakfast and one dinner is included in the tour, for all other meals; lunches and dinners the tour leader (when available) will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants. You can also enquire about any allergies and food and if necessary advise meals to be to be prepared with any medication you require.

Luggage:

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, you must carry your own luggage from the coach to the hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the uploading and offloading of their luggage from the coach.
