Jim Valvano once commented, "There are 86,400 seconds in a day. It's up to you to decide what to do with them." He reached the highest level of success as the legendary NC State University basketball coach and then as an award-winning commentator at ABC and ESPN. He authored three books, gave hundreds of motivational speeches to corporations across the

country, hosted weekly television and radio broadcasts and created his own corporation. He was a man possessed by life and all of the opportunities that it had to offer.

In 1993, Jim was diagnosed with terminal cancer. At a lunch with Jim & Pam Valvano, Steve Bornstein, then-president of ESPN, suggested starting a foundation for cancer research and offered ESPN's support. Jim's passion lives on now stronger than ever in the people of ESPN who give freely of their time, resources and creativity to support the mission of the V Foundation for Cancer Research. They do it in ways big and small, all year round through the ESPN V Committees, established by ESPN President George Bodenheimer, who expanded ESPN's involvement in fundraising for the V Foundation, and the growing number of Team ESPN members across the country.

Perhaps it was Jim's deep love of humanity that allowed him to share the details of his darkest hour with millions of strangers that would become his closest confidants, creating the bond that would ultimately support the V Foundation. During one of his final interviews he stated, "I want to help every
