### **Day 2 Buenos Aires City Tour**

Today after breakfast discover the highlights of Buenos Aires on a guided city tour. Continue onto the colourful neighbourhood of La Boca. Here, you will explore "Caminito Street" and enjoy the dancers and souvenir shops. Also, see the Boca Juniors soccer stadium. A number of geographical anomalies around this channel make these waters among the most plankton-rich in the world. You're likely to see a profusion of whales feeding in the rich ecosystem, which is a sight you'll not soon forget.

The European influence in the city's culture is noticeable. To begin, the city tour visits the San Francisco church, which was built between 1572 and 1618. The tour continues by the sector of Club Hípico. Here you can see one of the most beautiful horse racing tracks in South America. Next the tour heads to the Barrio Concha v Toro before arriving at the grandiose Plaza de Armas. In this square you will find historic buildings such as the cathedral, and close by the main post office building, the Natural History Museum and the "Palacio de la Moneda" (seat of government). The tour then makes its way up San Cristóbal Hill, where you can take in the fine views of Santiago and the Andes. Finally, the tour heads to the modern residential a reas on the way to Santiago Airport for your return flight back to Australia.

## Day 2 Lima City Tour & Rafael Larco Herrera Archaeological Museum

Explore Lima on a guided sightseeing tour this morning. Visit Plaza de Armas, with its beautiful buildings. Government Palace, the Town Hall, the palace of the archbishop and the cathedral are a few of the points of interest. Afterwards, visit the beautiful San Francisco monastery, which displays the largest collection of religious art in America. The highlight of this convent is the visit of the underground vaults known as "catacumbas" or catacombs.

Proceed through the modern districts of San Isidro and Miraflores and to the Coastline enjoying the view over the beaches of Lima and the Pacific Ocean. Next, enjoy a guided visit of one of the Lima's most noted museums, the Rafael Larco Herrera Archaeological Museum, which houses the world's largest private collection of Peruvian pre-Columbian Art. Approximately 45,000 objects have been exhibited to the public in the Permanent Hall, Jewellery Vault and the Classified Storage Area ever since.

## Day 3 Lima - Cusco - Cusco City Tour

Today you will be transferred from the hotel to the airport for your flight to Cusco. Upon arrival in Cusco, you will be met and transferred from the airport to your hotel. This afternoon enjoy a half-day city tour. You will see the centre of the Inca Empire, the







Plaza de Armas. You will also see a cathedral built on the ruins of an ancient Inca Palace. Next stop will be the old town, with its magnificent renovated colonial buildings, before driving to Sacsayhuaman ruins on the outskirts of Cusco. Sacsayhuaman also offers a fabulous view of the city. Stop at Tambomachay, the bath of the Inca, Kenko, the giant rock whose niches and gaps were carved in a strange way, and Puca Pucara, the ruin of a small fort.

### Day 4 Cusco - Sacred Valley

Today you will head to the Sacred Valley of the Incas, located on the banks of Vilcanota River. You will enjoy a panoramic sightseeing tour of the Pisac Archeological Complex and then drive to town where you can appreciate the main square, a colourful market full of crafts such as ceramics, textile art and personal accessories made by its inhabitants. After lunch (not included) you will continue your excursion to the enigmatic fortress of Ollantaytambo, a citadel built to guard the entrance to this part of the valley and protect from invasions of forest dwellers. After the tour transfer to the hotel.

## Day 5 Sacred Valley - Machu Picchu - Cusco

Transfer by bus to the train station this morning, where you will board a train through the breathtaking Sacred Valley. Along the way see lush, green fields and colourful villages in the foothills of the Andes to Aguas Calientes. From there, board a small bus for the drive up the steep mountain to the ruins of Machu Picchu. Called the Lost City of the Incas, this cultural heritage of mankind is a beautifully located impressive stone city constructed with a technique incredible for its era and even for present times. Enjoy a guided visit of the site. Return to Ollantaytambo by train, transfer to the hotel in Cusco.

### Day 18 Iguazu Falls, Brazil Side

Today visit the Brazilian side of the falls. The tour leaves from the hotel by coach and crosses Iguazu National Park as far as the Brazilian Falls. Walk along the paths following cascades and then along the catwalk that leads very close to the bottom of Devil's Throat to enjoy magnificent views. Take an elevator up to the road, and there board the coach and return to the hotel.

### Day 19 Iguazu Falls, Argentinian Side

Discover the Argentinean side of the falls today. Leaving from the hotel on the Brazilian side for a drive and a quick customs check,







cross the Tancredo Neves Bridge over the Iguazu River, which forms the border between Argentina & Brazil. Once in Argentina, the tour takes a scenic highway in the Argentinean Iguazu National Park. Stop at the Visitors' Centre and proceed from there to the Superior Circuit, the up-river cascades, the Inferior Circuit, the down-river falls and then the Ecological Jungle Train that leads visitors to and from the most impressive observation point of the falls – The Devil's Throat.

## Day 20 Iguazu Falls - Rio de Janeiro, Brazil

Enjoy the morning to explore before transferring to Iguazu Falls Airport (Argentinian side) for your flight to fabulous Rio de Janeiro!

## Day 21 Rio de Janeiro City Tour - Christ The Redeemer

After an early morning hotel pickup, enjoy a tour of Christ the Redeemer at Corcovado. On the way, enjoy views of Copacabana Beach, Botafogo Beach and Palácio Guanabara. Before heading up, you'll reach Tijuca Forest, stopping at Paineiras to board the vehicles up to Corcovado. The visit to the monument lasts approximately 45 minutes. In case of poor visibility on the summit of Corcovado, you will make an alternative stop at Mirante Dona Marta (362m), generally less affected by cloudiness.

Then, head to Sugarloaf Mountain before continuing to Botafogo Beach towards Praia Vermelha, in the district of Urca, passing by the imposing neo-classical buildings of the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro, the Institute Benjamin Constant for the blind and the National Institute for Mineral Resources. Board the cable-car and Urca Hill (200m) and Sugarloaf, staying there for around 30 minutes at the top. Afterwards visit the Maracanã Stadium from the outside (stopping at Bellini's statue for pictures) and then head to the Sambadrome (the stadium for the city's main Carnival parade).

You'll then see the Lapa Arches, Lavradio street and Avenida Chile. Visit the cone-shaped Metropolitan Cathedral, not only one of the Brazilian city's landmarks, but also a masterpiece of modern art. Then, visit the Escadaria Selarón – one of the most fascinating and original staircases in the world. Head to the São Bento Monastery, which has been compared to a museum and has a monastic simplicity making it one of the most beautiful architectural complexes in Brazil.

On the way back to the hotel, along Aterro do Flamengo, you'll see the Museum of Modern Art, the Monument to the Fallen in World War II, the Church of the Outeiro da Glória, the beaches of Flamengo and Botafogo and return to the hotel via Copacabana, Ipanema and Leblon.

#### **TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER**

#### **Tour Guide:**

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

## **Tour Leader:**

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

### Argentina:

Australian citizens travelling to Argentina from the 1st of July 2017 onwards will not be required to pay the current reciprocity fee of \$100 USD to enter the country. Australian tourists may be eligible to enter Argentina from this date onwards without a visa for visits up to 90 days. Contact the nearest Embassy or Consulate of Argentina for the most upto-date information.

#### Chile:

Australian tourists entering Chile through Santiago International Airport are required to pay a "reciprocity fee" of \$117 USD (subject to change) payable in cash or credit card prior to going through passport control. For current up to date info visit the Embassy of Chile website http://chile.gob.cl/australia/es/

## Peru (pre-tour extension only):

Australian citizens do not require a visa to enter Peru. They need only to hold a valid passport and a return ticket on arrival. They are allowed to stay up to 183 days in Peru.

## Brazil (post-tour extension only):

Prior to arrival in Brazil, Australian tourists must arrange a tourist visa through the Embassy of Brazil in Australia. The visa currently costs \$218 AUD (subject to change) and more information can be found through the Embassy website http://camberra.itamaraty.gov.br/en-us/ tourist\_visa.xml
