Schools will compete in the division determined by the 2003 CBED enrollment for grades 10, 11 and 12; unless a school incurs a gain/loss of enrollment of a minimum of fifteen (15) percent in the current year (October 2004 CBED), then the October 2004 CBED enrollment figures shall be used in place of the 2003 CBEDS enrollment figures to determine the school's division for 2004 (per CIF Bylaws).

NO Petitioning Up – Schools will be required to participate in the division that has been established by their respective CIF Section using the previous years' CBEDS enrollment. Exception: In CIF Sections with fewer than 30 schools, the CIF Section may allow all of their schools to compete in Division I.

#### **ENTRIES**

#### EACH SCHOOL MUST ENTER THEIR OFFICIAL ENTRIES

Each coach must individually enter his/her official entries, team or individuals, by using EZMeets.com web site. The deadline for the acceptance of entries is Sunday, November 14, 2004, prior to midnight. There will be no exceptions. Although the entry deadline is Sunday, November 14, 2004 coaches may enter their school's potential entries as of the reception of their school's password.

#### PRÔCEDURES FOR ENTERING YOUR SCHOOLS POTENTIAL PARTICIPANTS

Each school must have their school's password prior to entering your athletes. A separate letter will be mailed to all NCS head cross country coaches with this information in the month of October.

Once you have your password log onto the Internet. Go to <a href="http://www.EZMeets.com">http://www.EZMeets.com</a>. You may also go to the NCS web site, <a href="http://www.EZMeets.com">www.cifncs.org</a>, choose the sport of cross country and click on the EZMeets.com link. Once at the EZMeets.com web site scroll down to "North Coast Section XC Meet of Champions" and Click "Enter Athletes" or "Entries". This will take you to the NCS entries home page. Below is a copy of the NCS entry home page.



Follow the instructions on the "NCS Entries" home page at EZMeets.com web site to enter your school entries.

Your school's password will be mailed to you in early October. If your school does not receive the information please call the NCS Office and speak to Gil Lemmon, Associate Commissioner.

You may enter, change or scratch athletes at any time. Initially, you may enter more than seven (7) participants. However, when your team arrives at the NCS/Les Schwab Tires Cross Country Championships you will be limited to seven (7) runners per team. Prior to the November 14, 2004 entry deadline we ask that each school update the entries. If, due to injury, or for some other reason, your school is not sure exactly who will participate, it is permissible, and more desirable, too have the additional names listed on the entry list. However, the limitation of seven (7) runners on the day of the NCS Cross Country Championships may not be violated. Each time you visit the EZMeets.com web site and alter your school's entries print a copy of the entry page and keep it as a receipt. Please do this at the end of each on-line session. Contact the NCS Office with any questions or concerns.

<u>Team Qualifications</u>: All NCS member schools are eligible to participate in the NCS/Les Schwab Tires Cross Country Championships. Complete teams consist of a minimum of 5 and maximum of 7 eligible competitors.

<u>Individual Qualifications</u>: All NCS member schools may enter individual finishers (whether members of a team or not) in each division from each league meet.

#### **NATIONAL FEDERATION CROSS COUNTRY RULES**

The National Federation rules will be enforced at all NCS/Les Schwab Tires Cross Country Championship events. Uniforms must comply with the rules.

#### **CERTIFICATION OF COACHES** - Instructions

CIF (506) and NCS (209) Bylaws require that coaches meet certain standards. The State of Calif. Education Code requires that all public school teams must be under the supervision of a person who meets all of the requirements of California Administrative Code Title V, Section 5531. Coaches of non-public schools must be engaged by that school on a yearly contract basis and be certified by the administrator of that school as competent for that position held. In each case the principal of the school must sign a Certificate of Authorized Personnel form (see page 12) and each coach is required to bring the form to the NCS Cross Country Championships. This form, signed by the principal, must be submitted when coaches' packets are picked up prior to the start of competition. No students will be allowed to compete until their coach is present with a properly completed Certificate of Authorized Personnel form.

#### ADMISSION

Participating schools will list team party members on a gate list. (See page 11)

Team Party - includes up to two coaches, certified trainer and team drivers. Participants listed on the gate list will be admitted as a group without a ticket. The coach must be present at the gate to identify these participants.

#### **ATHLETIC TRAINER**

An athletic trainer will be available to athletes for the duration of the 2004 NCS/Les Schwab Tires Cross Country Championships. Trainers at NCS/Les Schwab Tires Championship Series Events are present for paramedic services. These services will be performed by licensed Registered Physical Therapists (RPT) and/or Certified Athletic Trainers. Trainers will perform only those services that are within the scope of the Physical Therapist license or the NATA certification of athletic trainers. During NCS Championship Series Events trainers will respond to emergencies immediately. All other non-emergency services may be provided, however, they may be interrupted or may become unavailable if an emergency arises. Trainers do not replace the responsibility of the coach of each represented school as the responsible party of their athlete's medical care. Coaches are expected to have a medical kit as well as all emergency medical forms necessary to respond to the health and welfare of their athletes.

#### **DIRECTIONS**

Hayward High School is located in Hayward, CA – just south of Oakland. Take Hwy. 880 north or south to the Jackson St. exit. Proceed east. Just past the large intersection of Mission Blvd. and Jackson turn right on Main St. At the dead end turn left onto E St. Follow E St. to East Ave. and Hayward High School.

#### **BILLING OF ENTRY FEES**

The North Coast Section will bill each league/conference commissioner for the total entry fees for each entrant to the Meet of Champions at the rate of \$55.00 per team of five or more competitors (maximum of seven) or \$7.00 per individual competitor.

#### CIF STATE CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS - Saturday, November 27, 2004 at Woodward Park,

**Fresno.** The State CIF will mail CIF State Cross Country Championship Bulletins to each CIF member school. The following criteria shall be used to determine the number of teams and individuals who will qualify to the CIF State Cross Country Championships:

#### **Automatic Teams**

Team entries into the State CIF Cross Country Championships shall be based on a formula that is comprised of two factors: 1) An established baseline providing a minimum number of entries for each section; 2) Additional entries based upon the most recent four (4) year history of the section team performance in each divisional race. No section shall have more than seven (7) team entries in any divisional race. Based on the above criteria North Coast Section will have the following entries to the 2004 State CIF Cross Country Championships:

#### **Individuals**

The top five highest placed individuals (not on an automatic team entry), per the criteria below in each division will qualify from section to state meet finals.

Sections Entering Two Teams - Individuals must place in the top 12 at section finals to qualify. Sections Entering One Teams - Individuals must place in the top 8 at section finals to qualify.





## **Fundamentals of Sportsmanship**

A. Gain an understanding and appreciation for the rules of the contest.

Being well informed is essential. Know the rules. Refrain from expressing opinions on decisions made by officials and coaches.

#### A. Exercise representative behavior at all times.

The true value of interscholastic competition relies upon everyone exhibiting behavior which is representative of a sound value base. Your behavior influences others whether you are aware of it or not.

#### B. Exhibit respect for the officials.

The officials of any contest are trained, impartial arbitrators who perform to the best of their ability. Mistakes by all those involved are a part of every contest. We should not rationalize our own poor or unsuccessful performance by placing responsibility on an official. A rule of good sportsmanship is to accept and abide by the decision made.

#### C. Openly display respect for the opponent at all times.

Opponents are guests and should be treated cordially, provided with the best accommodations, and accorded tolerance at all times. Be a positive representative of your school, team or family.

#### D. Display pride in your actions at every opportunity.

Never allow your ego to interfere with good judgment and your responsibility as a school representative. Regardless of whether you are an adult, student, player, coach or official this value is paramount since it suggests that you care about yourself and how others perceive you.




