# INTRODUCTION

## Rabbi David Spetner

KOLLEL DIRECTOR / OPERATIONS

Welcome to the Annual Report of the Cincinnati Community Kollel. The Kollel is now in its thirteenth year of activity and we are proud of its accomplishments. It is with great excitement that we offer this review to our community and supporters. The report in your hands contains our activity reports, as well as staff bios, a balance sheet and income statement, and an alphabetical list of our contributor base.

What is our Community Kollel? At its core it is a *makom Torah*, a place dedicated to the study of Torah. The Kollel operates with the philosophy that, more than any other spiritual or physical asset, it is our Torah and the study of it that have kept our people alive through-

out the millennia. It is the goal of our staff to share the beauty of Torah study throughout the Cincinnati Jewish community and, through that, to help each Jew draw closer to their Judaism.

We call the Torah *Etz Chaim*—a Tree of Life—and, like a tree, in order to bear fruit it must have roots deep within the earth. In order to share Torah, our staff must be deeply rooted in their own dynamic Torah study.

Our staff scholars maintain two intensive daily study sessions, each three hours in length,

Outreach Director, Rabbi Yitzchok Preis, has very effectively led that charge, overseeing all of the Kollel's off-site learning opportunities.

This year, the Kollel's expanded activities, which were introduced last year, have really taken off. First, our larger team of six Staff Scholars has created a whole new, dynamic level of energy in our Study Center. Next is the Kollel Retreat Center in Deerfield Township, headed by Rabbi Pinchas & Naomi Landis. In only a year and a half, weekly participation has grown to more than fifty individuals and overall participation to over 200. The Kollel's Aish campus project at University of Cincinnati and at Miami

University (of Oxford, Ohio), headed by former Staff Scholar Rabbi Rafi Weinschneider has sent many students to Israel and has scores involved in weekly Jewish activities. Please read more about these exciting endeavors in their individual reports.

We are excited about our staff and we hope you will get to know them. They are truly a special group, each with a unique blend of humanity, compassion, and scholarship.

We look forward to the opportunity to touch the lives of ever more Jews with the beauty of Torah.

## ON-SITE LEARNING

### Rabbi Meir Minster

KOLLEL DIRECTOR / TORAH STUDIES

We take great pride as we look back on the learning of the Kollel in the past year. Our staff scholars focused their learning on the tractates *Beitz'a* and *Chagiga*, which deal with the laws specific to the Jewish holidays. At the same time, we completed an in-depth study of the laws of Shabbos.

In this current year, our thirteenth, we have begun a two-year course of study of the tractate *Chulin*, which deals with the laws of kashrus and forms the core of practical Jewish law. This marks the third time that *Chulin* has been studied in the Kollel, and it attests

to the continuing cycle of advancement for our past scholars and the arrival of our newer staff members over the years.

We also get much satisfaction from the fact that the majority of our Staff Scholars make Cincinnati their home after leaving the Kollel, serving the Jewish community in so many different and meaningful ways.

Over the years we have had the pleasure to learn and review many of the tractates of the Talmud that cover the practical areas of Jewish living. Besides *Chulin*, we have studied *Niddah* (the laws of family purity) and

*Berachos* (the laws of blessings and prayer). As mentioned, we have spent several years covering the laws of *Shabbos*, which are found in the tractates *Shabbos* and *Eiruvin*. We also accepted the challenge to study the Laws of *ribbis* (interest and finance), one of the most complex areas of discussion within Jewish law; these are found in tractate *Bava Metzri'ah*. More recently, we completed the tractate *Yoma*, which deals with the special service in the Temple on the day of Yom Kippur, as well as the observances and fasting that still pertain to us today; and *Avodah Zarah*, which discusses other religions and our interaction with the non-Jewish world.

I would like to take a moment to describe the daily activities of our Beis Midrash. *Beis Midrash* translates literally into a "study hall" or "place of learning," but in our case it is much more. Besides serving as the physical hub for much of the Kollel's activities, the spiritual impact of the Torah learned there permeates and drives all that we do.

This is the essence of the Kollel. While our day is anchored by our personal study, it is from this learning that the Torah insights we share with others take shape. In the morning session we attempt to master specific areas of *halacha*, legal conclusions, while in the afternoon we survey the entire tractate at hand, gaining an appreciation for the context from

which *halacha* is derived. No less important, however, is the community learning which we view as flowing from these sessions.

From 5:30 in the morning until after 10:30 at night, members of the community can be found learning in the Beis Midrash—with the Kollel staff or on their own. They are taking time from their schedules to incorporate the beauty of Torah into their days. Whether studying one-on-one over breakfast, at lunch, or during our evening community session, or by joining a class or lunch-and-learn, people are finding their lives enriched by the Torah.

Besides our regular classes and one-on-one learning, the Kollel has developed several special learning opportunities. Now completing its fifth year, Kollel Dirshu, an exciting and extremely successful early-morning learning program for laymen, has exceeded even our most optimistic expectations. Cincinnati continues to be a shining star among the growing number of cities that participate in this international program. Kollel Dirshu, led locally by Rabbi Yitzchok Preis, encourages the mastery of sections of the Talmud by setting a daily

pace and a weekly examination of the material covered. A stipend is offered for those who reach attendance and grade requirements. Although the learning ends before 7:00am, the participants have found their entire day transformed by this early morning spiritual workout. Some even return later in the day to continue their Torah discussions.

We continue to be amazed by the number of people this program has attracted. Kollel Dirshu has earned a prominent space among our other successful programs, Yesodei Hatorah (where participants acquire the skills to learn on their own) and Daf Yomi (the daily study of a folio of Talmud). They provide

an opportunity to gain an appreciation for the breadth of the Talmud.

Perhaps our proudest moment is at Father and Son Learning, where parents, grandparents and children fill the Kollel building to capacity. The sweet sound of Torah being passed on, from generation to generation, is truly inspiring. Special thanks go to our volunteers—Josh Kibel, who runs this program so effectively in the winter, and Rabbi Shai Scherer, who has expanded the program to include Shabbos afternoons in the summer.

I invite you to come in to the Kollel. Join us in our learning, and discover your own place in Torah. We look forward to seeing you.

## OFF-SITE LEARNING

The Kollel's vibrant Beis Midrash continues to create an energy that spreads far beyond its walls. This past year saw Kollel outreach activities for teens, college students, and adults of all ages in a wide variety of settings.

Our **Kollel Retreat Center (KRC)** in Mason has outpaced all expectations. Several popular weekly classes attract adult learners from Mason and far beyond. Lively, lavish Shabbos dinners attract dozens of young professionals and families of all ages and backgrounds, and a variety of exciting seasonal events keep the KRC humming with activity.

Our **college outreach programming** increased significantly, with more students than ever before participating in weekly learning, Shabbos experiences, and Israel trips.

The KRC and college outreach programs will be elaborated upon later in this Annual Report.

Our **Women's Learning Initiative**, sponsored in part by the **Jewish Federation of Cincinnati**, presented a special evening of camaraderie and learning and provided the crowd with a more profound appreciation of Shabbat candles. **Woman to Woman**

**Partners in Torah**, now under the direction of **Ahuva Goldman**, continues to provide unique one-on-one learning experiences that bring together women of different ages and backgrounds in a variety of local settings.

A weekend **Gateways Retreat** at the Kings Island Resort Center brought hundreds of participants from Cincinnati, Columbus, Lexington, and Indianapolis together for a series of fascinating lectures, spirited services and lavish, festive meals.

The very inspiring (and very funny!) Rabbi Eliyahu Bergstein was our guest speaker for a special, local **pre-Rosh Hashanah Shabbaton**.

November was **Kosher Awareness Month** and brought classes, resource materials, and inspiration for increased kosher observance to Cincinnati. Our co-sponsors were Avari's, Biggs, Graeters, Marx Hot Bagels, and Ranelle's Gourmet Cookies and Challah.

**Russian-speaking** members of our community were treated to several informative lectures and film-based discussions with **former Russian actor, now Torah educator** and film producer, Rabbi Tzvi Patlas. Rabbi Patlas also made several special presentations for the **Hebrew-speaking** community.

Anti-Semitism was the focus of "**Why the Jews?**" in a presentation by Rabbi Motty

Berger of Jerusalem hosted by **Brett and Alison Caller** and **Steve and Robyn Miller**. Rabbi Berger also spoke at a special downtown presentation hosted by **Larry Neuman** and the **Strauss & Troy** law firm.

A monthly **Jewish Culture Club** brings Torah thought (and refreshments!) to **Walnut Hills High School** students.

A **Crash Course in Hebrew Reading** offered at the **Symmes Township Library** attracted many unaffiliated and 'nominally-affiliated' participants.

**Lunch-and-Learns** continue to provide a midday spiritual boost for participants every week **Downtown**. **Children's Hospital** is the location of our newest Lunch-and-Learn, catering to physicians and medical staff.

Home-based study groups meet regularly in **Amberley, Hyde Park, Kenwood, Montgomery, and Wyoming**.

## RETREAT CENTER

The Kollel Retreat Center has been open since August, 2006. This program was started to be an outpost for Jewish life and inspiration in the northern suburbs of Cincinnati. Our open house and welcoming approach has brought in over 200 people, who are now involved in regular programming at the Retreat Center including Shabbos and holiday programs, classes and lectures, and one on one study programs.

Our Shabbos program attracts many different types of Jews. The program includes lively and informative services, as well as festive, delicious meals. A Shabbos table with over forty people sitting around it is a regular occurrence at the KRC.

The holidays are always celebrated in a major way at the Center. With over 150 people attending the Purim Bash, sixty people enjoying the Passover Seders, fifty people partici-

pating in Explanatory High Holiday Services, 120 people sitting in the Succah, and ninety people at the Chanukah Party, everyone looks forward to the holidays with the Kollel.

Our classes have become very popular at the Center. We have a weekly Israeli group that meets to discuss Torah ideas in Hebrew. The "Back to the Past" History Series is very popular among Jews young and old. "Dinner and Discussion" is a great way to speak your mind about Judaism. Guest lecturers always attract nice crowds.

Many Jewish men and women have taken advantage of our one-on-one study program. We now have many different learning partnerships going on regularly around the city. All of these grew out of the Retreat Center.

This past August we ran a very successful trip to Israel. 25 participants from the Cincinnati area joined together on the Israel Learning Experience. We toured all over the country while learning about Jewish History and Culture. We also had the opportunity

Café” on-line learning program, and we provide a stipend for students who master the curriculum.

Several lectures were hosted at the A.E.Pi. house at U.C. In one presentation, guest speaker Doron Kornbluth tackled the very controversial but very important issue of intermarriage. He was very well received by the more than twenty students who participated despite a severe winter storm.

Programs on Miami’s campus are held at the “Aish Bayit,” as well as some held in

conjunction with Hillel at the Hillel facility. Guest speakers this past year were Rabbi Motty Berger, from Jerusalem, Steve Belkin, and Discovery Seminars’ Rabbi Eliyahu Bergstein.

Shabbat at the Bayit is a weekly highlight for many students looking for a “home away from home” where they very comfortably explore and expand their Judaism.

The enthusiastic response we’ve gotten from so many students has reinforced the important role of the Kollel’s Aish Campus program.
