


REMOVAL

1. DRAIN TRANSAXLE OIL

- a. Remove the filler plug and the gasket.
- b. Remove the drain plug and gasket, and then drain the manual transaxle oil.
- c. Install a new gasket and the drain plug.

Torque: 39 N*m (400 kgf*cm, 29 ft.*lbf)




Fig. 4: Removing Oil Seal With SST Courtesy of TOYOTA MOTOR SALES, U.S.A., INC.




Fig. 5: Removing Oil Seal With SST Courtesy of TOYOTA MOTOR SALES, U.S.A., INC.

INSTALLATION

1. INSTALL TRANSMISSION CASE OIL SEAL

- a. Coat the lip of a new oil seal with MP grease.
- b. Using SST and a hammer, install the new oil seal.


SST 09309-37010

Drive in depth:

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9.6 to 10.2 mm (0.378 to 0.402 in.)

NOTE: Do not damage the oil seal lip.

Drive in depth:

1.6 to 2.2 mm (0.063 to 0.087 in.)

NOTE: Do not damage the oil seal lip.




Fig. 7: Installing Transmission Case Oil Seal With SST Courtesy of TOYOTA MOTOR SALES, U.S.A., INC.

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



Fig. 8: Identifying Shift Lever Assembly Components With Torque Specification Courtesy of TOYOTA MOTOR SALES, U.S.A., INC.

REMOVAL

- 1. REMOVE SHIFT LEVER KNOB SUB-ASSEMBLY (See REMOVAL)


6. DISCONNECT TRANSMISSION CONTROL CABLE ASSEMBLY


- b. Disconnect the control shift cable from the shift lever.

a. Remove the 4 bolts and remove the shift lever.




<u>Fig. 11: Locating Shift Lever Bolts</u> Courtesy of TOYOTA MOTOR SALES, U.S.A., INC.

INSTALLATION

1. INSTALL FLOOR SHIFT SHIFT LEVER ASSEMBLY

a. Install the shift lever with the 4 bolts.

Torque: 12 N*m (122 kgf*cm, 9 ft.*lbf)

2. CONNECT TRANSMISSION CONTROL CABLE ASSEMBLY

a. Install the control cable assembly onto the shift lever retainer.

NOTE:

- Install the cable with the protruding portion of the cable outer facing upward.
- After installing, check that the lock of the cable outer is protruding beyond portion A, as shown in the illustration.




Fig. 13: Identifying Control Cable Assembly Onto Shift Lever Retainer

- b. Connect the control shift cable to the shift lever.
- c. Connect the control select cable to the shift lever with the clip.

NOTE:

- Connect the control select cable so that the adjusting mechanism lock of the control select cable is installed on the left side of the vehicle.
- Insert the clip in the direction shown in the illustration.




Fig. 14: Locating Shift Cable And Select Cable Courtesy of TOYOTA MOTOR SALES, U.S.A., INC.

- d. Adjust the length of the control select cable.
 - 1. Slide the adjuster case cover in the direction shown in the illustration (Illustration A).
 - 2. Gently pull the cable rod toward the rear of the vehicle by hand to pull the cable taut.
 - 3. Press the lock piece into the adjuster case and lock it (Illustration B).

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4. Slide the cover in the direction shown in the illustration (Illustration C).

NOTE: Slide the cover past the protrusion of the lock piece (Illustration D).





Fig. 15: Sliding Adjuster Case Cover Courtesy of TOYOTA MOTOR SALES, U.S.A., INC.

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


Fig. 17: Identifying Transmission Control Cable Components With Torque Specifications (2 Of 2) Courtesy of TOYOTA MOTOR SALES, U.S.A., INC.
