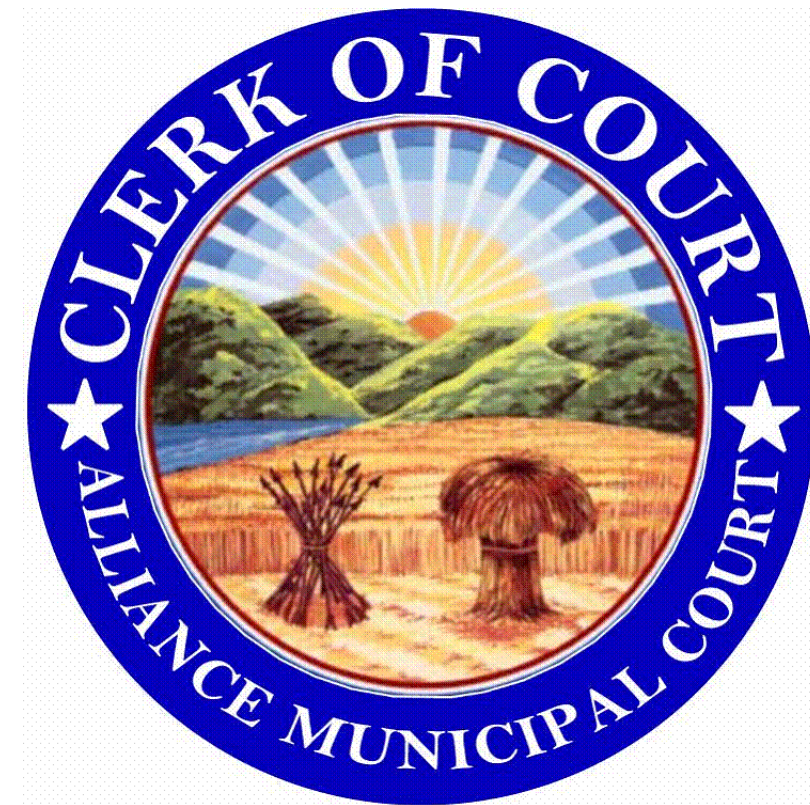

Robert G. Lavery Municipal Court Judge

Judge Robert G. Lavery has served as the Alliance Municipal Court Judge since January, 1996. Prior to becoming a judge he was a practicing attorney engaged in the general practice of law for nineteen years. Judge Lavery graduated from Alliance High School in 1969, Bowling Green State University in 1973, and the University of Toledo College of Law in 1976.

Judge Lavery was a prosecuting attorney in the Alliance Municipal Court from 1977 to 1982. He has also served on the Alliance Civil Service Commission and was appointed special counsel for the Ohio Attorney General's Office by Betty Montgomery. Judge Lavery was elected Alliance City Council President in 1987 and Alliance's Director of Law in 1991.

Professionally, he received Robert D. Horowitz, Stark County Prosecutor's "Voices for Victims Award" in October, 1998 and the Thomas J. Moyer, Chief Justice for the Supreme Court of Ohio's "Court Mediation Program Citation" in April 1997. In June, 1986, Lavery was recognized by the Stark County Community Action Agency "for loyal and dedicated commitment to the poor and disadvantaged."

More recently, Judge Lavery received the Distinguished Alumni Award for the Alliance City Schools in October, 2007 and the Dr. Martin L. King Jr. Community Award for racial harmony and social justice by the Diversity Initiatives Steering Committee at Mount Union College in January, 2008, and was selected Grand Marshal by the Carnation Festival Board in August, 2008, Citizen of the Year by the Lions' Club in 2009 and received the Urban Icon award in 2010.

Judge Lavery has been active in many civic and charitable organizations. Currently, he is on the advisory council for the Alliance of Churches, Inc, and a counselor for the American Legion's Boys State program, an honorary member of the Alliance Negro History Club and a life member of the N.A.A.C.P. He is also the Sunday school teacher for the Senior Bible Class at St. Paul's Lutheran Church. Robert Lavery is married, a resident of Alliance, and has two adult daughters.



MaryAnne Carper Clerk of Court

MaryAnne Carper is a twenty-nine year resident of Stark County. She attended Ohio Northern University after graduating from Center High School in Monaca, PA.

MaryAnne was elected Alliance Municipal Clerk of Court in November 2007, and is currently serving her fifth year in office. She has worked in local government for eighteen years.

She is a member of the Alliance Woman's Club and serves on the Board of Trustees as the 2nd Vice President and in the past as the Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer, Ways and Means; Alliance Garden Club, Treasurer; Alliance Area Republican Club; Votes for Women, Ohio Association of Municipal/County Court Clerks; 2012 committee for the Carnation Queen's Pageant; 2012 Chairperson for the Carnation Flower Show and teaches Sunday school for the Young Teens and Teens at the Alliance First Assembly of God. MaryAnne resides in Lexington Township with her husband Jeff. She is the mother of Rachel (Steve) Zoky and Rebekah Haberland.



Jean A. Madden Municipal Court Magistrate

Jean A. Madden started as a bailiff for Judge Robert G. Lavery in April, 2010. In October, 2010, Judge Lavery appointed her as the Court's first Magistrate, hearing criminal and civil matters. In addition to her magistrate and bailiff duties, she is also in charge of courthouse security. Since coming to Alliance, Magistrate Madden has developed and implemented the video arraignment system which allows incarcerated defendants to appear for their arraignments by video camera from the Stark County Jail. This process saves substantial time and money as well as improving courthouse security by not having to transport inmates to court. Currently she is working with the Stark County Veteran's Agency to aid veterans appearing before the Court in obtaining services that would assist in their rehabilitation. The Court will hold the initial session for veteran's the last week in March 2012.

Magistrate Madden came to the Alliance Municipal Court after thirty years with the Stark County Common Pleas Court. She started in that Court in 1980 as the criminal assignment commissioner. Upon her admission to law school, she became the secretary and law clerk to the late Hon. William A. Morris and then the Hon. John G. Haas. After receiving her law degree, she began her legal career as a staff attorney with the Stark County Public Defender Office. In 1995, she was appointed the Assistant Public Defender, a position she held until her departure for the Alliance Municipal Court position.

Magistrate Madden is a 1974 graduate of the University of Mount Union and received her J.D. from the University of Akron, School of Law in 1990. She is licensed to practice law in Ohio and Florida and has argued cases in all courts in Stark County, including the Fifth Appellate District and before the Ohio Supreme Court. She is a member of the Ohio Magistrates Association and Votes for Women and is a supporter of the work of the Coalition for Animal Concerns, promoting animal welfare.

Directions to Building

From Cleveland

Merge onto I-77 S via the ramp on the left toward Akron. Merge onto I-480 E via exit 156 toward Youngstown. Merge onto OH-14 E via exit 21 toward Youngstown. Turn slight right onto OH-14. Slight right onto OH-183. Turn left onto East Market Street. End at 470 E Market Street.

From Youngstown

Merge onto I-680 N. I-680 N becomes I-80 W. Take I-76 W toward Akron. Take the OH-225 exit, exit 48, toward Alliance. Turn left onto OH-225. OH-225 becomes OH-14. Enter next roundabout and take 1st exit onto US-224. Turn left onto OH-225. OH-225 becomes North Union Ave/ OH-183. Turn left onto East Market Street. End at 470 E Market Street.

From Columbus

Merge onto US-62 E via exit 107B toward Alliance. US-62 E becomes US-62F E. Take the US-62/ State Street/ OH-173 exit toward Alliance. Turn right onto State Street NE/ US-62/ OH-173. Turn left on Union Avenue. Turn right on East Market Street. End at 470 E Market Street.

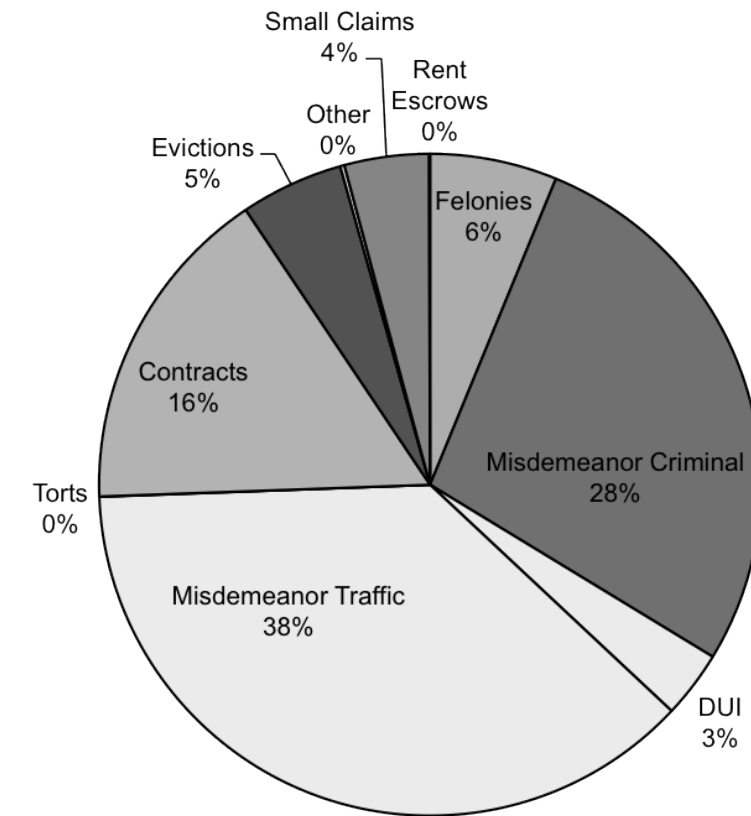
