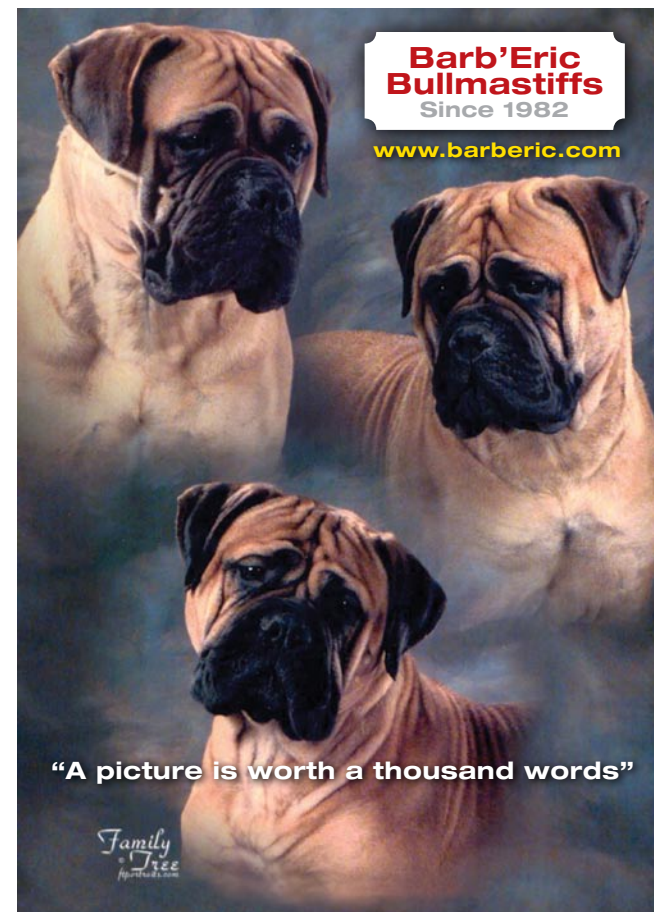

# Dog Show Etiquette

Dogs shows are fun and exciting! You might feel like petting all the dogs, but wait! Keep these things in mind as you walk around and enjoy the show.

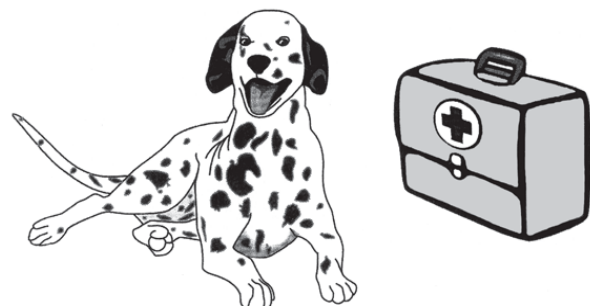
-  Always ask before you pet a dog. The handlers (people showing dogs) spent a lot of time and energy grooming their dogs for the show. Never go up and just pet a dog. Ask first.
-  Wait until handlers have finished an event before asking questions. Before the show, they are focusing on their dog and getting ready for their turn in the ring. Always ask permission before petting a dog!
-  Turn off your cell phone. It is a distraction to the dogs and handlers.
-  Stay away from ring entrances. It is very difficult for handlers to get in and out of the rings when people are in the way of the entrance.
-  Do not lean over the rings or talk to handlers when they are in the ring showing.
-  Do you have small children with you? Don't let them run up to dogs or stick their fingers and hands into crates or exercise pens. Also, it's best to leave strollers in the car. Strollers can place a child's face at the same level as unfamiliar dogs' faces. Plus, a stroller can accidentally run over lots of dogs' tails.
-  Be careful where you step so you don't step on feet, noses or tails!
-  Keep food away from the ring. It is a distraction to the dogs.
-  Leave your own dog at home unless you are taking them for a special reason, such as a CGC® test.

# First-aid Starter Kit



Keeping a first-aid kit close by can be handy in case your dog has an accident, gets a cut or eats something that could make it sick. The suggested materials listed below are intended to assist you with the basic first aid. If possible, always immediately contact a veterinarian when you suspect your dog is injured. He or she can guide you through the initial steps of basic first aid, such as slowing bleeding or inducing vomiting, until you can get to the veterinarian's office.

## AKC EVENTS AT THESE SHOWS

**Conformation RINGS 1-12** – Dog shows, or “conformation” events, are the signature events of the AKC. Exhibits are judged against breed standards, which have been established for the AKC-recognized breeds by their parent clubs. These written standards describe the ideal size, color, and temperament of each breed, as well as correct proportion, structure, and movement.

**Obedience RINGS 21-22** – Obedience Trials test a dog's ability to perform a prescribed set of exercises on which it is scored. In each exercise, the dog must score more than 50% of the possible points and get a total score of at least 170 out of a possible 200. Each time the dog gets that magic 170 qualifying score, he's earned a “leg” towards his title. Three legs and the dog has become an Obedience Titled dog! There are 3 levels at which a dog can earn a title and each is more difficult than the one before it.

**Rally RING 23** – Rally is a sport in which the dog and handler compete through a course of designated stations. Rally provides a link from the Canine Good Citizen® (CGC) program to obedience or agility competition, both for dogs and handlers. In addition, rally promotes fun and enjoyment for dogs at all levels of competition.

**Agility RING 31**– Agility is the ultimate game for you and your dog. It is also one of the most exciting canine sports for spectators. In agility, a dog demonstrates its agile nature and versatility by following cues from the handler through a timed obstacle course. The course has jumps, tunnels, weave poles, and other obstacles. Agility strengthens the bond between dogs and handlers, it is extremely fun, and it provides vigorous exercise for both!

## Dog Show Terms

**Baiting** - Using liver or some treat to get the dog's attention and have him look alert.

**Exhibitor** - A person who brings a dog to a dog show and shows it in the appropriate class.

**Fancier** - A person who is especially interested, and usually active, in some phase of the sport of purebred dogs.

**Gait** - The way a dog moves, movement is a good indicator of structure and condition.

**Handler** - A person or agent who takes a dog into the show ring or who works the dog at a field trial or other performance event.

**Heel** - A command to a dog to keep close beside its handler.

**Pedigree** - The written record of a dog's family tree of three or more generations.

**Stacking** - Posing the dog to create a pleasing picture.

### BOEING K-9 PROGRAM

The Boeing Company's K-9 Program consists of more than eight K-9 teams, one trainer, a kennel master and a team of highly trained

explosive Detection Dogs deployed at various sites throughout the enterprise to provide its employees, contractors and visitors a safe work environment. Boeing currently has K-9 units working in the State of Washington, Southern California, Wichita, Kansas and Chicago, Ill. This program, which grew out of Boeing's need for enhanced security in the aftermath of 9/11, was established in November 2001. K-9 members of the Explosive Detection Dog program work with Boeing Security to identify and alert on suspicious material and are trained to detect over 17,000 different explosive-based chemicals and compounds. Boeing's explosive detection dogs have been on the job at shareholders meetings, customer product delivery events, on the field and flight lines during flight tests, and at major employee forums held at Boeing facilities.

Selecting a K-9 requires that the dog and handler are the right fit for the job. Today's K-9s are often recruited from rescue shelters or from other service dog training programs. The dogs are tested out to see if being an explosive detection dog is the right skill match. If they pass the test, they go into training and certification. Each K-9 and handler are certified together as a team once a year.

The dogs become part of the handler's family, as the handler is responsible for his or her dog 24 hours a day.

Typically, these dogs, often Labradors, German Shepherds, Belgian Malinois and even mixed breeds, have tenure of six to eight years in the program. When they retire from active duty the dogs often remain part of their handler's family.

In addition to their work keeping people, products and property safe, Boeing's K-9 teams actively participate in the community as goodwill ambassadors. Members of the K-9 unit make themselves available for demonstrations, safety fairs and other public events.

### FAMILY DOG TRAINING CENTER

#### DEMONSTRATION OF THE AKC'S CANINE GOOD CITIZEN (CGC) PROGRAM

Started in 1989, the CGC Program is designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. The Canine Good Citizen Program is a two-part program that stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic good manners for dogs. It is open to all dogs, regardless of heritage. All dogs who pass the 10-step CGC test may receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club.

AKC Certified CGC Evaluator Julene Cooper, Family Dog staff and students will demonstrate the basic obedience exercises and good manners that dogs (and their handlers) need to earn the title of Canine Good Citizen, discuss techniques for training dogs to pass the test and show how these skills apply to everyday life.

Family Dog Training Center is one of several facilities in the area offering classes and workshops that help owners prepare to take the test. Family Dog also offers CGC testing on a regular basis. These tests are open to everyone.

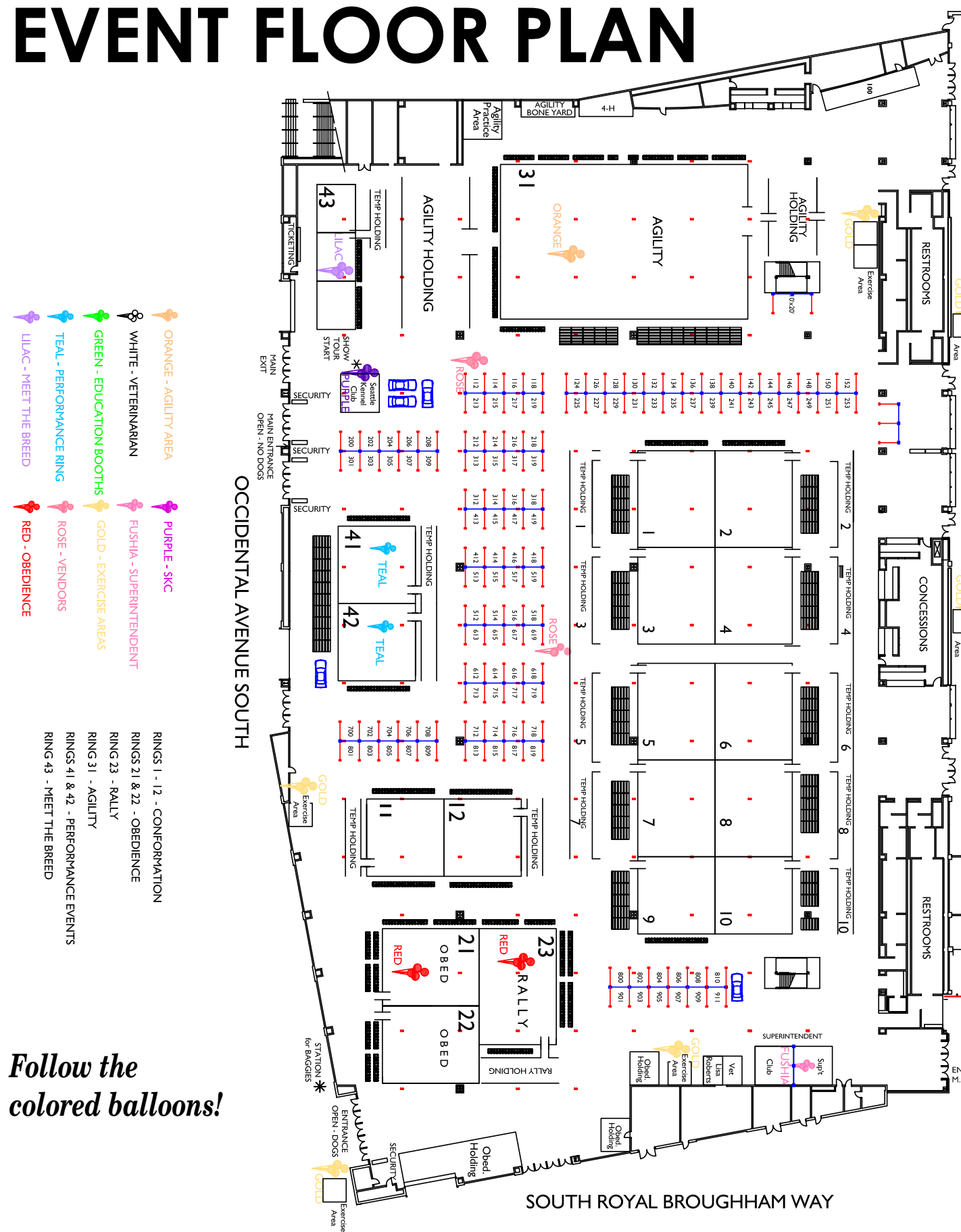
#### SOLVING DOG BEHAVIOR PROBLEMS
