

General Competitive Grants Program

During the 2015-2016 fiscal year, \$235,500 in grants were awarded through the General Grants program of the Catholic Foundation of North Georgia. These grants were provided by the following: General Fund, Goizueta Fund, The Care for the Elderly Fund, Community Services Fund, Nellie Dodd McAdam Endowment Fund, and the Conrads Family Education Fund.

Donor Advised Fund Distributions

The donor advised funds at the Catholic Foundation of North Georgia provided significant grants in the 2015-2016 fiscal year totaling \$146,300 to the organizations here at the advice of donors.



Charles Calder Cattanach, Jr. (1945 - 2016)Grant Recipient

Dedicated to preventing abortions, Charles Cattanach started Life Images, a mobile ultrasound ministry, in 2003. In the next dozen years, Mr. Cattanach performed more than 10,000 free ultrasounds for pregnant women who visited 13 crisis pregnancy centers in North Georgia. After seeing the image of their unborn child on Mr. Cattanach's ultrasound machine, many women made the choice to carry the child to term.

In 2010, the Catholic Foundation was pleased to award a grant to Life Images, which allowed Mr. Cattanach to upgrade his ultrasound machine and also to offset some of his operational costs.

Charles Cattanach was a member of Our Lady of the Mountains parish. He was active in the Knights of Columbus, Legion of Mary, and a past President of the Parish Council. He is survived by his wife, Linda Liles Williams Cattanach, children, step-children (including Father Paul Williams), grandchildren and extended family.



PARISH ENRICHMENT COMPETITIVE GRANTS PROGRAM

During the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the Catholic Foundation of North Georgia provided 20 Parish Enrichment Grants of \$1,000 each to the parishes listed below. Rev. Richard A. Kieran

(1940-2016)"God Calls. We Respond"

Fr. Richard Kieran was born and raised in Ireland. Recruited by the Archdiocese of Atlanta, Fr. Richard spent his 51 years as a priest here in Georgia - teaching, leading and serving.

As a young priest, Fr. Richard served as an educator. Later, he held the position of pastor at six different parishes across the Archdiocese.

Besides his assigned duties, Fr. Richard used his "free time" to minister to his flock in a variety of ways. For nearly 20 years, he was the spiritual director of the Atlanta Cursillo movement. In order to minister to the growing Hispanic Catholic population, Fr. Richard learned Spanish. He was a member of the Christian Council of Metropolitan Atlanta and he led pilgrimages to the Holy Land so that Catholics might deepen their understanding of Scripture.

Fr. Richard is also credited with helping a young David Talley (the future Bishop Talley) discern for the priesthood.

Father Richard's motto was: "God calls, we respond."

He certainly did.

Brother Priests Create a Lasting Legacy

Father John C. Kieran and Father Richard A. Kieran Endowment Fund It's no secret that our priests give freely of their time and talent. But did you know that we have priests who also give generously of their treasure?

In 2016, Irish-born priests, Rev. John Kieran and his brother, (the late) Rev. Richard Kieran created the Father John C. Kieran and Father Richard A. Kieran Endowment Fund. The fund will benefit the Catholic Foundation, and in turn, our local Catholic community. Fr. John said his brother wanted their gifts to help the Catholic Foundation of North Georgia "with no strings attached" to support the mission and operations of the Foundation. Fr. John said he knew that it would be invested well by trustworthy, knowledgeable people. In other words: "Give it to God, and let it be."

This wasn't Fr. John's first collaboration with the Catholic Foundation. As pastor of St. Pius X Fr. Richard Kieran (left) and Fr. John Kieran parish in Convers. Fr. John became one of the first pastors to establish a parish endowment fund with the Catholic Foundation. Once he learned about the Catholic Foundation, Fr. John immediately saw the value of the Foundation's work in supporting the long-term financial needs of parishes. He even contributed some of his own money to start the parish endowment fund.

A few years later, when the two brothers were looking for a way to benefit the Church in North Georgia, they decided to establish a fund named for their family. "We had great parents, so I want the Kieran name to be remembered in gratitude for their hard work in parenting us." Fr. John said his parents made great sacrifices in the face of many struggles for their children and sent all to college who wanted to go.

A founding donation of \$25,000 was provided by Fr. Richard to create the Father John C. Kieran and Father Richard A. Kieran Endowment Fund. Fr. John's gift to the endowment will be realized after he passes. Proceeds from the sale of his condo will be invested in the fund, per the bequest in Fr. John's will.

Fr. Richard Kieran died in November 2016, but his legacy will live on in the fund that the brothers created. Fr. John's hope for the future of the endowment is that "it continues to grow and realistically helps parishes."



Following in a Saint's Footsteps

Father Stanley Rother Endowment Fund for Catholic Charities Atlanta

Diane Hardin grew up in a German-Catholic community in Oklahoma which taught her values, morals and a strong work ethic. Her father was a farmer and philanthropist in the community. His best friend and cousin was Stanley Rother – future priest and martyr.

Father Stanley Rother

Stan felt called at an early age to join the priesthood. In 1968, a few years after his ordination, Fr. Stan volunteered to serve in a poor mission at Santiago Atitlan in the highlands of Guatemala during their long and bloody civil war. He learned their language, translated the New Testament for them, and assisted with education and farming. Diane remembers Fr. Stan coming back to Oklahoma during her childhood to gather used farm equipment to help his people plow their fields in days instead of months. Fr. Stan also founded a hospital, a school and a radio station near the mission.

After being warned that he was named on a death list, Fr. Stan went home to Oklahoma in January 1981. However, not wanting to be separated from his flock for Easter, Fr. Stan returned to Guatemala for Holy Week. In July 1981, masked men entered the rectory and shot Fr. Stan. He was declared a martyr by Pope Francis in December 2016 – the first recognized martyr born in the United States.

Father Stanley Rother Endowment Fund

In 2000, Diane moved to Atlanta to join her husband Hamilton, a Methodist. After they adopted two children, they realized that God too was an integral part of their family. When they began discussing their estate plan and their children's future, the Hardins knew they wanted to support both their children as well as make an eternal gift in thanksgiving to God. She said, **"We realized how critical it is for parents to establish family traditions toward sharing God's blessings."** They chose to divide their estate into three parts – one part for each child, and one part split between each of their faith traditions. "As we all know, we can't take it with us. We decided the next best alternative was to leave a portion of what God has given us in an endowment that will continue to help here on earth in perpetuity."

Diane and Hamilton reflected on Jesus' life, and knew that Jesus was especially present to those who were struggling. To support the work of Catholic Charities, the Hardins started an endowment at the Catholic Foundation of North Georgia, which they intend to grow through future gifts and a bequest in their will. They chose Catholic Charities as the endowment's beneficiary because of the work it does with Hispanics, immigrants and refugees. "It reflected Father Stan's legacy the best."

The Hardin family will be attending Fr. Stanley Rother's beatification on September 23, 2017 in Oklahoma City. "It's very emotional and overwhelming being related to someone on the path to sainthood," said Diane.

Walking behind Fr. Stan as a child – literally in his footsteps – has become a metaphor for Diane's life. "My parents taught me to give back to God what He gave to me," Diane said. "If all of us would pick just one passion for Christ, and give our time, talent and treasure to that passion, this world would be such a better place." She feels all of us should find a saint within our faith and follow in their footsteps with our hearts and actions. Diane feels blessed to have as her role model, her cousin, Fr. Stanley Rother.
