

#### Best in Show: Agave Nectar Feeding Bat - By Larry Petterborg

For many years I have been fascinated with bats, first as a biology major at the University of Utah and later as an admirer of the photography of Merlin Tuttle. About a year and a half ago, Kathy Adams Clark did a program at the Heard Nature Photographers Club. She offers workshops in Arizona where you can photograph both bats and hummingbirds using high speed flash techniques. We did song birds and hummingbirds in Madera Canyon and for the bats and more birds, we went down into the valley to "The Pond at Elephant Head". Bill Forbes lives on the property and provides the all of the triggers and flash equipment necessary to photograph feeding bats at night. Because Bill did not have any electronics that were compatible with my OM-D E-M1 Olympus camera, I had to barrow a Canon 5D from Kathy. We manually focused the cameras, set up the flowers and aimed the flash units during daylight. After a quick meal at sunset, we turned everything on and left the cameras going all night. The great thing is, the bats fly in to feed on the nectar in the agave flowers and trip the infrared beams taking their own pictures.

### Guest Speaker – "House of the Generals" – Dan Spigel

Dan Spigel, born and raised in Fort Worth, Texas, was a fine arts and drama major at the University of Texas, also studied at Texas Christian University, And the Hollywood film Institute. Dan Retired from commercial real estate. His passion has been photography and film making. In the 90's he announced he was going to write a screenplay.

Two years later, he started filming the movie "House of the Generals." He speaks from coast-to-coast on his endeavor of making an independent film. Dan stresses the importance of how family photographs through genealogy played an important role in the screenplay. It took Dan Spigel years to discover cousins who were among the Russian émigrés arriving in Dallas. From whom he learned about more about his mother's family and the story of her life In the General's house.

Dan wrote, produced and directed the movie, which is filmed entirely in Texas with the exception of an opening scene in Paris, France. Dan has appeared on national television and on June 16 he is appearing at the Plano Photography Club.

Filmmaker Dan Spigel, producer of the independent film, "House of the Generals," speaks on the importance of family history. He brings his family back to life through photographs to tell a historic tale of family survival beginning with the Russian revolution to the Holocaust, concluding with the miracle of the birth of Israel. As second generation Holocaust survivors, Dan and his wife, Tammy, have spoken to groups nationwide and appeared on national TV, discussing the 145-minute film.

Dan will begin the program by engaging the audience directly and then will proceed with a very short screen photo presentation on a video projector. The talk includes: why your photos are so important, the future and how the sky is the limit in photography, how photography engages all the arts, and how to be involved in all aspects of photography. Photographs led Dan and Tammy on a road of discovery for the last 20 years. He will talk about family they thought were lost and then discovered. Tammy will join Dan on the podium for questions and answers.


