LAST SERIES

- ▶ The Sky Sox split their series against the Iowa Cubs winning game one and four.
- ▶ In game four, the Sky Sox overcame an 8-3 deficit in the 9th inning, eventually winning the game 9-8 in 10 innings.

TODAY'S STARTER

- ▶ LHP **Josh Hader** will make his second Triple-A start tonight against the Omaha Storm Chasers.
- ▶ Hader entered the 2016 rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 11 Prospect in the Brewers organization and the No. 4 Prospect in the Brewers organization according to MLB.com.
- ▶ In 11 starts with Double-A Biloxi, Hader went 2-1 with a 0.95 ERA (6 ER/57.0 IP) with 73 strikeouts. He did not allow more than one earned run in any of his 11 starts.

▶ At the time of his promotion, Hader led the Southern League and ranked third in Minor League baseball in ERA and WHIP (1.00). He led the league in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (11.53) and fewest baserunners per 9.0 IP (9.47) while also tying for the league lead and ranked 5th in MiLB in strikeouts and ranked second in opponents average (.194).

▶ Hader was elected to the SL midseason All-Star team, his fourth Minor League All-Star bid after being elected to the South Atlantic League midseason team in 2013 while with Class-A Quad Cities and the mid and postseason All-Star squads of the California League while with Class-A Lancaster.

▶ Hader was acquired by the Brewers in the trade that sent OF **Carlos Gomez** to Houston 7/30/15.

PROSPECTING

▶ Eight of the Brewers' Top-30 prospects according to *Baseball America* are currently on the Sky Sox roster. Those players are SS **Orlando Arcia** (1), RHP **Jorge Lopez** (2), LHP **Josh Hader** (11), OF **Michael Reed** (17), INF **Yadiel Rivera** (21), RHP **Ariel Pena** (27), OF **Kyle Wren** (28) and RHP **Damien Magnifico** (30). Arcia (1), Lopez (3), Hader (4) and Reed (18) are also ranked among the organization's Top-20 prospects according to MLB.com's list.

THE MAN WITH THE GOLDEN GLOVE

- ▶ Shortstop **Orlando Arcia** entered the 2016 season as the top prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America* and is rated the No. 6 overall minor league prospect on MLB.com.
- ▶ Arcia was the Brewers Minor League Player of the Year in 2015 after hitting .307 with eight home runs, 37 doubles, seven triples, 74 runs, 69 RBI and 25 SB in 129 gms with Double-A Biloxi.
- ▶ Participated in the 2015 All-Star Futures Game in Cincinnati.
- ▶ Was named a Rawlings Minor League Gold Glove Award Winner following the 2015 season.
- ▶ Through his first 60 games of the season, Arcia is hitting .287 (70-for-244) with four home runs, 38 runs and 26 RBI. He has reached base safely in 49-of-60 games and has 19 multi-hit games.
- ▶ With the call-up of Rangers prospect **Nomar Mazara**, Arcia is now the youngest position player in the Pacific Coast League 21 years, 313 days).

PINA ON A HOT STREAK

- ▶ C **Manny Pina** has been on a tear of late hitting .378 (54-for-143) with four home runs, two triples, 16 doubles, 24 runs scored and 28 RBI over his last 38 games. During that span he's collected 17 multi-hit games including seven three-hit games.
- ▶ Pina ranks 4th in the PCL with a .354 batting average.
- ▶ He ranks 3rd in the PCL in cutting down opposing base runners having thrown out 39.6% (19-of-48) so far this season.

WHERE THERE'S A WILL THERE'S A WAY

- ▶ INF **Will Middlebrooks** has been on a tear of late, hitting .403 (25-for-62) with four home runs, seven doubles, 15 runs and 17 RBI over his last 16 games. In that span, he's collected nine multi-hit games and has raised his average from .195 to .258.

COMEBACK KIDS

- ▶ The Sky Sox lead the PCL with 10 wins when trailing after six innings so far this season. They also lead the league in wins when trailing after seven innings with nine. On the season, they also have 14 wins when the opponent scores first.

- Promoted to Colorado Springs on June 12.

RICK SWEET - MANAGER

BORN: SEPTEMBER 7, 1952, LONGVIEW, WA **RESIDES:** BUCKEYE, AZ **OPENING DAY AGE:** 63

Rick Sweet enters his third season in the Brewers organization and his second as manager of the Sky Sox. Prior to joining the organization in 2014 as manager of the Nashville Sounds, Sweet spent the previous nine seasons in the Reds organization as manager of the Louisville Bats (2005-11) and as the Reds' catching coordinator (2012-13).

The 2016 season marks his 26th year as a minor-league manager, a managerial career that dates back to 1987. As one of the most successful managers in Minor League Baseball, he owns a 1,731-1,671 (.509) career record and his 1,730 wins rank fifth-most among active minor league managers entering the 2016 season.

During Sweet's stint in Louisville from 2005-11, he became the franchise's all-time winningest manager with a 539-465 (.537) record. From 2008-10 his Bats won three straight International League West Division championships. He was named IL Manager of the Year in 2008 and 2009 and was *Baseball America's* 2010 Triple-A Manager of the Year. He was also recognized as Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 1994 while with Triple-A Tucson.



Sweet previously managed in the Seattle (1987-88), Houston (1989-95), New York - NL (1997), Montreal (1998, 2000), San Deigo (2001-03) and Detroit (2004) minor league systems. He served with the Astros as first base coach in 1996 and with the Expos as field coordinator from 1999-2000.

Sweet is a three-time Triple-A All-Star Game manager, having received the honor twice in the PCL with Tucson (1993) and Portland (2003), as well as with Louisville in the IL in 2009.

The former catcher had a nine-year playing career (1975-83) including three seasons in the majors with San Diego (1978), New York - NL (1982) and Seattle (1982-83). Following his playing days, Sweet became bullpen catcher for the Mariners (1984) and then spent the next two years as an advanced scout with Seattle (1985-86).

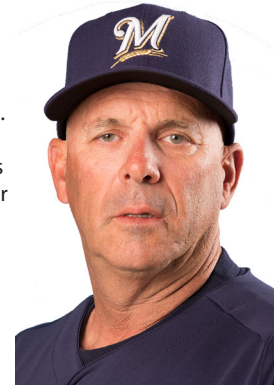

Coaching Highlights: Begins his fourth season as a coach in the Brewers organization and his second in Colorado Springs. Prior to joining the Brewers, he spent six seasons as a hitting coach in the San Diego Padres organization with Class-A Fort Wayne (2007), Rookie Peoria (2008-09), Class-A Lake Elsinore (2010) and Triple-A Tucson (2011-12). Before joining the Padres he worked in the Texas Rangers organization for two seasons as hitting coach at Class-A Bakersfield (2005) and as a manager of the rookie-level Arizona Rangers in 2006.

Playing Career: Skube was selected by the Brewers in the 13th round of the 1979 draft and played seven seasons as an outfielder/first baseman in the organization. He was named California League Rookie of the Year in the 1982-83 seasons, batting .250 with nine RBI. Prior to his professional career, Skube attended the University of Southern California from 1975-79, winning MVP honors for the Trojans in 1977 and helping lead USC to a national championship in 1978.

Coaching Highlights: Begins his second season as pitching coach for the Sky Sox and 13th overall season with the Brewers. He joined the organization as pitching coach at Class-AA Huntsville in 2004, spent seven seasons in the same capacity at Brevard County from 2005-11 and spent the last three seasons with Triple-A Nashville as their pitching coach. During the 2010 season, Dabney served as interim bullpen coach for the Brewers from April 23 to May 23. He took the place of Stan Kyles, who underwent surgery in April. Prior to joining the Brewers, Dabney spent five seasons as a pitching coach in the Texas Rangers organization with the Rookie GCL Rangers (1999), Class-A Savannah (2000), Class-A Charlotte (2001-02) and Class-A Stockton (2003). While with Charlotte, he coached in the Florida State League All-Star Game both seasons. His staff posted a league-best 3.40 ERA in 2002 and ranked third with a 3.37 ERA in 2001.



Playing Career: Dabney played nine minor league seasons as a pitcher with Chicago-AL (1988-93), Cleveland (1994) and Chicago-NL (1995-96) and finished his career in Taiwan (1997).
