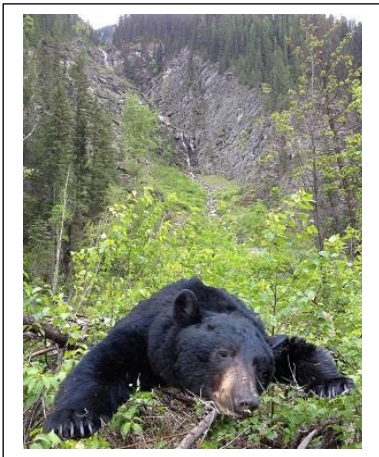
Another hunting season has almost come to an end.

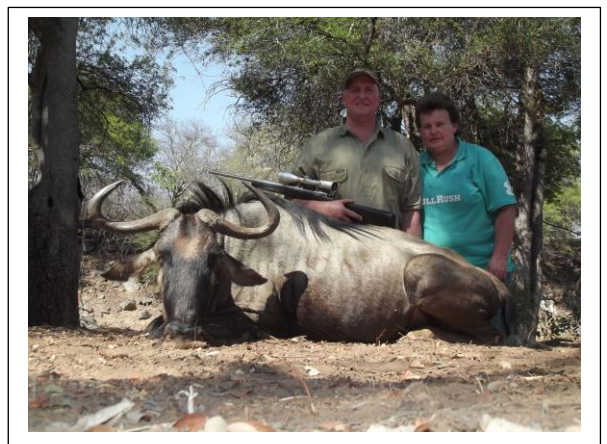
CONSERVATION IN AFRICA - A LITTLE NOTE
