

# **CURRENT SEASON TICKET HOLDERS**

Badger Select is the new seat change process for Wisconsin Athletics. Patrons will no longer write their seat change request on their application and have it reviewed by the athletic department. Upon receiving payment in full for season tickets and applicable contributions by each sports deadline, patrons will be assigned an individualized selection date and time based on donor rank, and years of purchase for non-donor season ticket holders.

Badger Select gives the season ticket holder the opportunity to view all available seats online and personally decide if they would like to move or add additional seats. Patrons will have the ability to:

- move and improve existing seats
- add additional season tickets
- purchase season parking (Football and Men's Basketball only)

Please note, Badger Select is an optional benefit available to all current and prospective season ticket holders. If you do not want to move your season tickets, or purchase season parking, you do not have to log in to Badger Select. Simply continue to order your season tickets by each sport deadline, as in prior years.

## PROSPECTIVE SEASON TICKET HOLDERS

Badger Select is the new seat change process for Wisconsin Athletics. Patrons who make a contribution and submit a request for season tickets by each sports deadline will be assigned an individualized selection date and time based on donor rank. Patrons will have the ability to:

- purchase new season tickets
- purchase season parking (Football and Men's Basketball only)

Badger Select is an annual process that gives patron's requesting new season tickets the ability to view available seats and season parking for purchase. Season ticket and parking is subject to availability during individualized selection time.

# **KEY POINTS FOR CURRENT SEASON TICKET HOLDERS**

Football, Men's Basketball and Men's Hockey

**ONE** Season ticket holders who do not want to change their current season ticket location or add additional seats to their account, nor want to select season parking, do not need to log in to Badger Select. To order season tickets, the same process of returning the ticket order form and contribution form (when applicable) by each sport's deadline remains the same. This can be done online, over the phone or via mail.

**TWO** After completing the order and contribution (if applicable) process for season tickets that you had the previous season, you will automatically be assigned an individualized selection date and time during Badger Select, based on donor rank, and years of purchase for non-donor season ticket holders. You then can choose to log in during that time, or any time after until the end of the process to view available seats at Camp Randall for Football and the Kohl Center for Men's Basketball and Men's Hockey.

**THREE** During the Badger Select process, as a current season ticket holder, you have the ability to purchase additional seats or relocate your current seats to other available seats. You also have the ability to purchase parking for Football and Men's Basketball based on your qualifying gift amount, and availability.

# KEY POINTS FOR PROSPECTIVE SEASON TICKET HOLDERS Football, Men's Basketball and Men's Hockey

**ONE** Become a donor to Wisconsin Athletics at a level of \$50 or more by each sport contribution deadline. (Football: April 20 and Men's Basketball: July 15. Men's Hockey no donation required to participate in Badger Select, however you do need to submit a season ticket request by June 15.)

**TWO** After becoming a donor, make a sport specific season ticket request. The request periods are as follows for each sport: Football: mid-March — April 20, Men's Hockey: mid-May — June 15, Men's Basketball: mid-June — July 15.

**THREE** After you have accomplished key points one and two, you then will be issued a personalized selection date and time to log onto Badger Select and select the best available seats in real-time.

**FOUR** Your personalized selection date and time is determined by your donor rank. Donor rank is determined first based on annual giving level, and second by priority points.

**FIVE** Season parking permits are also available for purchase during Badger Select for Football and Men's Basketball.

# STEPS TO BECOME A SEASON TICKET HOLDER

**ONE** Become a donor to Wisconsin Athletics (minimum \$50 contribution) by April 20, 2017.

**TWO** Complete the season ticket request application. Applications are published weekly online at UWBadgers.com and are also mailed weekly from mid-March to mid-April. Requests must be received by April 20, 2017.

**THREE** After you have accomplished steps one and two, you then will be issued a personalized selection date and time to log onto **BADGER SELECT** in June and choose the best available seats in real-time. You also have the ability to purchase season parking at this time.





# STEPS TO ORDER SEASON PARKING

**ONE** Patrons wishing to order season parking must be a current football season ticket holder and an active donor to Wisconsin Athletics (minimum \$50 contribution). To be considered an active donor, patrons must submit their contribution by April 20, 2017.

**TWO** Donors ordering multiple parking passes must qualify for each pass based on their annual giving level. (Example: Ordering two Zone A football parking passes would require a minimum annual giving level of \$10,000 [\$5,000 per pass]).

**THREE** Detailed information regarding the online selection process will be sent to all eligible donors and season ticket holders in mid-May with the online selection process taking place in early June, as part of **BADGER SELECT**.

# STEPS TO REQUEST NEW OR ADDITIONAL SEASON TICKETS

**ONE** Become a donor to Wisconsin Athletics (minimum \$50 contribution) by July 15, 2017.

**TWO** Complete the season ticket request application. Applications are published weekly online at UWBadgers.com and are also mailed weekly beginning in early June. Requests must be received by July 15, 2017.

**THREE** After you have accomplished steps one and two, you then will be issued a personalized selection date and time to log onto **BADGER SELECT** in July and choose the best available seats in real-time. You also have the ability to purchase season parking at this time.



#### **SEASON TICKET SEAT CHANGE OPPORTUNITY**

New in 2017, if you are a current season ticket holder and would like to change your current season ticket location, you will be able to do so through **BADGER SELECT**. It is important to note that you should still order your current season tickets by July 15 and donate applicable minimum per seat contributions associated with those seats to be eligible for **BADGER SELECT**. #### STEPS TO ORDER SEASON PARKING

**ONE** Patrons wising to order season parking must be a current basketball season ticket holder and an active donor to Wisconsin Athletics (minimum \$50 contribution). To be considered an active donor, patrons must submit their contribution by July 15, 2017.

**TWO** Donors ordering multiple parking passes must qualify for each pass based on their annual giving level. **Each patron is allowed a maximum of two Zone A permits, with the ability to purchase a third permit in Zone B or C, based on giving level and availability.** (Example: Ordering two Zone A basketball parking passes would require a minimum annual giving level of \$10,000 [\$5,000 per pass]).

**THREE** Detailed information regarding the online selection process will be sent to all eligible donors and season ticket holders in early August with the online selection process taking place later that month, as part of **BADGER SELECT**.

# STEPS TO REQUEST NEW OR ADDITIONAL SEASON TICKETS

**ONE** Patrons looking to purchase new season tickets must contact the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office by June 15, 2017 in order to receive a personalized date and selection time in the **BADGER SELECT** process, which will take place in late July. You will have the ability to log on and select the best available seats in real-time.




#### **SEASON TICKET SEAT CHANGE OPPORTUNITY**

# STEPS TO ORDER SEASON PARKING

**ONE** Current season ticket holders and donors will have the opportunity to order the same season parking location held for the 2016-2017 season. Patrons who are men's hockey season ticket holders may purchase parking for men's hockey on a season basis only. Men's hockey season parking requests are reviewed first based on lot availability, second on annual giving level and third on priority points within each annual giving level.

**TWO** Making a contribution does not guarantee allocation into a certain lot or certain zone. Patrons requesting multiple permits must qualify for each permit individually based on the annual giving level. (Example: Ordering two Zone A hockey parking passes would require a minimum annual giving level of \$100 [\$50 per pass]).



# **SPORTS PASS CHANGE IN 2017**

The Donor Sports Pass will still be offered as a benefit to 2017 donors to Wisconsin Athletics at the Coach's Club giving level and higher, however, a pair of general admission tickets for Volleyball and Women's Hockey will no longer be offered. This change is due to the increased number of season ticket holders and sellouts for these sports.

A pre-sale for Coach's Club giving level donors and higher for single game tickets will be offered moving forward. This exclusive sale will give priority for purchasing single game tickets for Volleyball and Women's Hockey. More information will be emailed out closer to each season.


#### 1<sup>ST</sup> - ANNUAL GIVING LEVEL


Donor rank is first determined by annual giving level. Below is the table of 2017 annual giving levels and includes the number of donors at each annual giving level as of December 31, 2016.

MEN'S BASKETBALL - Finished 3rd in the Big Ten standings, made 18th consecutive NCAA tournament appearance in 2016, reached the Sweet 16 for the 5th time in the last 6 seasons.

WOMEN'S TRACK AND FIELD - Had four athletes qualify for the 2016 NCAA Outdoor Championships, made program history with first NCAA field event champion and first Olympic appearance in a field event.

**GIFT PROCESSING** Contributions received in the Wisconsin Athletic Development Office are posted to the donor's gift record within three business days. Contributions made for annual priority seating benefits will be credited to the ticket holder on record.

**TAX INFORMATION** All contributions to Wisconsin Athletics are considered gifts to the University of Wisconsin and are credited at full value for purposes of the donor's gift record at the University of Wisconsin Foundation. Any contribution that entitles the donor to purchase tickets is 80% deductible for income tax purposes, according to IRS Code Section 170 (I). In addition, the IRS has ruled the 80% portion of your contribution is only tax deductible to the extent it exceeds the value of any additional benefits received. Individuals who make a contribution to Wisconsin Athletics will be issued a tax receipt by the University of Wisconsin Foundation.

WAIVER OF BENEFITS For 100% tax deductibility of your contribution, you must decline your right to receive any benefits at the time you make your contribution.

**DONOR ADVISED FUNDS** Please note the Division of Intercollegiate Athletics and the University of Wisconsin Foundation will no longer accept contributions subject to the 80% rule from any private foundation, donor advised fund or IRA rollover. Contributions from those sources may only be applied to a Wisconsin Athletics 100% deductible fund. Please consult your tax advisor for more information.
