



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# THE WITNESS STONES PROJECT



Thank you to our honorary chairs Elizabeth Devine, retired history teacher, Tracey Wilson, town historian and retired history teacher, and Denise deMello retired Library Media Specialist. We applaud their work with the Witness Stones Project, a community-based partnership between the Noah Webster House and the West Hartford Public School system. The Foundation for WHPS will continue to support the participation in this project for all WHPS 8th grade students. Through examination of actual local historical records and artifacts, students will develop interpretations in an effort to tell the stories of real persons that had been enslaved within the area of what is now West Hartford. In addition to examining local historical records and artifacts in the classroom, the project will include an installation of a "witness stone" for each of the individuals studied. These stones will become permanent markers within the West Hartford community to commemorate the individuals remembered and to represent the work done by students to bring their stories back to us.







