Some of these same retailers now know that sponsoring an S3DA™ club means increased foot-traffic, sales, and family involvement which bodes well for an expanded profit margin.

The 2020 competition year will be unprecedented and absolutely one for the record books! With the exponential expansion of the S3DA™ member base, we've seen new challenges presented due to simply outgrowing the venues for many of our Regional, State and National Events. 2020 will include the Vegas National Championship held in conjunction with NFAA's "The Vegas Shoot," the S3DA™ Indoor National Championship (held in conjunction with NFAA) will be moving to Louisville, KY to the Kentucky International Convention Center (KICC). This will

be a new venue for both S3DA™ and NFAA and will present some exciting opportunities for our families. The Outdoor Target Nationals will now be a two-day event in London, KY and for the first time ever, S3DA™ will conduct a stand-alone national event when the 2020 3-D Nationals are held in Rend Lake, Illinois! This is a massive undertaking with collaboration between S3DA™ and the Rend Lake Area Tourism Commission. This will open many exciting opportunities for our families from outdoor recreation to conservation activities. You will not want to miss it.

Also, NEW for 2020 will be an entire series of national events held in the Western United States. We understand that it can be a hardship for our families to travel all the way across the country for a tournament so we're bringing the tournament closer to you. The new Western Indoor Nationals will be held at the Pete Shepley Center in Tucson, Arizona, the Western Outdoor Target Nationals will be held at the Easton Archery Center in Salt Lake City, Utah and the Western 3-D Nationals in Durango, Colorado. These new Western events will bring a higher level of competition within reach of our Western S3DA™ members. Beginning in 2019 and continuing to 2020, S3DA™ has also placed a renewed focus on conservation efforts with the appointment of a National Conservation Outreach Coordinator and partnering with the Archery Trade Association (ATA) to get Explore Bowhunting Kits to S3DA™ clubs/teams nation-wide. Once a club is registered as a Conservation Club (e-mail holly@s3da.org to do this) they can participate in conservation related activities and win some awesome prizes.

When the competition year winds down, we encourage all our clubs to participate in outdoor recreation and hunting activities in whatever manner they choose. In the United States, we have an amazing legacy of target shooting, hunting and conservation with archery as its foundation and the best way to preserve it is to get involved. This is truly a one size fits all program that can move youth archers from beginning to experienced and transition them from our program into not only collegiate and competitive archery but into all aspects of hunting, conservation and outdoor recreation.





Trey died tragically on August 31st, 2015 due to injuries suffered in a motorcycle accident while traveling home from college just one week after returning home from the Classic. The Trey Spencer Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2016. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to deserving individuals enrolling in undergraduate studies in community colleges, colleges or universities who are active in both S3DA™ and ASA.
