## Fourteen Bed Rock Principles of HHIM Church

1. Commitment to Worship: Worship is encountering God in experiences that deepens a Christian's faith and strengthens him or her for service. Worship of God in Christ should be at the center of all else the church is and does.
2. Commitment to Witness: Our number one goal is and will always be the salvation of the lost. All Christians, the entire church, is to be witnesses of Christ's saving grace. We will preach and teach biblical mandates to achieve success in all these areas. We will also make available the necessary classes, groups, resources, and qualified individuals to help each willing member achieve holistic improvements.
6. Commitment to Youth Empowerment: We will empower youth in our church and community with the Word of God, programs, resources, training, and state of the art facilities to meet the needs of our youth.
7. ### Men

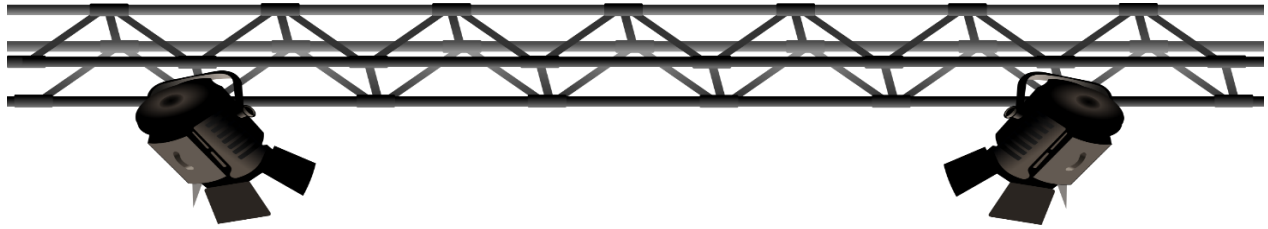
1. Men must wear black slacks, trousers or sweat pants

1. Women must wear black slacks, trousers or sweat pants
2. Women must wear black shirt
3. Woman must wear black brassiere
4. Woman must wear black undergarment
5. Woman must bring towel & shower flip flops
6. Woman must bring change of dry clothing
7. Bring a lock to secure items in locker room during baptism (Optional)
