- Backstroke ledges will be available for 11-12 and 13-14 age groups.

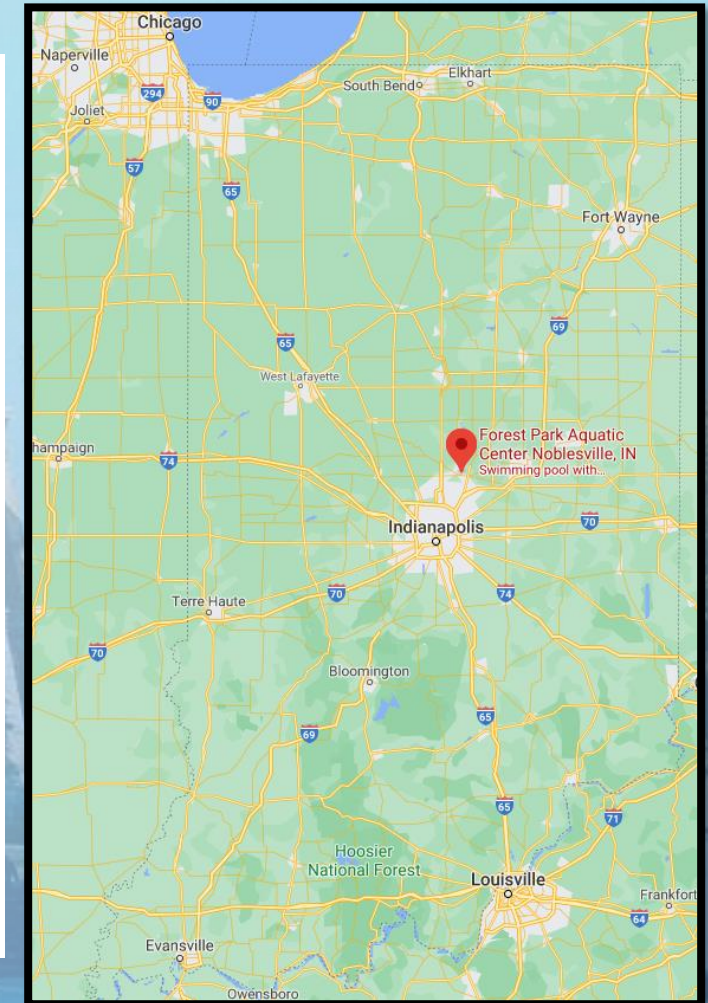
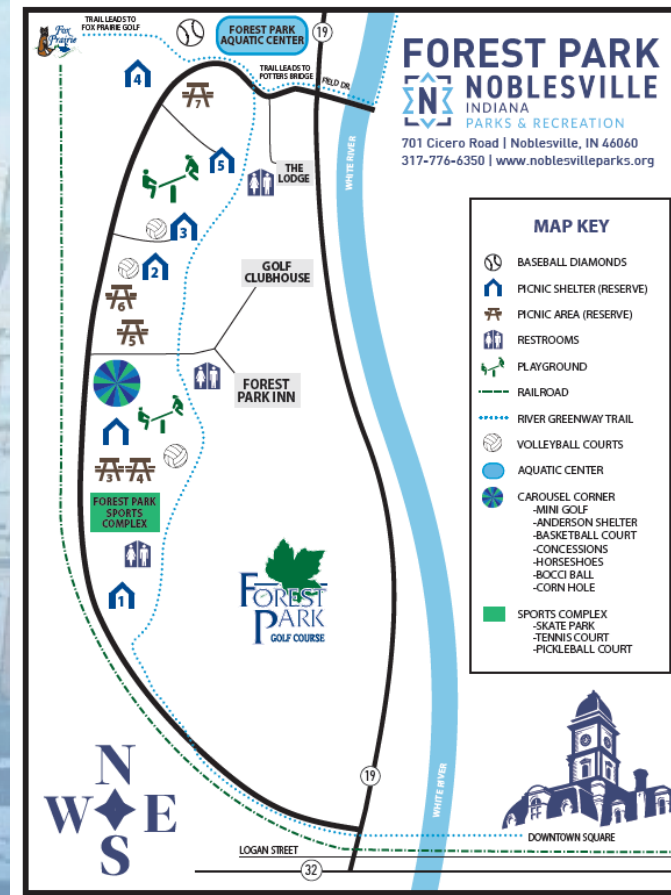

## Directions

Forest Park is located off of State Road 19 (Cicero Road) in Noblesville. Enter the park through the North entrance (Forest Park Drive). Follow Forest Park Drive to the Aquatic Center entrance. The Forest Park Aquatic Center is located at the North end of the Park near the Babe Ruth baseball fields.





# PARKING



## Parking

Free Parking is available throughout Forest Park.

The Forest Park Aquatic Center and Babe Ruth Baseball Complex share a large parking lot adjacent both facilities.

Parking is also available along Forest Park Drive in addition to several other paved parking lots scattered throughout the park.

Please do not park in unauthorized areas.





# POOL CONFIGURATION AND PROCEDURES

## ENTERING THE FACILITY



Athletes, Coaches, Volunteers and Officials will enter the facility via the gate located on the southeast side of the main building (nearest the Concession Stand and Baby Pool).

Athletes will need to check in the first time they enter the facility to claim their deck pass. Each additional time they will be able to show this pass for admittance.

Coaches and Officials will be required to sign in for each session and show credentials the first time they have entered the facility. At that time they will be provided an Age Group State Deck Pass for the remainder of the meet.

Volunteers will be required to check in for each session they have committed to.

No one will be permitted to enter the athlete, coach, volunteer and official entrance without proper credentials.





# POOL CONFIGURATION AND PROCEDURES

## ENTERING THE FACILITY



Spectators will enter the facility via the gate located on the Southwest side of the main building (nearest the Babe Ruth Baseball Complex).

We request the number of spectators to be limited to one spectator per athlete.

No one will be permitted to enter the athlete, coach, volunteer and official entrance without proper credentials.





# POOL CONFIGURATION AND PROCEDURES



## Spectators

- Bleachers have been procured for the meet with capacity to seat 500 spectators.
- No spectator tents will be permitted; however, The Forest Park Aquatic Center has large umbrellas and deck chairs which will be made available. Spectators may bring personal chairs, but they must remain behind the bleachers.

# POOL CONFIGURATION AND PROCEDURES



**Athlete Only Locker Rooms** – will be provided and are located in the main building. The locker rooms were remodeled in 2020.

**Restrooms** – separate restrooms for officials, coaches, volunteers and spectators are located on the west side of the main building. These restrooms were remodeled in 2020. Additional public restrooms are located throughout Forest Park.

**Athlete Camping** – will be made available in the grass lot located in the Northwest area of the facility. Athletes are also permitted to camp in Forest Park, but are responsible for ensuring they can hear event announcements.

**Clerk of Course** – will be utilized for all 10 and under events.

**Coach Viewing Area** – A series of tents will be provided along the East side of the competition pool for coaches to view their athletes' events. The intent of this area is for coaches to come and go as their athletes compete. No sitting or camping will be permitted in this area.

**Coaches and Officials Hospitality** – will be provided throughout the meet. The hospitality areas will be located as shown on the diagram to the right.





# POOL CONFIGURATION AND PROCEDURES



## Facility Overview

- 10 lane x 50-meter long course Olympic pool
  - New (2020) 6" diameter Competitor brand lane lines
  - Backstroke starting wedges for 11-12 and 13-14 age groups
- 7 lane x 25 yard heated diving pool for warm-up / cool-down
- Zero entry toddler pool and spray pad which will be open during the meet.
- Recent Upgrades
  - Renovated (2020) men's and women's locker rooms and restrooms
  - High quality sound system with remote microphone technology

**Awards Pictures** – An area will be setup near the circle drive for parents to take pictures of their athletes with their awards. The final location of this has not been determined, but will be communicated during the meet.

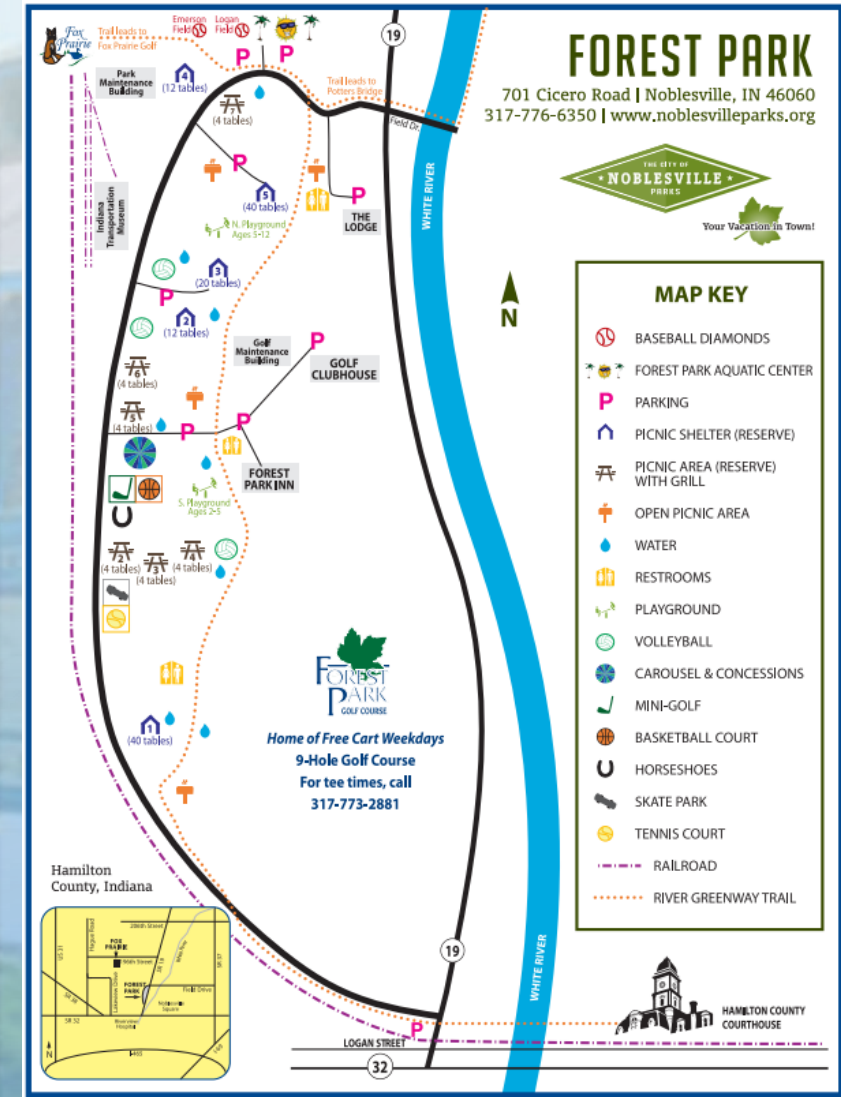

# FOUL WEATHER CONTINGENCY AND COMMUNICATION PLAN

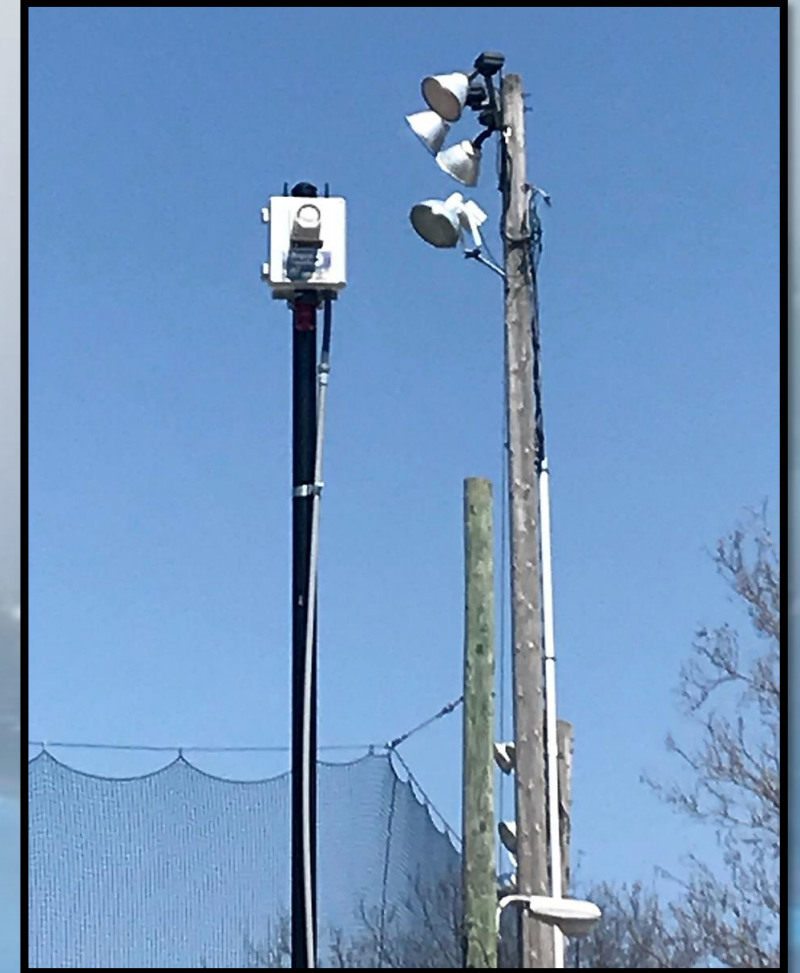


## Session Delays

- In the event of foul weather which delays the meet, every effort will be made to complete the session and preserve the preliminary/finals championship format.
- The Forest Park Aquatic Center is equipped with a lightening detection system. If lightening is detected within 10 miles of the facility, an audible horn will sound. In this situation the pool and deck will be cleared. If lightening is not detected within 10 miles for 30 minutes, the meet may resume.
- Indiana Swimming is responsible for the operation of the meet and will make the ultimate decision on whether sessions will be delayed, rescheduled or scored as timed finals.
- The Forest Park Aquatic Center features lights which will be utilized in the mornings and evening if needed.

## Communication

- In the event of a weather delay, verbal communication will be provided via the public address system.
- Coaches will receive regular communications via an app which will provide instructions and regular updates on the situation.
