

As We Gather...

In our Gospel today, Bartimaeus calls out, "Jesus have mercy on me." Those around him yelled, "Be silent"; however, Bartimaeus repeated, "Jesus have mercy on me." "The Jesus Song" by Tom Booth is a simple song that combines two prayers: The Jesus Prayer and The Chaplet of Divine Mercy. These prayers echo Bartimaeus's testimony of being healed by Jesus after several cries for help.

The Jesus Prayer:

"Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner."

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy:

"For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world."




CARDINAL JOHN FOLEY CATHOLIC SCHOOL Students Honor our Mercy Tradition
