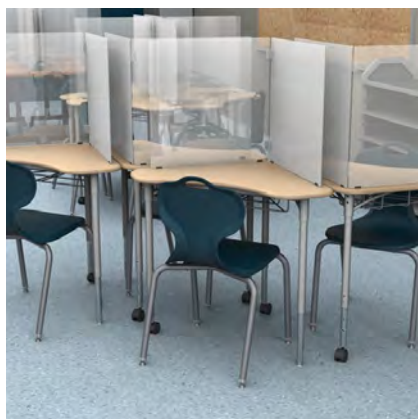

## Classrooms

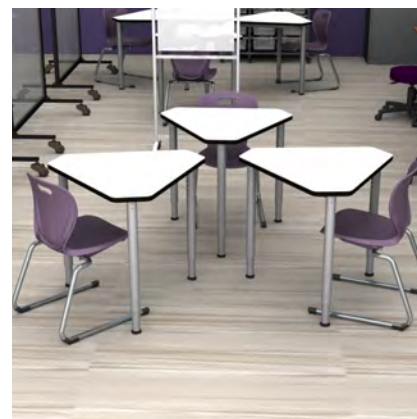

## Labs & Makerspaces

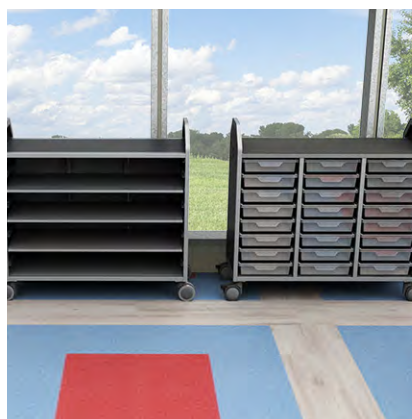

## Early Learning Classrooms

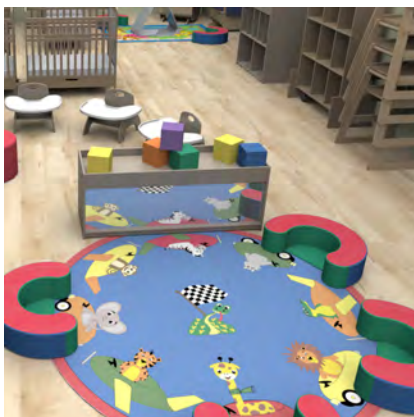

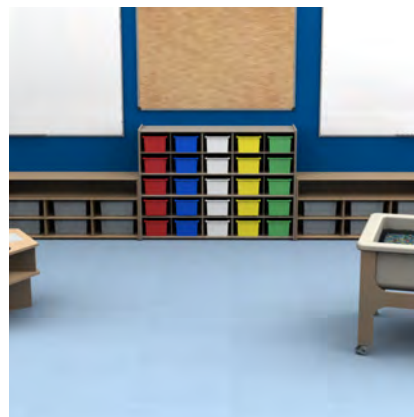

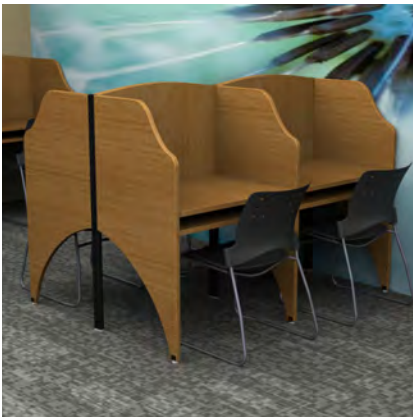


## Library & Media Centers

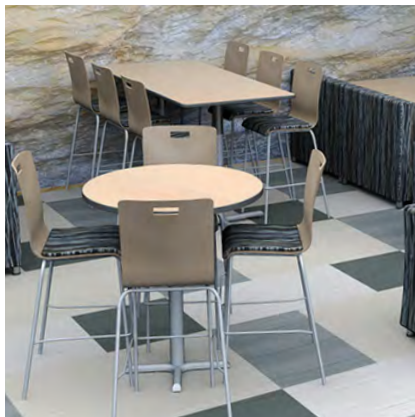


## Cafeterias

It's essential to have packs of disposable masks always on-hand to protect students and staff while remaining compliant with local health and safety regulations.



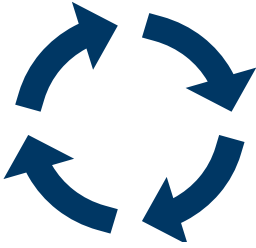
### **UV Disinfection Lights** ▶

UV disinfection lights like portable UV wands are highly effective at sanitizing high-touch items and surfaces in seconds without the use of chemicals or wipes.



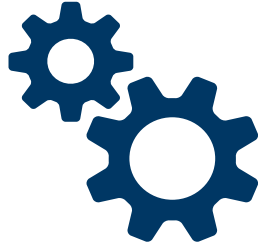

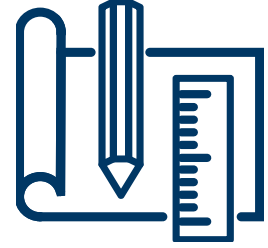

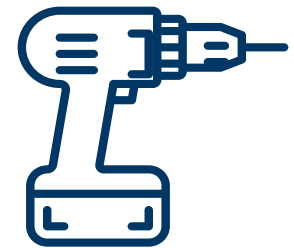
