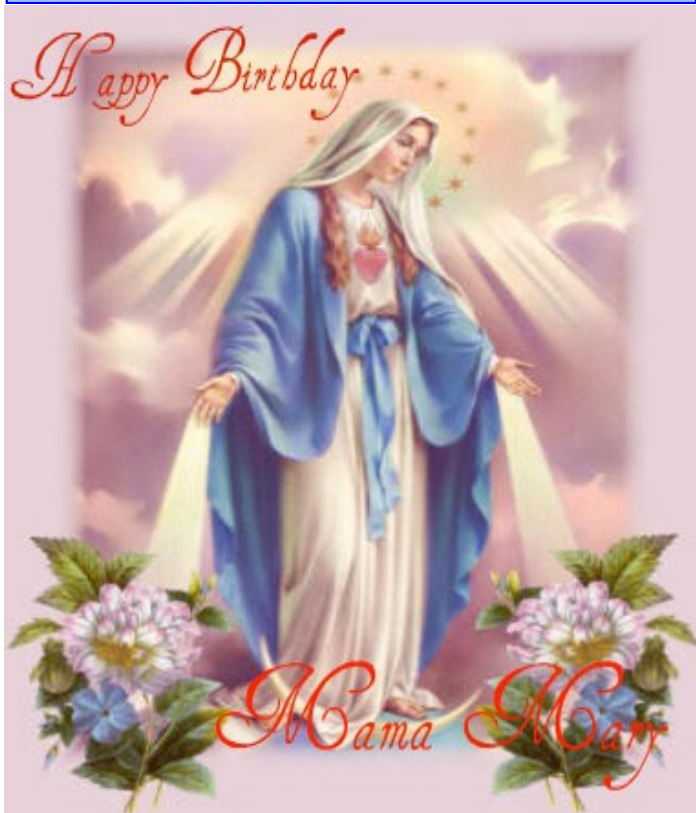

PARISH REGISTRATION:

All parishioners should be registered. Parishioners over the age of 18 should register independently of their parents. It is necessary to be a registered parishioner for at least 3 months in order for us to provide testimonial letters. Kindly notify the Parish Office of any changes.

BAPTISMS: Second Saturday of the month at 1 PM. Please call the Parish Office to make arrangements prior to making social plans. **Parents & godparents must attend instructions** on the first Sunday of the month after 10:30 AM Mass in the Msgr. Wujek Room or Chapel.

MARRIAGES: Must be registered, practicing and contributing parishioner. Arrangements should be made at least **one year in advance, prior to making social plans.**

SICK CALLS: Arrangements for communion calls to the sick can be made by calling the Parish Office. Please notify the Parish Office when a parishioner is in the hospital.

For emergencies, call anytime.

PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM (PREP): Instruction in the Catholic Faith for children in grades 1-8. Classes are held from September to April on Monday afternoons from 4:30 - 5:45 PM. Please contact the Parish Office for further information.

9/11 MEMORIAL

This year on the 20th anniversary of September 11th a monument will be dedicated to all who lost their lives.

The unveiling of the monument will take place at **8:00 am on September 11, 2021 at the Fire House on Jackson Street.** Fr. Michael Gromadzki will be presiding at the benediction. All are invited to attend this solemn moment.

This day does not pass in the calendar without our remembering. We remember images of death and destruction. Images that human eyes were never meant to see. We remember words our ears were never meant to hear, the tender last words of husbands and wives who would never embrace again. We imagine the feeling of emptiness in the arms of children who at the end of the day could not find mom or dad for their welcome home hug. We remember our own feelings of emptiness as our sense of security, as our own confidence in the predictable order of life and work was radically shaken.

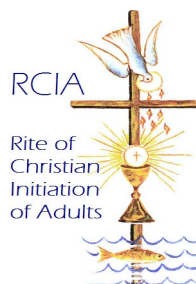
Students transferring from another Religious Education program must have a transfer letter indicating grade level and sacramental information.


