

### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AVAILABLE ON January 27th , 2020

Alive! In Christ is first-come, first served for all new awards and younger siblings that may be eligible, so we encourage you to apply as early as possible.

Approximately 400 new awards will be available for the Archdiocese

The application <u>deadline</u> for Beyond Sunday, Catholic Families Tuition Assistance (CFTA), and the Parish Employees Endowment Fund (PEEF) is February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Any family who would like to be considered for these programs, even if you are applying for requalification, must apply between

January 27<sup>th</sup> and February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

Up to 155 new elementary school awards in the Archdiocese and 50 new high school awards will be available in Beyond Sunday for Catholic families registered in a parish. Siblings attending the same school are not eligible in this program.




