#### **Animal Identification**

NEW THIS YEAR: In 2022, all market animals (except poultry), beef/dairy feeders, horses and dogs coming to the fair will need to be entered in 4honline and identified as a project animal.

DEADLINE: Market Steers & Baby Beef projects deadline was Jan. 22. All other animals will need to identified in 4Honline by June 1. Deadline for rabbits will be in August with exact date to be announced.

There will be no in person tagging for sheep or goats this year. There will be no paper tagging forms. Sheep, Goats, Hogs, Beef/Dairy Feeders will:

- pick up their animal(s) tag at the Extension Office or the Senior Fair office
- · tag their animal
- enter the animal(s) and upload pictures in their 4Honline profile or through the FFA link

We realize this is a new procedure and we at the Extension Office will be happy to assist you with this process should you have questions while entering your animal.

The Ohio Department of Agriculture requires that all poultry not used for family consumption (sold at the fair or to other private individuals) must be processed at a state licensed poultry processor (i.e. Buckeye Poultry or Pleasant Valley Poultry).

The Poultry Committee has reserved processing appointments for broilers on Wednesday, September 28th as well as broilers and turkeys on Thursday, September 29th at Buckeye Poultry. #### **Quality Assurance Training**

#### **NEW THIS YEAR:**

Anyone bringing a living, breathing animal to the fair must attend Quality Assurance training. This will be done a the county level on numerous dates throughout March-May.

Sign up now and get this requirement checked off!

As an OPTION, 4-H and FFA members over 12 years of age may test out of their annual quality assurance (QA) program. Youth ages 12-14 who pass the QA test can test out of their annual QA program for up to 3 years. Youth ages 15-18 years who pass the QA test can test out of their annual QA program permanently. These ages are as of January 1, 2022 – a youth's 4-H age.

Some common errors:

- Pet Rabbit: Still Project only. Rabbit does not go to fair.
- Baby Beef is a full grown market animal project in which the animal is sold at the fair.
- 117BF Beef Feeders are calves from a Beef breed that will weigh approximately 250-800# at fair.
- 117DF Dairy Beef Feeders are calves from a Dairy breed that will weigh approximately 250-800# at fair.
- 140 Swine breeding project: Must enroll if entering a swine breeding class in the State Fair. It is a still project only for Ashland Fair.
- Volunteers: Choose club volunteer if associated with a club. All committee members, please choose program volunteer.

## Leasing of Breeding Animals to show in 4-H/FFA

The purpose of a lease is to provide additional positive learning experiences for the 4-H/FFA member that would have otherwise been unavailable. To provide a youth with the opportunity of participating in the 4-H/FFA Breeding Animal program when one or more of the following conditions exists:

- 1. The 4-H/FFA member does not have a suitable long care opportunity.
- 2. The family is unable to purchase a breeding animal.

Leasing MARKET animals is NOT permitted.

Leasing of BREED RABBITS is NOT permitted.

If a 4-H/FFA member is leasing a breeding animal to show at the county fair, they must have a signed lease agreement on file.
