Chapter Three of the Book of Ecclesiastes tells us "There is an appointed time for everything, and a time for every affair under the heavens. A time to be born, and a time to die...a time to plant and a time to uproot the plant...a time to seek and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away."

I have always been a creature of habit and usually avoided change in my life, as Doreen, Rob and Amanda can attest! However even I need to makes changes on occasion. Sometimes big ones!

Just prior to observing my 10th anniversary of receiving the Sacrament of Holy Orders in May, I requested that Cardinal Sean O'Malley end my assignment to the Medford Catholic Collaborative. My request was granted as of August 01, 2018. I have spent the 10 years since ordination at St Joseph, then Saint Francis of Assisi and then both parishes as a collaborative. August 1st was the ninth anniversary of my transfer to Saint Francis of Assisi!

These 10 years during which we have journeyed together will always remain prominent in my heart and my memories. With many of you I have laughed, prayed, celebrated sacraments, wept together at wakes, funerals and graves. For all of those experiences I am most thankful.

In May, I joined the Very Reverend James A. Flavin, Episcopal Vicar of the Central Region of the Archdiocese of Boston as his Deacon Assistant. His office is located at St. Brigid Parish in South Boston. Some of the Saint Francis of Assisi folks may remember Father Flavin, as he would occasionally fill in on weekends at Saint Francis of Assisi some years ago.

Effective on August 1, 2018 my new assignment was also effective. I have been assigned as Deacon to the South Boston – Seaport Collaborative. This includes Saint Monica-Saint Augustine, Saint Peter, and Saint Vincent de Paul Parishes in South Boston as well as the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Voyage in the Seaport. The Shrine is the first new church built in the Archdiocese of Boston in 60 years. I encourage you to visit the Shrine!

As I say goodbye, please know that I will continue to pray for you each day and for your loved ones, living and deceased. As always, I ask that you keep my family and me in your prayers as well, especially as I begin my new assignment.


