### LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

We often wrongly conclude that because we may be more avant-garde, contemporary, politically sensitive, and untraditional, we are somehow more in the light than others. People tend to prefer darkness more than light, even the most spiritually sensitive among us. The light always carries with it the richness of God's mercy and compassion which see beyond ideologies and concepts to relationships that cultivate life, earthly and eternal. Every hand of compassion and mercy extended to a human being must always point back to God. The call always involves ordering our lives in accord with our truth and essence of being. ## Stewardship Corner

There was a time not too long ago that I shied away from the light. Now, I didn't literally stay indoors or avoid the sun. This figurative shying away from the light was an internal battle. One that I think we all face throughout our lives in different ways. My battle was avoiding the light of God and not allowing that radiant light to pierce my inward being. It is when we turn in on ourselves that sin worms its way into the core of who we are. It is slow and gradual that sometimes we miss it. But God so desperately wants to be close to us and set His light within us. It was when I started understanding God's immense love for me (and accepting it!) that I was able to stop turning in on myself and focus on God's deep abiding love. And God wants each of us to fully accept His light and love in order to bring others to Him! On top of that, the line from today's second reading highlights that it is not by our doing: "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not from you; it is **the gift of God**" (emphasis added). This work of saving, it is a gift from God, too. All is gift! Relationships, food, vehicles, home, kids, spouse, money, recreation, work, etc. Stay in God's light (accept His deep love for you!) and you'll begin to see everything in your life as a gift.

### Fun Facts for Catholic Kids of ALL Ages Explain Jesus' death in an age-appropriate way.



You do not need to dwell on the gruesome details of crucifixion, which can upset and frighten younger children, but you should introduce Jesus' death. Emphasize the reasons for Jesus' sacrifice that he gave up his earthly life so that believers could have eternal salvation.

- † For preschoolers, stick to saying that Jesus died and rose from the dead for us.
- † For younger school kids, add in some more details about the death and resurrection. Note that it shows that death is not the end, but rather the beginning of eternal life.
- † Younger teens and beyond can better handle the details of crucifixion and comprehend the symbolism of death and rebirth in relation to mankind's salvation.
