55 years of country-rock, 1965-present:

Creating a new American musical genre--how two immensely popular genres of music merged to create a timeless style, uniquely American in every aspect. This eight-week class will cover the historically significant country-rock movement which started in LA in 1965 and spread across the country, changing the musical landscape of popular music. We will explore how two roots-oriented genres--country music and rock and roll--borrowed from each other and merged to create a new genre which has since spawned many sub-genres, each with its own unique approach to country-rock. We will look at several artists and their key albums, including: The Everly Brothers, The Byrds, the Buffalo Springfield, Gram Parsons, the Flying Burrito Brothers, Crosby, Stills and Nash, Neil Young, Poco, the new Riders of the Purple Sage, Pure Prairie League, Rick Nelson, the Eagles, Linda Ronstadt, Emmylou Harris and others, as well as trends in instruments, arrangements and lyric-writing that made up the songs.
