

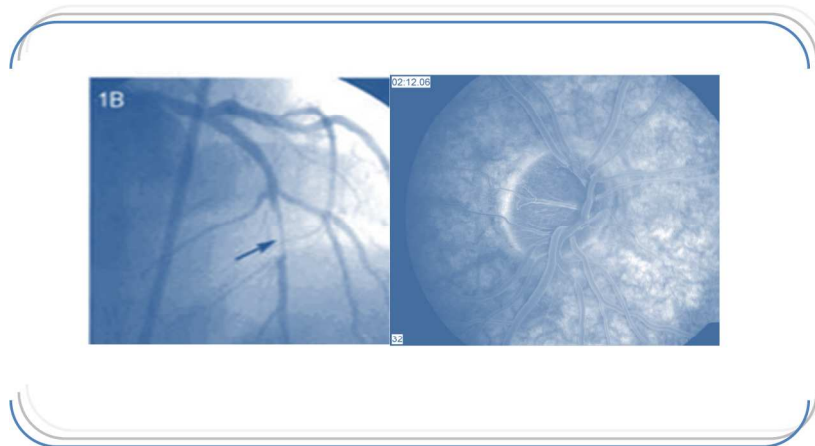

i - MED-Project, a joint project from MEDCAMER and CDN.G

Improving Medical Education by Diaspora Engagement

The purpose of the project is to make close cooperation and collaboration between medical specialists and specialised staff in the Diaspora possible in two chosen teaching hospitals in Cameroon.

We want to:

- cover the need for further education and training
- improve “on-the-job training”
- improve facilities with customised sustainable “minimally invasive” medical equipment as well as the training to use this equipment
- introduce fast “point of care” diagnostic possibilities
- optimise the management and organisation of clinical procedures and process in practice.

Activities:

The focus of the program is to train doctors in the use of simple, modern, “minimally invasive” diagnostic and therapeutic instruments such as sonography, sonographically controlled puncture, electrocardiography and endoscopy.

A two-week further education event is planned in 3-month intervals with:

I. Workshops and seminars

II. Special certified courses lasting for several days for carers in institutions (to use and assist in the use of modern medical equipment). Courses for ECG, sonography and endoscopy.

III. Joint visits and operations on patients (at each location)

IV. Extraction of 30 specialised doctors (faculty) each year from the Diaspora, who organise and manage the further education events with their colleagues in Cameroon.

The specialised doctors of the Diaspora are obligated to work / teach for at least 2 weeks every 24 months within the scope of the project in Cameroon and conclude a volunteer contract.

Sustainability

We aim to educate sufficient doctors and nurses in each location after 3 years, so that, above all, ECG, sonography and endoscopy become a routine diagnostic and therapeutic procedure.

They should be able to handle the instruments safely, servicing should be guaranteed and, above all, they should be installed for the hospitals economically and profitably.

These two hospitals should serve as benchmarks for other hospitals.

After 4 years the location of the project will be changed and the project will then be continued in 2 other hospitals in other areas of the country.

The project should continue running as a CME program for as long as enough Diaspora doctors can be mobilised.
