Jesus's Presence Always a Blessing

The Week of prayer for Christian unity is January 18 – 25. We are called to reflect upon the importance of relationships this week. So we focus more on the similarities with other people than the differences. Best example is Jesus Christ the Word Incarnate who never sees a stranger in his life. "As a bridegroom rejoices in his bride so shall your God rejoice in you." (Is 62:5). Our God is coming to celebrate the life with us, to lead us to complete happiness.

Today's Gospel presents one of the best known miracles in Jesus' ministry, the changing of water into wine at Cana. The presence of the Lord at this marriage feast has resulted in our associating Cana with Catholic marriage. Mary, the mother of Jesus takes the initiative. Jesus' mission is her own mission. Jesus and his mother inspire us to be available to the service of others, making every family part of his family, God's family and God's children. The challenge is how to love our brother and sister with all of our differences.

The spouses need Jesus and Mary when their dreams are gone, mutual love seems dried up, the relationship becomes boring, and raising the children becomes a burden draining all their energy. The awareness of the presence of Jesus and Mary in the family will encourage parents to create an atmosphere of prayer, Bible-reading, mutual love and respect which will eventually lead to unity and peace.

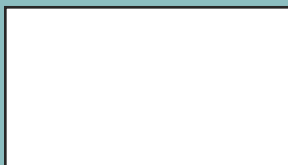

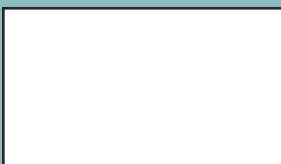


