- Won 14 of its last 17 games.
- Fourth nationally in FT attempts (738).
- Eighth nationally in rebound margin (+9.8).
- 15th nationally in rebounds per game (42.4).
- 26th nationally in scoring defense (56.8).
- 23 of the Wolfpack's 26 wins this season have been by 12 or more points.
- Including the NCAA first-round win over Elon, NC State has held nine of its opponents to 50 points or fewer this season.

SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS (34-1, #1 SEED)

- Ranked fifth in the RPI.
- Ranked fourth in the AP and USA Today polls.
- Third nationally in scoring margin (+26.5) and turnover margin (+8.4).
- Sixth nationally in 3FG percentage (.393).
- 10th nationally in scoring offense (82.1).
- 16th nationally in scoring defense (55.6).
- Teaira McCowan ranks third nationally in rebounds per game (13.3).
- Last two losses came to South Carolina in the 2017 NCAA Championship game and the 2018 SEC Championship game.
- Ended UConn's 111-game winning streak in the 2017 Final Four.

SERIES HISTORY (TIED 1-1)

- In the last meeting between the teams, Mississippi State defeated NC State 71-58 in Cancun, Mexico, on Dec. 21, 2001.
- The teams met in the first round of the 1999 NCAA Tournament, with NC State earning a 76-57 win in Lubbock, Texas.

NC STATE IS MOST SUCCESSFUL THIS SEASON WHEN...

- Leading at the half (23-1).
- It outscores opponents in the paint (17-1).
- Shooting 40 percent or higher from the field (16-1).
- Holding opponents to less than 40 percent shooting (21-2).
- Four or more players score in double figures (15-2).
- Its bench outscores the opponent's bench (14-2).
- Games are decided by 10 points or more (23-3).
- It scores more fast break points than the other team (15-3).
- Hitting five or more three-pointers (22-5).
- Outrebounding the opposition (22-6).

GOING TO KANSAS CITY. KANSAS CITY, HERE WE COME

The last time NC State played an NCAA Tournament game in Kansas City, Mo., it was in the 1998 Final Four. Though the season ended with an 84-65 loss to Louisiana Tech, it was widely viewed as one of the best seasons in program history with a 25-7 record and six wins over ranked opponents, including one over UConn in the Elite Eight.

FUN TIMES IN RALEIGH

NC State participated in NCAA Tournament games in Raleigh for the first time since 2007. The Wolfpack is 14-2 in NCAA Tournament games played in Raleigh and has not lost a home game in the tournament since 1983.

HOW THE WOLFPACK GOT HERE

In the first two rounds of the 2018 NCAA Tournament in Raleigh, NC State held Elon (W, 62-35) and No. 16 Maryland (W, 74-60) to 48 percent and 74 percent of their season scoring averages, respectively.

LAST MEETING - NC State vs. Mississippi State

December 21, 2001

CANCUN - LaToya Thomas had 26 points and eight rebounds as Mississippi State upset 18th-ranked North Carolina State 71-58 Friday at the Sports Tour International tournament.

It's the first time N.C. State (6-4) has lost four straight non-conference games. Carisse Moody and Kaayla Chones each scored 13 points for the Wolfpack and they combined for 13 rebounds.

Freshman Tan White added 22 points, seven rebounds and five steals for the Lady Bulldogs (8-2), who ran out to a 19-6 lead.

Mississippi State's lead was down to 37-34 at halftime, but it opened the second half with an 11-4 run to open a 10-point edge with under 14 minutes left.

The Lady Bulldogs' largest lead was 15 points - 67-52 with about 10 minutes remaining.

MSU made 50.9 percent of its field-goal attempts, a season-high for a Wolfpack opponent, while N.C. State made only 40.8 percent.

THE WOLFPACK IS BACK

NC State is making its third NCAA Tournament appearance during HC Wes Moore's fifth season in Raleigh. This season marks the first time that the Wolfpack has made two consecutive NCAA Tournaments since the program did so in 2006 and 2007. With the first-round victory over Elon on Mar. 16, NC State has won at least one game in back-to-back tournaments for the first time since the program did so in 1998 and 1999.

RISE TO THE OCCASION

In five seasons under head coach Wes Moore, the Wolfpack is 6-10 against teams ranked in the AP top 10.

THIRTY-TWO STRAIGHT

Sophomore guard Aislinn Konig has hit at least one three pointer in 32 consecutive games since Nov. 15.

NEW FACES. BETTER RESULTS

Despite graduating four senior starters and their accompanying 43.5 points per game from the 2016-17 squad, the 2017-18 Wolfpack is better (26-8) than last season (23-9). The Wolfpack was picked 10th (coaches) and tied for fourth in the ACC standings.

KEEP GETTING TO THE LINE

NC State has made more free throws (489) than its opponents have attempted (481) through 34 games this season.

SHARP SHOOTER

Sophomore guard Aislinn Konig has hit 90 three-pointers this season, tying for the most made in a single year with Jennifer Howard's 1995-96 season.

BLOCK BY BLOCK

Senior center Akela Maize is moving up the single-season blocks list at NC State. With 67 blocks through 34 games this year, she currently ranks second for most in a single season. Maize has swatted two blocks or more on 14 occasions so far this year. Her season and career high mark of five came in the Nov. 23 win over Alabama and was tied in the win over No. 10 Florida State on Feb. 1. Genia Beasley holds the program record of 73 blocks during the 1978-79 season.

HISTORIC PERFORMANCE ON THE BOARDS

Senior Chelsea Nelson collected 22 rebounds in the win over No. 18 Duke on March 2, setting a new ACC Tournament single-game record. It was the second best rebounding performance in NC State history, behind only 27 collected by Susan Yow against ECU on Jan. 17, 1976.

REWRITE THE RECORD BOOKS

NC State has won 16 games at home this season for just the second time in program history. During Wes Moore's five seasons in Raleigh, the Wolfpack is 67-14 in Raleigh.

MAKING A DIFFERENCE ON THE ROAD

Presently in the fifth season under head coach Wes Moore, the Wolfpack has earned 32 true road wins since the start of the 2013-14 season. In the prior eight seasons from 2005-06 to 2012-13, the Wolfpack earned 32 true road wins.

NCAA TEAM OF THE WEEK

Following wins over No. 10 Florida State (Feb. 1) and Boston College (Feb. 4), the Wolfpack was named the NCAA Team of the Week on Feb. 6.

AMONG THE RARE FEW

Senior forward Chelsea Nelson became just the 33rd player in program history to surpass 1,000 career points during NC State's 62-41 win at Clemson on Jan. 28.

MAJOR REBOUNDING ADVANTAGE

In 34 games this season, NC State has won 28 rebounding contests. The Wolfpack has five times this season out-rebounded its opponents by 20 or more (South Alabama, Georgetown, Virginia Tech, Clemson, and UNC-Chapel Hill).

SEVEN STRAIGHT ACC WINS

NC State's seven-game ACC winning streak between Jan. 10 and Feb. 4 marked the longest streak against league opponents since the 2000-01 season.

100 WINS FOR @WOLFPACKWES

The Wolfpack's Jan. 14 win over Syracuse was head coach Wes Moore's 100th at NC State. Having accomplished this feat in just 148 games, he is the third quickest active ACC head coach to achieve 100 wins at his school. (Joanne McCallie - 122 and Jeff Walz - 147).

350 WINS FOR THE WOLFPACK

The Wolfpack's Jan. 14 win over Syracuse was the program's 350th Atlantic Coast Conference victory. NC State is just the fourth program to enter this elite club, joining Duke, Virginia, and North Carolina.

GREAT FIRST START

Redshirt junior and recent Maryland transfer Kiara Leslie took advantage of her first NC State start in the Wolfpack's 79-55 win over Tulane on Dec. 3. Leslie scored 14 points, grabbed a game-high nine rebounds, and dished out four assists against two turnovers in 32 minutes of action.

WHAT A PERFORMANCE

Redshirt junior guard Kiara Leslie tied a career high with 22 points in the win over UNC Asheville, and how she achieved it may be the most impressive part of the feat. The Holly Springs, N.C., native went a perfect 8-8 from the field, including a half court buzzer beater at the end of the third quarter, to tie for the second best single-game shooting performance in program history.

LISA LESLIE AWARD WATCH LIST

Senior center Akela Maize of the NC State women's basketball team has been named to the 20-player watch list for the inaugural Lisa Leslie Award, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and Women's Basketball Coaches Association announced Nov. 10.

Named after the three-time All-American and 1994 National Player of the Year, the Lisa Leslie Award recognizes the top centers in women's college basketball. The selection committee for the award is comprised of top women's college basketball personnel including media members, head coaches, sports information directors, and Hall of Famers. By mid-February the list of 20 will be trimmed to 10. In March, five finalists will be presented to Ms. Leslie and the Hall of Fame's selection committee. Fans will also have the opportunity to vote for their favorite finalist at HoopHallAwards.com.

STRONG NONCONFERENCE SCHEDULE

NC State has scheduled a strong non-conference slate for the 2017-18 season. The Wolfpack's 13 opponents have an average RPI of 140 from the end of the 2016-17 season with seven having qualified for the postseason.

WOLFPACK QUICK FACTS (PRIOR TO START OF SEASON)

-Replacing the seniors. NC State graduated four seniors and 43.5 points per game from its 2016-17 season starting lineup. The senior class posted an impressive career record of 86-43 during its time in Raleigh, winning the most games since the 2007-08 seniors finished with an identical career record.

-Improvement in the post. Seniors Chelsea Nelson and Akela Maize will be big factors in the team's success during the 2017-18 season. Nelson has dramatically improved each season and had a career year as a junior last season, averaging 11.2 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while

shooting a team high .567 from the field. Maize has also seen her role develop throughout her career and had some of the best games of her career in wins over No. 2/2 Notre Dame and at No. 9/7 Louisville last season.

-Recently renovated Reynolds Coliseum. The 2016-17 season was the first season back in the renovated Reynolds Coliseum, which was offline during the 2015-16 season to undergo an extensive \$35 million renovation. NC State had great success in the building last season, going 14-2 on Kay Yow Court. Wolfpack fans turned out in large numbers (2,912 per game) last season, creating a unique home court advantage in the reconfigured seating bowl of 5,500. The momentum from last season's success in the regular season and NCAA Tournament has translated into some of the strongest ticket sales figures in program history, leading to what will be another strong home atmosphere in 2017-18.

-The coach. NC State head coach Wes Moore remains one of the most successful active NCAA women's basketball coaches in the country as he enters his 29th season (fifth at NC State). Moore was named the 2017 ACC Coach of the Year last season, claiming the award for the first time in the 43-year history of women's basketball at NC State. He is 86-43 during his time with the Wolfpack, has posted a 40-24 ACC record, and has led the team to two NCAA Tournament appearances and a postseason invite in all four completed seasons. For his career, Moore is 644-212 and has 23 seasons of 20+ wins to his name.

-Multiple newcomers. NC State welcomes two freshmen (guard Kai Crutchfield and post Kayla Jones) and three transfers (guard Armani Hawkins, guard Kiara Leslie, and guard Grace Hunter) to its roster this season. Two—Hawkins (Arizona State) and Leslie (Maryland)—will be able to play during the 2017-18 season. The third: Hunter (Charlotte) is already proving to be a terrific addition to the team's preparation during practices, as she earned First Team All-CUSA honors last season while averaging 17.2 points and 8.6 rebounds per game for the 49ers.

One of the top head coaches in NCAA women's basketball, Wes Moore will begin his fifth season as the head coach of NC State with the start of the 2017-18 campaign.

Since taking over the Wolfpack in April of 2013, Moore has posted an 86-43 (.667) record and led NC State to two NCAA Tournament appearances and postseason invitations each year. He has led the Wolfpack to a 40-24 (.625) record in ACC games, a league that consistently ranks among the top conferences in NCAA Division I basketball. Three of Moore's four seasons have included significantly surpassing preseason league projections and two have concluded in fourth-place finishes in the 15-member league. All four of his seasons in Raleigh have been winning seasons, and three have included 20 wins or more.

In his first season at NC State (2013-14), Moore led the Wolfpack to a 25-8 record, a fourth-place finish in the ACC standings, and an NCAA Tournament appearance. For his efforts, he was named the ESPNW ACC Coach of the Year. After an 18-15 campaign in 2014-15 and a 20-11 season in 2015-16, Moore led the Wolfpack to the NCAA Tournament Round of 32 in 2016-17 with an impressive 23-9 record (12-4 ACC). On March 1, 2017, he earned the official ACC Coach of the Year honor in votes by both the league's Blue Ribbon Panel and head coaches, earning the first such honor in the 43-year history of the NC State women's basketball program. He was also named a Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year Semifinalist after authoring upsets of four top-15 teams throughout the season: No. 2/2 Notre Dame, at No. 6/7 Florida State, No. 12/15 Duke, and at No. 9/7 Louisville.

Moore spent 15 seasons (1998-2013) as the head coach at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga (UTC) where he led the Lady Mocs to 12 Southern Conference (SoCon) regular season titles, nine SoCon tournament championships, and nine NCAA Tournament berths, while becoming the winningest coach in UTC and SoCon history. He came to Raleigh as the reigning SoCon Coach of the Year, an award he has earned on six separate occasions.

He is the first coach in history to advance three different teams to the NCAA Tournament at the Division I, II, and III levels.

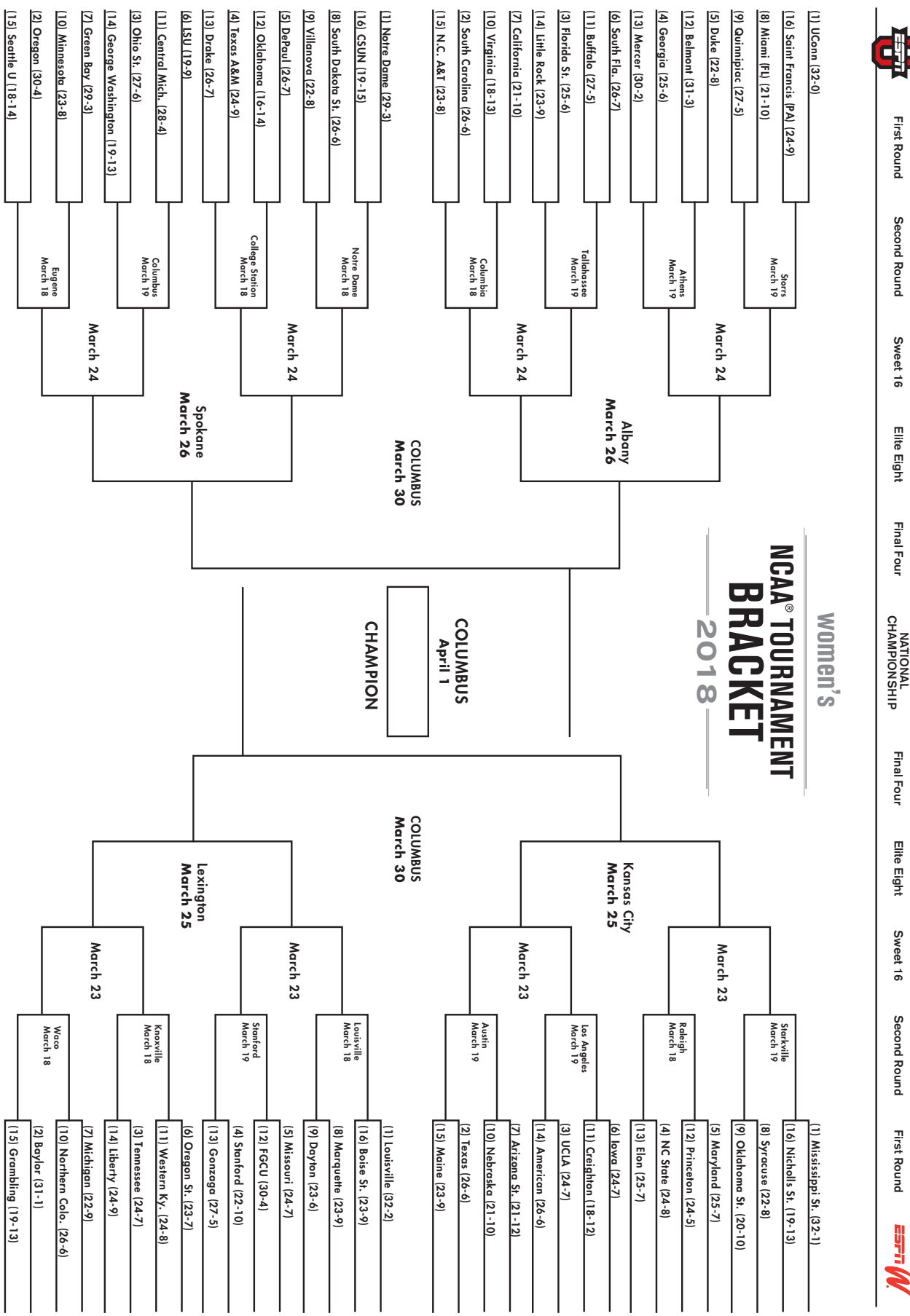
