
About Us


Mission Statement


Dual Enrollment

Our one-of-a-kind Dual Enrollment track; eligible high school students can earn college credits while attending our school! Students who qualify will take our Visual, Performing, and Communicative Arts Magnet classes while simultaneously being enrolled in academic college course(s) through Miami Dade College (MDC). The credits that students earn at MDC will be used toward high school graduation and are acceptable toward a college associate or baccalaureate degree, or technical certificate.

DUAL ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

- A minimum 3.0 high school unweighted grade point average (GPA)
- Passed the appropriate Reading and Writing sections of the College's Basic Skills Assessment Test (PERT or CPT), or submitted adequate SAT/ACT or FCAT scores (See additional testing and placement scores information)
- Permission from the parent/guardian, school principal, and counselor
- Met with the College Dual Enrollment Coordinator for our school
- An understanding that the amount of work necessary to succeed in dual enrollment courses will be greater than in high school courses


The following items are dress code violations and are NOT permitted:

Busing


Our transportation zones are created by elementary school zones. Please note there are many pick up & drop off areas within these zones. Addresses within the designated transportation service zones, are currently eligible to receive transportation services, providing your residence is in excess of two miles from Arthur & Polly Mays Conservatory of the Arts. Please note that should your residence and/or the transportation service zone change, your child may no longer be eligible to receive transportation services is reviewed annually and may be eliminated at any time due to budgetary constraints. 
Deadline to Apply: January 15th Audition Results: March 15th
