...I might not be perfect, but Jesus thinks I'm to die for.

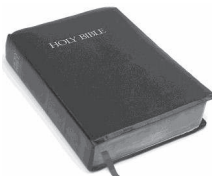
...Don't judge my past...I don't live there anymore. (Try Life)
