

The club was and still is independent of all national organizations, thus keeping annual dues very low. Annual dues are only \$30 per/year for a family. To qualify, you must attend two functions, submit an application to the Membership Chairperson and be voted in by the Board of Directors. Membership reached 200 families in September 1997 with more than 220 cars and some 2nd generation club people.

Monthly activities include charity fund raising, parades, rallies, cruising, picnics, workshops, road trips, car shows and swapping stories with friends.





Let me be the first to say it "*Dues Are Due!*". Here is a little background regarding the timing of this event. The club By-Laws state that the club year runs from January through the end of December. Then, why are we paying dues now, you say!? Well its like this-

- 2. The slate of candidates is created and presented to the membership at the November meeting.
