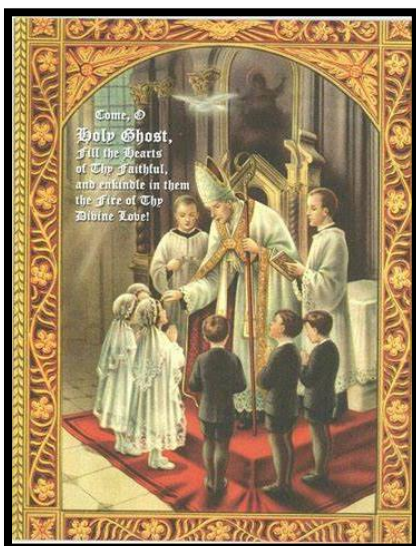

Weddings - You must contact St. Mary's directly at least 6 months in advance in order to have your wedding at St. Mary of the Assumption Parish & Shrine. Schultz to discuss getting married at St. Mary's and to begin marriage preparation classes by calling 315-343-3953 or emailing kpauldine@syrдио.org.**

Baptisms - For baptisms, you must contact St. Mary's directly. There is a required baptismal preparation meeting with Father Schultz. It is required that your sponsors be Confirmed Catholics and active Catholics (go to Mass weekly, etc.). Please know that we are a Traditional Catholic parish, and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is offered "ad orientem" or "facing East" - The priest, in the person of Christ, leads us to God the Father by placing our focus solely on our Lord during the Mass. The Communion Rail is used for both Latin and English Masses. Please kneel (if physically able) at the Communion Rail to receive Holy Communion. Holy Communion is given only on the tongue at a Latin Mass.

During the Ascension Thursday Mass, Bishop Lucia officially invoked the healing intercession of Blessed Carlo Acutis for Jimmer, a Syracuse Diocesan parishioner who has ALS.

Official Intercessory Prayer:

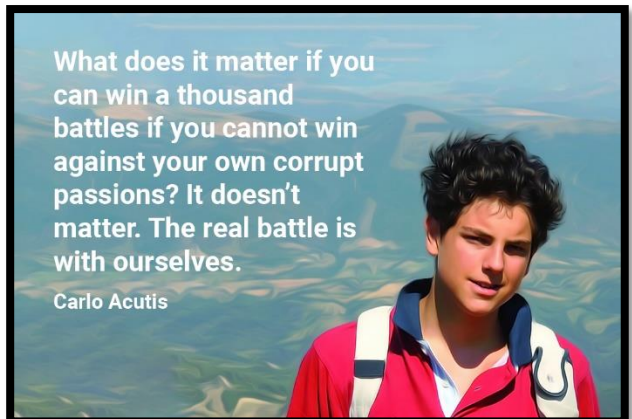
Oh Father, who has given us the ardent testimony, of the young Venerable Carlo Acutis, who made the Eucharist the core of his life and the strength of his daily commitments so that everybody may love You above all else, let him soon be counted among the Blessed and the Saints in Your Church. Confirm my faith, nurture my hope, strengthen my charity, in the image of young Carlo who, growing in these virtues, now lives with You. Grant me the grace that I need: that Jimmer would be granted complete healing from ALS. I trust in You, Father, and your Beloved Son Jesus, in the Virgin Mary, our Dearest Mother, and in the intervention of Your Venerable Carlo Acutis. Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be....
Amen.

Two miracles are necessary to become a Catholic Saint. Blessed Carlo Acutis already has one miracle but needs one more to be declared a saint! According to church law, a virtuous person needs to intercede in two miracles before they can be declared a saint, except in cases of martyrdom or when the pope lifts such requirements. The first miracle officially recognized by the Vatican as a result of Acutis's intercession involved the healing of a 4-year-old Brazilian boy name Matteheus who had a pancreas malformation and was on the verge of death.



We are asking everyone to assist in this request by taking a prayer card and continuing to pray daily for Jimmer's complete healing through the intercession of Blessed Carlo Acutis. Please consider praying a Novena for this Intention.
