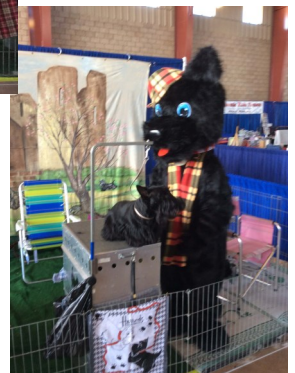

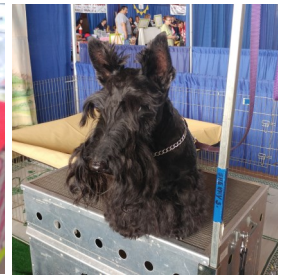

Our two-year-old sweetheart, Kylie, is still here as I continue taking her to weekly socialization classes every Saturday afternoon in Torrance ... as time permits.

My sister has been in hospice care for many weeks now and lives at the foot of Mt. Shasta, almost 700 miles away from me, here, in Huntington Beach. So time is at a premium with Scottie Rescue right now with all the sadness and assorted things that serious illness brings to a family.

Kylie, however, is doing very well now around other dogs in our highly trainer-controlled socialization classes. She shows no aggression towards my Angus or



Shannon here at home either, but I have not let her run loose in the house or yard with them, yet, and most likely won't. They were originally rescued Scotties, themselves, who because of their dog aggressive issues, ended up as our special Scotties. Shannon is now 13 and seriously ill and Angus is seven. They both were bailed out of shelters as young Scotties and in working with their behavior issues it eventually was decided that they would become our personal Scotties ... six years apart.

Our plan is still to adopt Kylie as an "only dog," even though she has shown great improvement after her three weeks with a trainer who specializes in working with dog-to-dog aggressiveness.

Kylie will one day soon become some lucky family's great Scottie companion. She is very entertaining, happy, housebroken, a lap-sitting charming little girl, who is well on her way to normal, peaceful daily walks.

Make no mistake, though, she is a strong alpha Scottie when it comes to other dogs. As my trainer said when I picked her up, "She thinks she is an 80-pound Rottweiler ... a real 'hoot' and great fun to be around."

SCOTTIE RESCUE

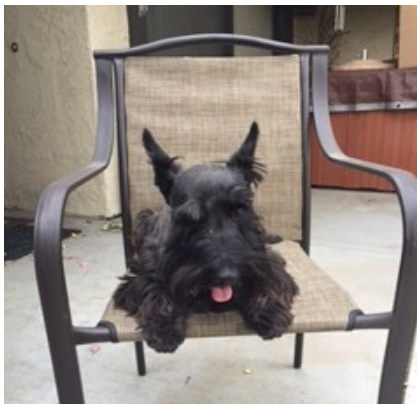
