THE FINANCIAL AID FUND

At College Prep, as is the case in all independent schools, tuition funds most of what is vital to the school program – small classes, a highly qualified faculty, maintenance of a beautiful and state-of-the-art campus. This year's tuition of \$33,800 is a meaningful amount of money for every parent. The College Prep Board of Trustees strives to keep the cost of a Prep education comparable to that of other Bay Area independent secondary schools, but even at its current level, tuition puts a College Prep education beyond the reach of too many able and worthy students. In order to remain accessible to all qualified applicants, College Prep underwrites a generous financial aid program. During the 2012-2013 school year, 23% of the Prep student body is receiving assistance in the form of tuition grants. This academic year, the school has made available \$1,763,000 in financial aid!

THE ROBERT BALDWIN, JR. FUND FOR THE FACULTY

An outstanding faculty is core to the excellence of the program College Prep offers to its students. Thus, the challenge of hiring and retaining excellent teachers is of paramount importance and a top priority. Since 2001, great strides have been made toward being able to offer faculty and staff competitive compensation and benefits packages. The Robert Baldwin, Jr. Endowed Fund for the Faculty ("The Baldwin Fund") was established in 2000 by a grateful alumnus. His intention was to honor Bob Baldwin, longtime Head of School, and to acknowledge the gifts talented teachers bring to their students.

As have most other independent schools, College Prep has begun the task of building an endowment that will provide long-term financial stability. The Baldwin Fund is a separate fund within the College Prep endowment, the draw from which may be used to support faculty salaries. The Baldwin Fund is currently valued over \$4,202,000.

Tonight, we can make a meaningful difference for College Prep teachers by designating a portion of our auction proceeds to the Baldwin Fund. Your gift will help meet the challenge and be a lasting contribution towards maintaining the quality of teaching essential to the Prep experience.

SILENT AUCTION

Silent Auction tables will close in stages. Sections I and II will close prior to the Live Auction. Section closing times are listed on Page 1 of this catalogue and posted at the auction tables. An announcement will be made at the time of each closing.

A bid sheet will accompany each Silent Auction item. Bid amounts and raises are pre-determined and listed on each bid sheet (unless otherwise indicated). The bidder is to legibly write their bidder number on the line adjacent to their designated bid.

Bids entered after the announced closing of the category will be disallowed. The highest legal bid, circled at the closing of the Section, will constitute the winning bid.

The Auction Steering Committee reserves the right to reopen the bidding or take the bidding live on any item that attracts unusual attention.

LIVE AUCTION

In the event of a dispute, the auctioneer will determine the successful bidder. The auctioneer reserves the right to reject any bid that he deems not commensurate to the value of the offered item.

Bids shall be placed on an item by raising your bidder paddle. Spotters will assist the auctioneer in identifying the bids. The auctioneer will announce the winning bid and bidder number for each item. Acceptance of the high bid becomes a binding obligation upon the bidder to make payment in full for that item by the end of the evening. Syndicate bids (groups of buyers) must be submitted under the bid number of a single person who will be responsible for payment in full at the end of the evening.

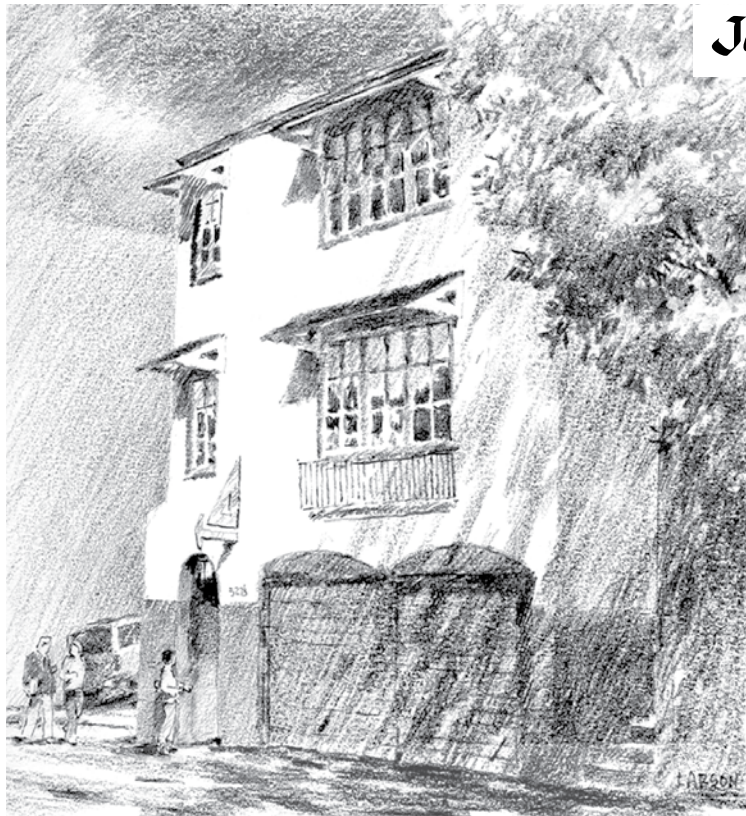

A NOTE ON BUYING OLD WINES AT THE AUCTION

This year the College Prep auction has received an extraordinary donation of a large number of distinguished old wines, aged for many years in a well kept cellar. Our wine advisory committee is not familiar with the current drinking status of all of the wines. Due to their rarity, we were only able to sample a few of the wines from this cellar, to determine their value. Some wines were disqualified from the auction. We cannot guarantee the quality of every individual wine offered, but in our estimation the oldest lots will in some cases offer remarkable experiences for fans of mature fine wine.

For those who are not familiar with older wines and unsure of which to bid on, we offer a brief guide:

- 1) Generally speaking, red wines of the type at this auction will improve for 5-10 years and will not start to decline till around 15-20 years. Exceptionally sturdy reds such as high-quality Cabernet, top Bordeaux and Petite Sirah will hold and improve for longer. Sweet dessert wines such as Sauternes and Port also tend to live longer.
- 2) If you prefer red wines with rich, fresh or jammy fruit flavor, full body and dry tannins, you will probably enjoy the younger wines more (e.g., vintages since 1995). If you prefer mellow, softer or lighter red wines with distinct earthy or cedary/woody notes, you will likely enjoy the older wines.
- 3) Dry white wines generally peak in quality and decline earlier, within 5-10 years, with the exception of Riesling or Semillon. However, some Chardonnays from top vineyards and vintages can age for much longer, although they change in character. The older Chardonnays or white Burgundies in the auction will no longer seem fruity or oaky, but take on more of a nutty, lemon or apple curd character, and a bit of the oxidized character of high-quality sherry.

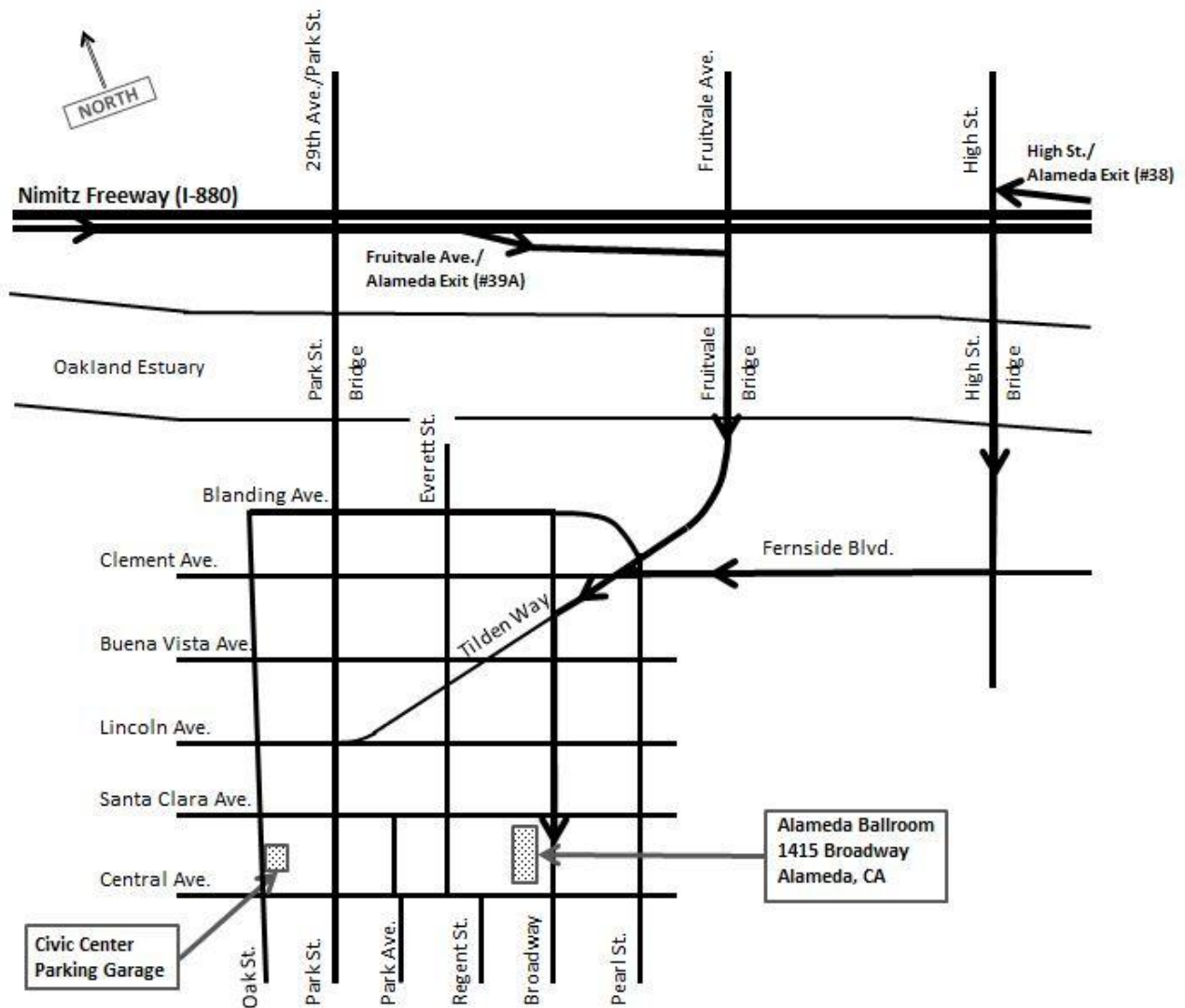
