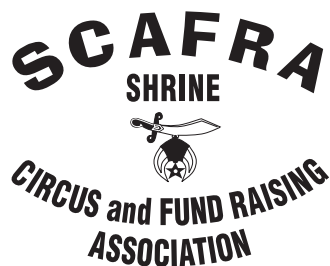

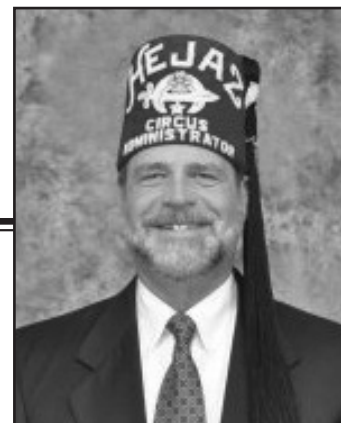

We returned to our traditional schedule of having the Marketplace only on the Thursday, along with our very appreciated "Welcome Reception" with light snacks provided by the exhibitors.

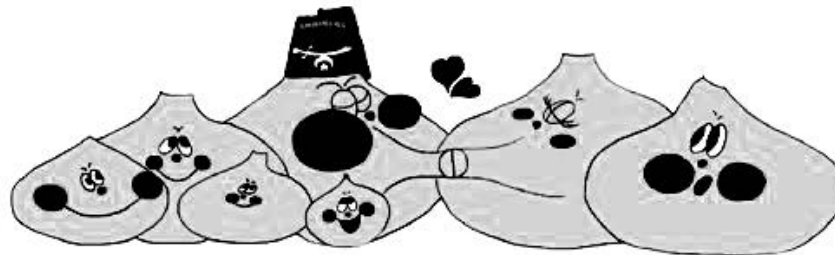



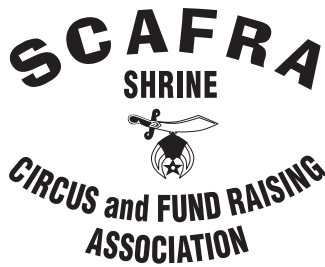
Application is easy; clip the back page and send your dues now! **Dues are payable as of January 1st** of each year.

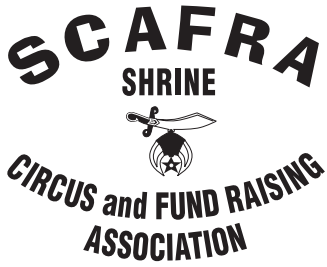
