No wonder it was these springs that founded St. Moritz's legendary reputation. Ever since the Bronze Age, people have come to bathe in St. Moritz's mineral water, and the tradition continues to be cherished.

**01 St. Moritz** Scintillating St. Moritz is the embodiment of style, quality and tradition and is famous for its superb sports, leisure and relaxation facilities, vibrant cultural life and high-profile events. In February 2017, the FIS Alpine World Ski Championships 2017 were held here.

**02 Pontresina** The pearl of the High Alps: this sunny, sheltered village at the foot of the Bernina massif is a paradise for outdoor activity fans and anyone seeking relaxation.

**03 Celerina** Away from the bustle yet close to the action: here, alpine and cross-country skiers, winter walkers and tobogganing fans find everything they could wish for.

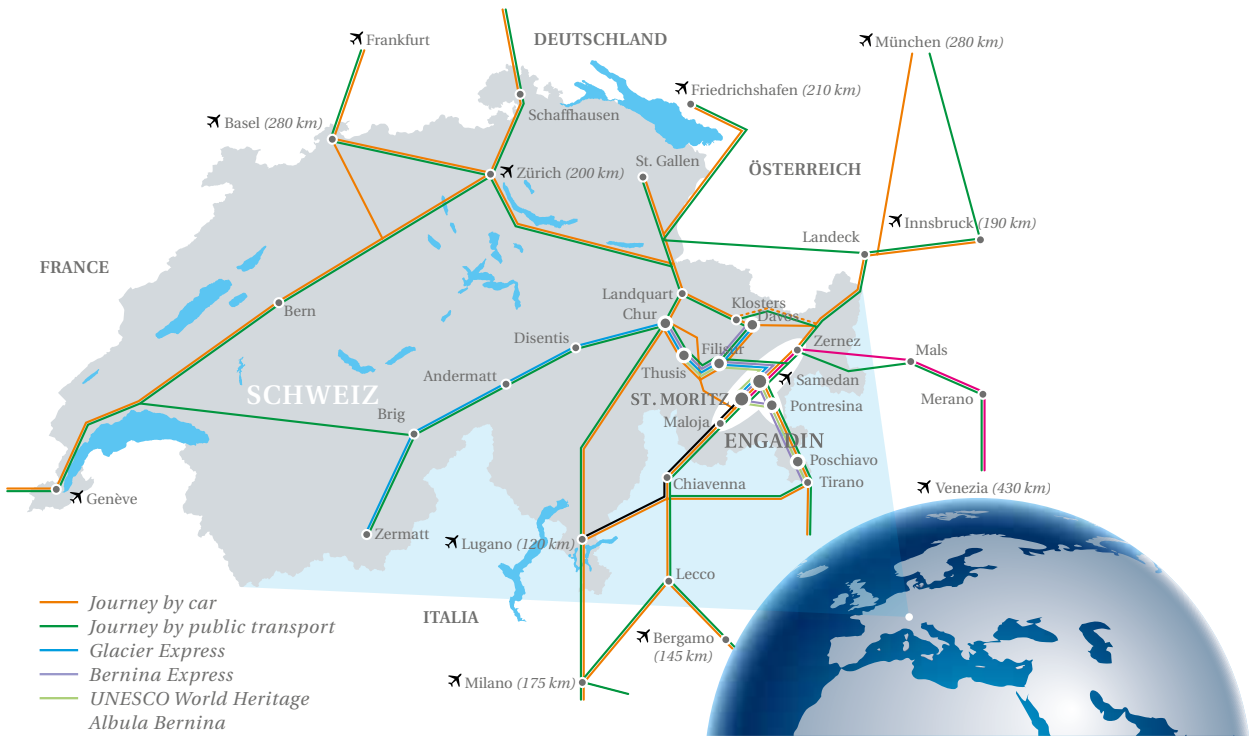
**04 Silvaplana** Legendary among snowkiting enthusiasts, sporty Silvaplana also makes an ideal base for alpine and cross-country skiers as well as snowboarders.

**05 Sils** This picturesque village at the gateway to the romantic Val Fex enchants alpine skiers, snowboarders, cross-country skiers and winter walkers alike.

**06 Maloja** Famous as the starting point for the Engadin Ski Marathon, this charming village at the foot of the Maloja Pass is the perfect family holiday resort.

**07 Samedan** Attractions in and around the lively capital of the Upper Engadin include the Mineral Bath & Spa, the inviting cross-country ski centre and the children's ski area above the town.

**08 Bever** This small, unspoilt Engadin village at the gateway to the idyllic Val Bever is especially popular with families.



## WAYS TO THE ENGADIN

**09 La Punt Chamues-ch** Located at the foot of the Albula Pass, this picturesque village promises delightful tobogganing, ski touring and snowshoe trekking.

**10 Madulain** Sleepy Madulain is the smallest village in the Upper Engadin and a paradise for cross-country skiers.

**11 Zuoz** Families are especially well catered for in this patrician village with its child-friendly ski area and glorious cross-country ski trails.

**12 S-chanf** The finish point of the Engadin Ski Marathon boasts enchanting cross-country ski trails as well as idyllic winter walking paths.

**13 Zernz** Tobogganing on Munt Baselgia, snowshoe trekking at the Ofen Pass, cross-country skiing in the wide expanses of the Engadin valley – visitors are spoilt for choice.

**By Car** Road connections to the Engadin are excellent. From within Switzerland, drive via Chur (over the Julier Pass) or via Klosters (using the car-transporter rail service through the Vereina tunnel; trains run every half hour). From Germany and Austria, you can also travel directly via Landeck. From Italy, the routes lead via the Maloja Pass, Bernina Pass or Ofen Pass.

**By train** Travel with the Swiss Federal Railways (SBB) as far as Chur, where you change to the Rhaetian Railway (RhB). The line through the Albula valley into the Engadin, with its spiral tunnels and giddy viaducts, is one of the most scenic and spectacular in Europe; together with the Bernina line, it was designated a UNESCO World Heritage site in July 2008. The Albula tunnel is now over 110 years old; a new, parallel tunnel is to be excavated over the coming years. Since last winter, St. Moritz station has welcomed visitors with a splendid new look.

**By plane** Engadin St. Moritz is home to the highest European airport that can accommodate direct international flights. Dedicated customs facilities at Engadin Airport allow for both Schengen and non-Schengen arrivals, permitting direct flights from throughout the Schengen zone and beyond. The introduction of new flight approach procedures will improve planning of arrivals and departures.

Snow-covered slopes sparkling in the sunshine frame a wide, high valley of bewitching beauty. The Engadin has repeatedly won the coveted ADAC ski guide award for the Alpine ski region with the greatest variety, alongside other honours including the prestigious British Travel Award. At the four large ski areas of Corviglia/Piz Nair, Corvatsch, Diavolezza/Lagalb and Zuoz, as well as at five smaller but charming areas, skiers and snowboarders find a total of 88 superb pistes waiting to be explored. Beginners, intermediates and experts alike discover slopes perfectly suited to their ability. Thanks to the high altitude and the modern artificial snowmaking facilities, Engadin St. Moritz is famously snowsure, while the dry climate guarantees superb powder. Throughout the area, 74 mountain and excursion restaurants promise mouth-watering gastro-nomic variety. Another special attraction of the region is the early start to the season: up on the Diavolezza, snow sports enthusiasts can indulge their passion as early as 21 October 2017.



## Ski and snowboard activities with a difference

A wide choice of activities on the pistes guarantees endless holiday variety. For example, **Corvatsch Snow Night** on Friday evenings promises a party atmosphere and the chance to tackle the longest floodlit slope in Switzerland – great fun for skiers and snowboarders alike. On all other evenings, enthusiasts can book a private Snow Night – the ultimate exclusive ski experience.

You can even ski or snowboard all day long without repeating a single run: the **Snow Safari** offers a panoramic tour of several different ski areas. “**Glüna Plaina**”, which means “full moon” in Romansh, is a thrilling evening event that starts with a delicious meal at the summit restaurant on the Diavolezza and ends with you gliding down deserted slopes to the valley in the silvery moonlight.

**White Carpet Corviglia** At 7.45am, the cableways swing into action, and as the sun peeps above the snow-capped ridge, you are already gliding up to the heights. Soon after eight, you are standing at the top of freshly prepared pistes, with barely a soul in sight – and all the space in the world to carve the very first tracks down to the valley floor.

## THE SKI AND SNOWBOARD MOUNTAINS AT A GLANCE

**Corviglia/Piz Nair:** The mountain overlooking St. Moritz and Celerina is home to one of Switzerland's classic ski areas. It is easy to reach from all sides: from St. Moritz Dorf on the Chantarella funicular, from St. Moritz Bad on the Signal cable car, from Celerina on the six-seater gondola and from Suvretta by chair lift. Winter sports enthusiasts find superbly prepared pistes, with more than 160 km (100 miles) of sensational runs to choose from. The 15 mountain restaurants serve gastro-nomic treats to suit all tastes.

From Silvaplana–Surlej, an impressive large cable car carries you in just a few minutes up to the Corvatsch snow sports area, whose slopes are directly linked to the Furtschellas pistes above Sils. Among the many highlights is the famous and challenging Hahnensee run to St. Moritz: 9 thrilling km (5.5 miles) in total. All around, there are contrasting runs of all levels of difficulty to choose from – on the pistes, in the park and on powder. The cable car serving the upper reaches of the mountain carries you to the Corvatsch summit station, the highest in Graubünden at 3,303 metres above sea level (10,837 ft). Altogether, 14 lifts and 10 mountain restaurants guarantee plenty of variety.

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**Muottas Muragl** The breathtaking views from the Muottas Muragl summit station are a highlight of any visit to the region. The funicular, which is more than 100 years old, carries you up in just ten minutes. After a stroll along the panoramic Philosophers' Trail or a hike along the scenic snowshoe route, the Romantik Hotel Muottas Muragl offers a cosy refreshment stop. This is the first plus-energy hotel in the Alps (which means it produces more energy than it needs itself) and the winner of the Swiss Solar Prize and other prestigious environmental awards. The most memorable way back down is on the legendary toboggan run promising 4.2 km (2.6 miles) of high thrills. Toboggans and snowshoes can be hired at the base station.

For families, the Engadin St. Moritz region is an enchanting winter playground. A comprehensive range of activities specifically for children guarantees fun-filled holidays. Family-friendly hotels offer a specially warm welcome for their younger guests, while the cosy apartments are equipped to meet the needs of visitors of all ages. Wherever families choose to stay, they can be sure to feel at home.

A particularly good deal for families on a ski or snowboard holiday is the Family Card, a lift pass that grants further discounts on the already reduced child rate. Throughout the Engadin, families find a wide range of facilities and services that focus on younger visitors. Highlights include the Corviglia Snowpark with its beginners' fun slope, Pontresina Children's Ski World, the dedicated



children's ski and snowboard courses offered by the region's snow sports schools, and the delightful Snowli Kids' restaurant at the bottom of the Celerina–Marguns gondola in Celerina. The Corvatsch Snowpark promises thrills for all levels of freestyle enthusiasts and boasts a new flow line in addition to the classic features. The venue also hosts competitions.

Up on the slopes, kids particularly love the special child-friendly four-seater chair lifts of Tschainas in Celerina und Chastlatsch in Zuoz. Off the snow, entertaining attractions include the children's cinema in Sils, which shows popular kids' films free of charge, and the National Park Centre in Zernez, where the whole family can find out about the fascinating flora and fauna in Switzerland's only National Park.

## Tobogganing

The toboggan run from Muottas Muragl promises a very special thrill. Starting at an altitude of 2,456 m (8,058 ft), the route comprises 20 curves and high-speed straights, guaranteeing an exciting and ever-changing ride all the way down to the bottom station of the funicular – a distance of 4.2 km (2.6 miles) and vertical drop of 718 m (2,356 ft). Throughout the valley, the various villages offer plenty of opportunities for tobogganing fun.

Clip on a pair of narrow cross-country skis to experience an extraordinary sense of freedom as you glide across the endless white expanses of the Engadin. Whether you prefer the elegant classic or more dynamic skating style, you will find that Nordic skiing acquires a new dimension on up to over 230 km (143 miles) of contrasting trails here. No wonder that year after year, around 13,000 cross-country ski enthusiasts make the pilgrimage to the valley of light to take part in the world-famous Engadin Ski Marathon. The race celebrates its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary this season on 11 March 2018; entrants also have the option of a half marathon of 21 km (13 miles) following the same course from Maloja as far as Pontresina. One week before the great gathering, on 4 March 2018, the traditional Women's Race promises a thrilling contest over 17 km (10.5 miles).



Alongside the ever-popular marathon course – at 42 km (26 miles), an awesome challenge at any time – highlights include the charming trail from Zuoz to Zernez, delightful itineraries through the side valleys and across the famous frozen Engadin lakes, and the Alp Bondo circuit up at the Bernina Pass. There is also night skiing on floodlit trails. A map showing cross-country ski trails and winter walking paths is available from local tourist information offices and from sales points along the trails.

Experience the fairy-tale charm of our delightful winter walking trails. The Engadin St. Moritz region has 150 km (93 miles) of winter walking paths and trails waiting to be explored. Cosy cafes and restaurants along the way offer the chance to stop for a welcome rest. On a stroll across the frozen Engadin lakes, you appreciate the vast expanse of the high-lying valley and, especially at sunset, the magical quality of the light in the Engadin. The flat winter walking paths from Maloja to Silvaplana and on to St. Moritz are perfect for families – depending on snow conditions, with pushchairs, too. For a particularly picturesque winter walk, follow the path from Sils into the romantic Val Fex, or from Maloja through the snow-blanketed forest to the frozen Lake Cavloccio. Those setting their sights higher can follow the Philosophers' Trail up on Muottas Muragl. Along this idyllic winter walking trail, seats furnished with woollen blankets invite walkers to reflect on the breathtaking beauty of the landscape all around.



## Snowshoe treks

With snowshoes on your feet, you are free to explore the pristine forests and snow-blanketed plateaus at your own pace – a magical adventure for anyone seeking tranquillity and adventure off the beaten track. In recent years, Maloja has made a name for itself among enthusiasts as a paradise for snowshoeing, while Madulain offers an idyllic evening snowshoe trek followed by a fondue dinner in a cosy alpine hut.

## Snowkiting

Snowkiting is like kitesurfing, only on skis or a snowboard. A favourite venue is the frozen Lake Silvaplana, where you glide over the snow pulled by a kite powered by the Maloja wind.

## Ice sports

Every village in the Engadin has an ice rink, where locals and visitors can skate, play ice hockey or hold a curling match. Some are also floodlit and open in the evening.

## Ice climbing

The ice climbing gorge in Pontresina and the various frozen waterfalls attract experts and novices to the Engadin from far and wide. The Pontresina Mountaineering School offers a variety of courses at all levels.

### *Madulain Ice Path*

*Ice skating enthusiasts will love this beautiful open-air trail through the meadows along the left bank of the Inn. The light effects on the frozen river, views of the historic village heart and the sense of peace in the valley floor are enchanting. The path is 1,000 metres (1,100 yards) long and begins at the works yard, where parking is available.*

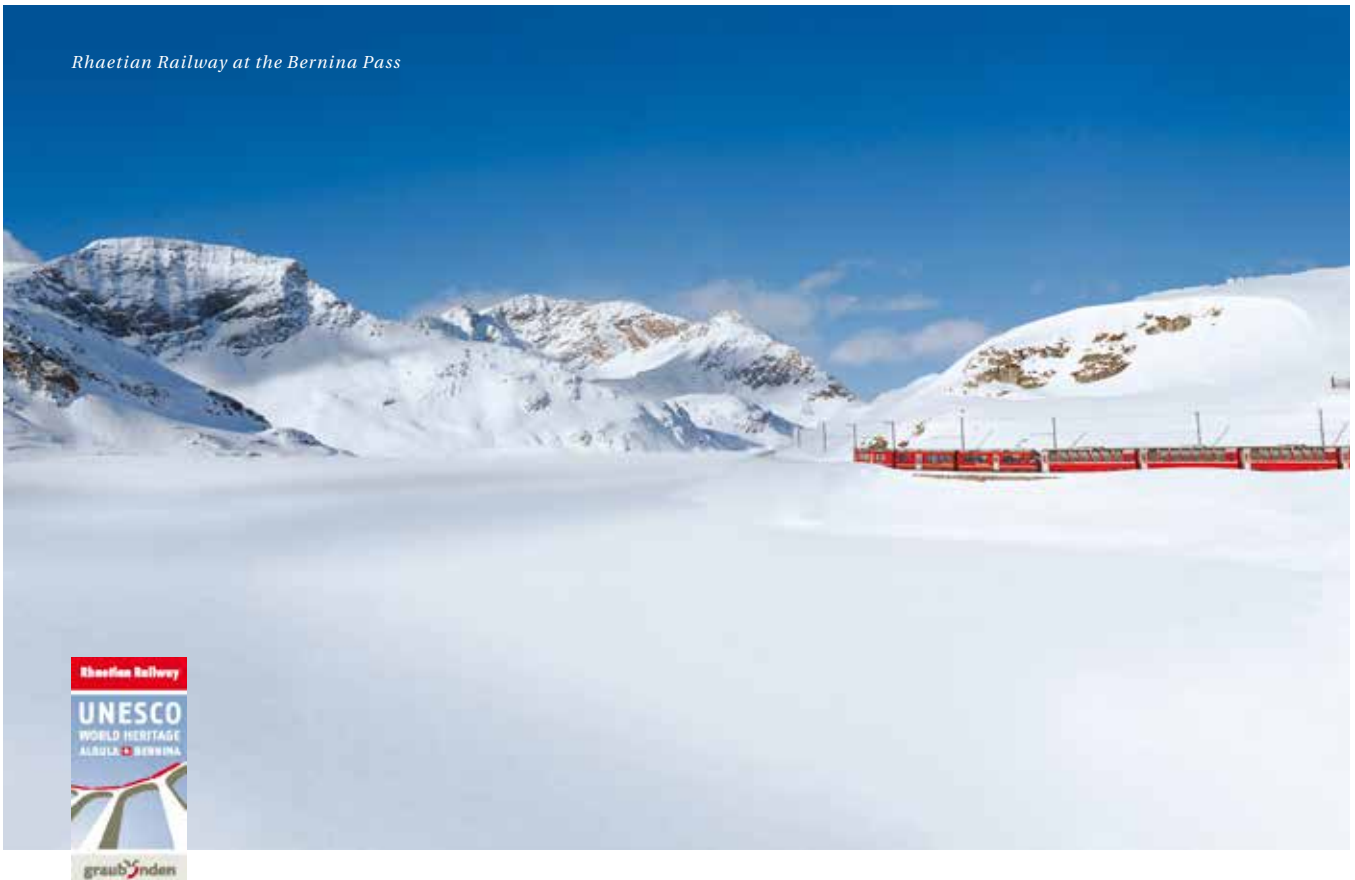

**UNESCO World Heritage** The "Rhaetian Railway in the Albula/Bernina landscapes" is one of the world's most spectacular narrow-gauge railway lines and features on UNESCO's list of World Heritage sites. The Albula and Bernina lines are fine examples of the ingenuity and innovation of the railway pioneers who opened up the high-alpine landscape.

**Bernina Express** From St. Moritz, the train winds in tight bends along walls of snow and past the Bernina massif as it climbs to the Bernina Pass at 2,253 metres above sea level (7,392 ft). From here, the panoramic carriages glide down through the Valposchiavo, a valley full of southerly charm, on their way to the palms of Tirano in Italy.



**Bernina Glaciers** The Bernina Glaciers project offers a chance to experience the full variety of the spectacular glacial landscape of the Bernina region between the Engadin and the Valposchiavo. Three connecting elements – glaciers, energy and time – are the focus of a range of attractions and exciting adventures in nature.

**Glacier Express** Treat yourself to one of the most spectacular of all journeys through the Swiss Alps, from St. Moritz to Zermatt. Along the way, enjoy a freshly prepared lunch served at your seat as you watch the breathtaking mountain scenery glide past the panoramic windows.

**Alp Grüm full-moon trip** The evening begins with a ride in a panoramic carriage of a special train from St. Moritz to Alp Grüm, where drinks and a glacier fondue are served. The trip back through the snowy mountains sparkling in the light of the full moon is bewitchingly beautiful.

**Excursions by PostBus** The picturesque village of Soglio in the Val Bregaglia is one of many charming destinations you can visit in comfort by PostBus. Other scenic options include a trip to the Italian market town of Chiavenna or a ride on the Palm Express along the shores of Lake Como to Lugano.

**A bird's-eye view of the Engadin** The highest pinnacles of the Eastern Alps seem close enough to touch on a thrilling helicopter ride over the Bernina massif. If you like to feel the wind in your face as you fly, you may prefer a tandem descent by hang-glider or paraglider with a qualified pilot: a gentler experience, but just as memorable.

**Top tobogganing: Preda/Darlux–Bergün** The Rhaetian Railway's special toboggan excursion combines a ride on the world-famous Albula line with some of the best tobogganing in the Alps. The train journey through twisting tunnels and over giddy viaducts is one of the most dramatic in Switzerland. From Preda, at 1,800 metres above sea level (5,900 ft), you toboggan 6 bracing kilometres (4 miles) all the way down to Bergün.

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### *Ice stupas in Pontresina*

*Local glaciologists and architects, in collaboration with the Indian engineer Sonam Wangchuk, have managed to create Europe's first ice stupa. These cones of ice, which serve as water storage, are up to 20 metres high and aim to draw attention to the melting of the glaciers.*

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### **The wonderful climate of the Engadin**

The Engadin's elevated location, high in the Alps, creates unique weather patterns. Experts refer matter-of-factly to a dry, continental climate. As variations in temperature between day and night are as great as those between summer and winter, conditions for winter sports are superb. The dry cold preserves the freshly fallen snow so that the landscape keeps its white, fairy-tale appearance throughout the winter, and sports enthusiasts enjoy powder conditions rivalled only by those in the Rocky Mountains. All the same, this southerly mountain valley enjoys exceptionally high levels of sunshine.

## The Engadin lakes

In winter, the Engadin lakes freeze over and are covered by a thick blanket of snow, creating a vast white expanse that adds to the sense of boundless freedom of this inspiring, high-lying valley. These wide-open spaces offer visitors a beautiful setting for walking, cross-country skiing and snowkiting, and provide a dramatic venue for exclusive events such as the spectacular Snow Polo World Cup St. Moritz, the legendary White Turf horse races and the traditional Engadin Ski Marathon.

## Sparkling snow crystals

The combination of low temperatures, dry air and snow makes everything in the Engadin sparkle. On particularly cold, sunny days, the air appears to be full of millions of tiny diamonds, glittering in the sunlight. Unusual phenomena take place on the ground, too – for example, in the Val Trupchun. As the sun rarely reaches the valley floor in winter, snow crystals grow up to 4 centimetres (2 inches) across and glisten magically in the light.

## White giants: the glaciers of the Engadin

Among the highlights of the magnificent Engadin landscape are the 173 glaciers. Draped majestically around the highest peaks of the Eastern Alps, they extend for more than 40 square km (15 square miles), making up four per cent of the region's surface area. Crowning them all is the Morteratsch Glacier – at around 7 km (4.5 miles), the longest in the Engadin. Other glaciers, too – with evocative names such as Roseg, Tschierva, Sella and Pers – bear witness to the power of nature. Hidden under a winter blanket of snow, however, the ice giants are barely discernible. At most, you can make out the odd crevasse, offering a glimpse of the eerie blue interior. Just as intriguing are the ice caves, created in summer when the relatively warm meltwater makes its way out of the glacier. Exploring the ice giants independently, however, is dangerous; anyone seeking to discover the glaciers' secrets is well advised to book an expert guide.

**Champagne climate** St. Moritz is also famous worldwide for its "champagne climate" – not a reference to its champagne-drinking guests, but to the sparkling and invigorating climate of the Engadin, which in winter is characterised by exceptionally dry, clear air.

**Olympia Bob Run, St. Moritz–Celerina** The Olympia Bob Run from St. Moritz to Celerina is the oldest bob run in the world – as well as the only natural-ice track that still hosts international races annually. Over a history lasting



more than 110 years, it has staged two Olympic Winter Games as well as 20 world championships. You can find out what it feels like to hurtle down the 1,722-metre (1,883-yard) natural-ice bob run by booking a guest ride with a professional pilot and brakeman, experiencing speeds of up to 135 km/h (84 mph).

**Cresta Run** The legendary Cresta Run in St. Moritz is the birthplace of the sport of skeleton racing. With a length of 1,200 metres (1,300 yards) and 10 corners, the Cresta – like the bob run – is built anew every winter using snow and water. Riders hurtle down it at an average top speed of around 130 km/h (80 mph) – travelling head-first, chin a mere 10 cm (4 in) above the ice.

**Magical St. Moritz** St. Moritz's elegant and renowned 5-star deluxe hotels delight guests with their glamorous atmosphere and world-class restaurants, but hotels in other categories also enjoy great popularity thanks to their consistently high quality. In addition, numerous fine restaurants crowned with Michelin stars (6 in all) and GaultMillau points (426 in all) serve a wealth of gastronomic treats to please every palate.

Stroll around St. Moritz's shops and you are guaranteed some happy surprises. Elegant designer boutiques, traditional sports suppliers, tempting souvenir and gift shops, and mouth-watering delicatessens all add to the wide variety of shopping on offer in this chic Alpine town. Turn into one of the small side alleys and you will find quaint shops where you can pick up genuine Engadin products – and perhaps make the odd lucky find to round off your shopping adventure.

The resort's glittering array of nightspots extends from the historic bars of the grand hotels to fashionable lounge bars, legendary clubs and a wealth of other venues – including the Casino St. Moritz at the Kempinski Grand Hotel des Bains.

## REBIRTH OF A CLASSIC

*Opening ceremony of the FIS Alpine World Ski Championships 2017  
in the Kulm Park St. Moritz with Edy*



As the World Ski Championships 2017 launched in St. Moritz, an iconic building reopened, more splendid than ever: the Kulm Country Club. This architectural gem in the grounds of the Kulm Hotel St. Moritz, built more than 110 years ago, served as the venue for the international event's medal ceremonies.

The ice pavilion stands as a memorial to the Winter Olympic Games of 1928 and 1948 in St. Moritz, and is a protected monument. Built in 1905 during the Belle Époque, this popular meeting place is now enchanting a new generation of guests following a renovation and extension project for which the Kulm Hotel St. Moritz managed to engage the leading British architect Lord Foster. Internationally renowned for his spectacular schemes in London, Berlin, California and elsewhere, he had already made a mark on St. Moritz with his futuristic Chesa Futura. For the Kulm Country Club project, Lord Foster worked with the local architect Arnd Küchel.



## Renovation with a focus on original features

The first floor of the building now houses a restaurant with terrace, which will also host a variety of temporary exhibitions on themes from the Olympic Games and sports to nature and culture. Wood plays a major role both externally and internally, and historical wooden features continue to dominate the overall effect following renovation. The local architect, Arnd Küchel, placed great importance on retaining original Art Nouveau elements and wooden décor. Where necessary, windows and doors were rebuilt in the original style, and even the historical wooden windows were painstakingly restored.

The grandstand of the ice pavilion, with its elegant wooden superstructure, is another eye-catching feature and, according to Arnd Küchel, a masterpiece of structural design. A smaller counterpart, the "sun pavilion", is attached to the Restaurant Chesa al Parc: a stylish setting in which to soak up the sun. Throughout, great attention was paid to preserving historical detail, as shown by another example: the entrance door, painted red. This is no eccentricity of the architect, but a reconstruction, true to the original.

## The living spirit of the Winter Olympics

Following renovation, the old heart of the complex – the entrance area, with its impressive staircase – once again radiates the same dynamic aura that delighted guests at the first Winter Olympics nearly 90 years ago. During the games of 1928 and also 1948, the Kulm Country Club served as headquarters for the figure skaters. For visitors to St. Moritz and locals, too, the ice rink soon became a popular meeting place. The careful renovation of the ice pavilion has preserved beautifully the unique combination of Art Nouveau and traditional local style, and today the restored building is as full of charm as ever.

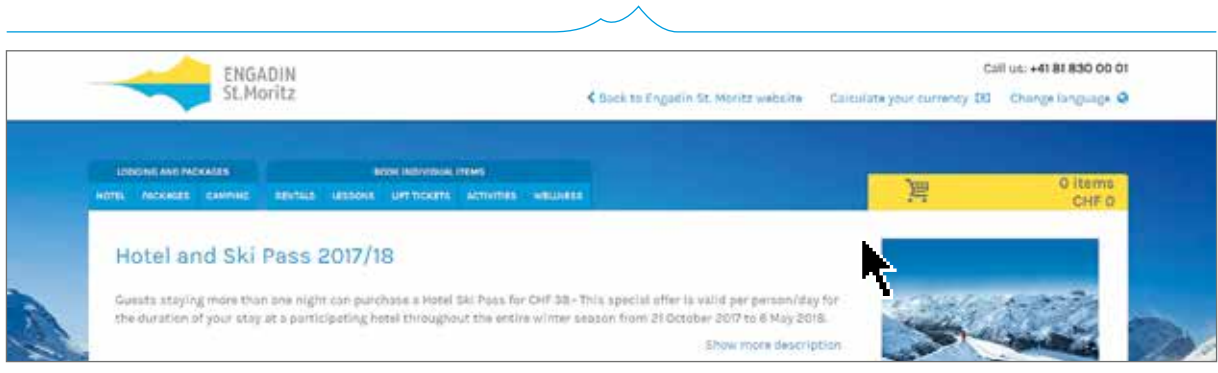

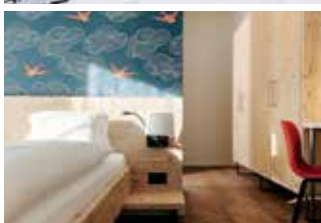

The attractive Engadin village also makes a peaceful base for exploring the region's various large ski areas, while from the doorstep a network of cross-country ski trails leads into the expansive valley of the Upper Engadin, down into the wild and romantic Lower Engadin, and around ZerneZ itself. Anyone seeking a very special experience of nature can book a guided snowshoe tour – for example up at the Ofen Pass. Livelier thrills, meanwhile, are on offer on the Munt Baselgia toboggan run, the artificial ice rink and the wonderful natural ice rink.

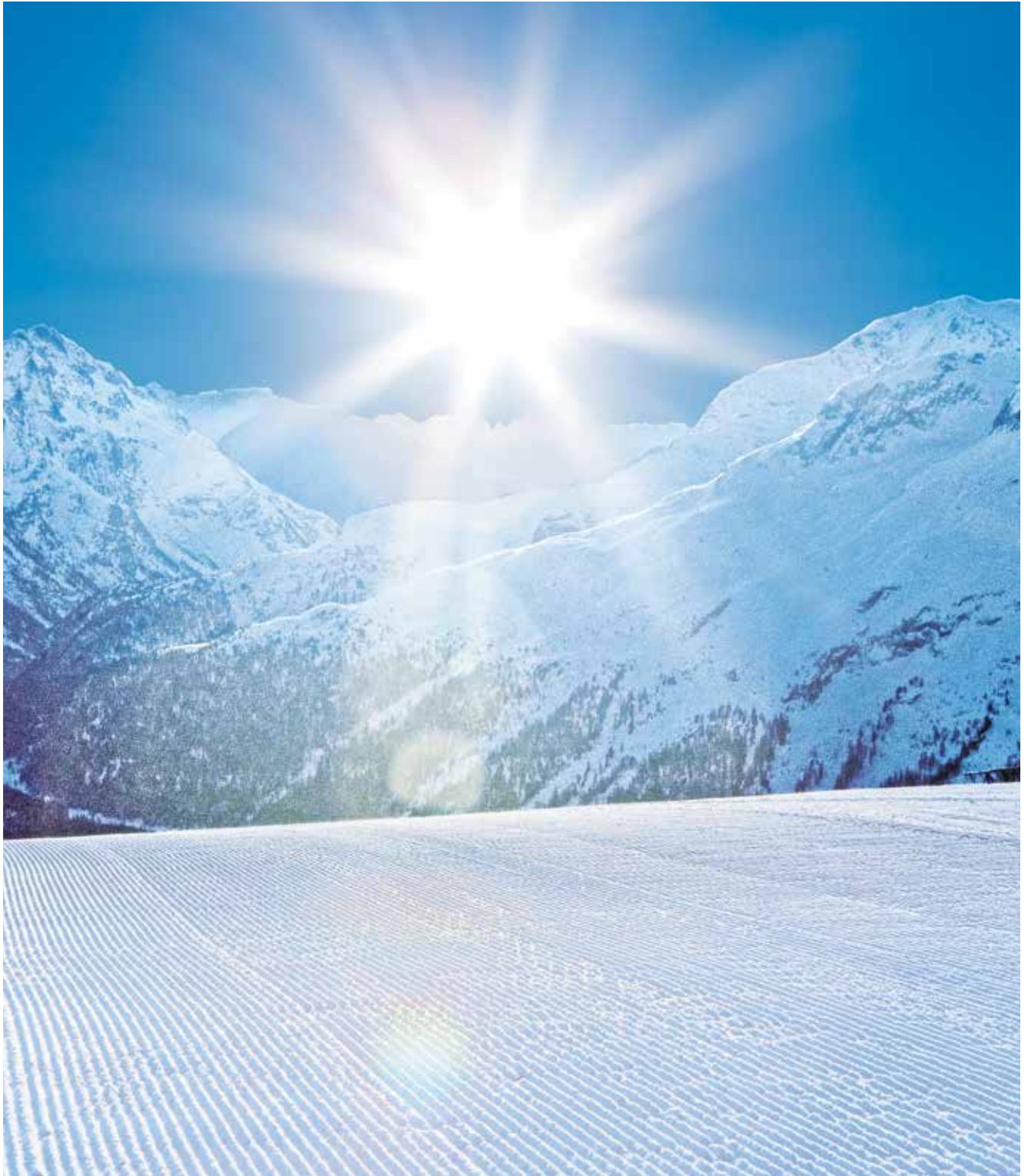

## Terms of contract and conditions of travel

This catalogue was compiled by the Engadin St. Moritz Tourism Organisation on behalf of the service providers – hotels, airlines, etc. – listed therein.

### 01

#### Scope of these terms of contract and conditions of travel

These terms of contract and conditions of travel govern the legal relationship between you and the service provider insofar as your contractual partner does not present terms and conditions at the time of booking. Unless expressly specified otherwise at the time of booking, your contract will be with the companies providing services, even if you place your booking through the Engadin St. Moritz Tourism Organisation. In such cases, the Engadin St. Moritz Tourism Organisation acts merely as an agent between you and the service provider; your contract is direct with the provider of the service booked.

### 02

#### Conclusion of contract and services provided

Your contract with the service provider becomes legally binding when the booking office unconditionally confirms your booking. If the same booking office arranges other services and packages for you that are not booked from a publication of the Engadin St. Moritz Tourism Organisation, these terms of contract and conditions of travel shall not apply. The services provided will be as specified in the booking confirmation and in the details provided of the service on offer. Unless stated otherwise in the product description, your activity will begin at the location specified in the contract.

### 03

#### Prices and terms of payment

All prices are quoted in Swiss francs and are to be paid in Swiss francs. Unless otherwise agreed in your booking or in the booking confirmation, the price of your trip shall be payable in full upon booking. If the price is not paid in full by the date due, your contractual partner shall be entitled to withhold services, to withdraw from the contract and to demand the cancellation costs listed in paragraph 05. Note that if you book your trip through a different booking office such as a travel agent, this booking office may make additional charges for advice, reservations, etc.

### 04

#### Price and programme changes

The service providers and the Engadin St. Moritz Tourism Organisation are entitled to change the details of services and prices before a contract is signed. You will be informed of this at the time of booking. After the contract has been signed, prices can be increased up to three weeks prior to the beginning of your trip if the transport or accommodation costs, the charges for certain services or the exchange rate have increased.

Changes to the programme and scope of services may also arise owing to unforeseen or unavoidable circumstances. Should any of the essential features of your trip change considerably and if you cannot be offered an appropriate alternative, you have the right to cancel your booking. In these circumstances, price increases of more than 10% count as a considerable change. Unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances may necessitate a change of programme even after your trip has commenced. Your service provider will endeavour to provide appropriate alternatives in such cases. The Engadin St. Moritz Tourism Organisation will not refund any services not delivered and accepts no liability for programme changes.

### 05

#### Changes or cancellations requested by you

If you wish to change your booking or to cancel your trip, you must notify the booking office directly. Any travel documents you have already received must be returned to the booking office at the same time. A service charge of CHF 60.– per person, max. CHF 120.– per order, will be levied for cancellations and changes (affecting names of travellers, dates, accommodation or additional services, etc.). If you cancel your trip or change your booking (name, date, accommodation, additional services, etc.) less than 31 days prior to departure, you will also be charged, in addition to any processing fee, for the following costs as a percentage of the total cost of your trip:

- 30 to 15 days before departure  
**30% of the package price**
- 14 to 8 days before departure  
**50% of the package price**
- 7 to 1 days before departure  
**80% of the package price**
- on the day of departure and in the event of no-show  
**100% of the package price**

The critical date is that on which the booking office receives notice of your intentions; if that is a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday, the next working day shall apply.

### 06

#### Late arrival or early departure of your own accord

You are responsible for arriving on time. Should you arrive late, you cannot claim a refund for any services you have missed owing to your late arrival. Should you depart early, your expenses will not be refunded.

### 07

#### Early departure or exclusion occasioned by the service provider

The service provider is entitled to end the service/trip prematurely in the event of unforeseen or unavoidable circumstances that would render fulfilment of contract impossible, considerably more difficult or dangerous for those taking part. If no alternative is possible, the service provider shall be exempted from its obligation to fulfil the contract. Your claim to a refund in such cases shall be limited to unjust enrichment. The service provider can exclude participants from the trip if their actions or omissions justify such a step. In such a case, the cost of the package shall still be due in full and there shall be no refund for services not received. Any claims for compensation are excluded.

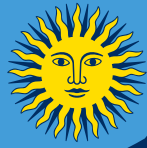

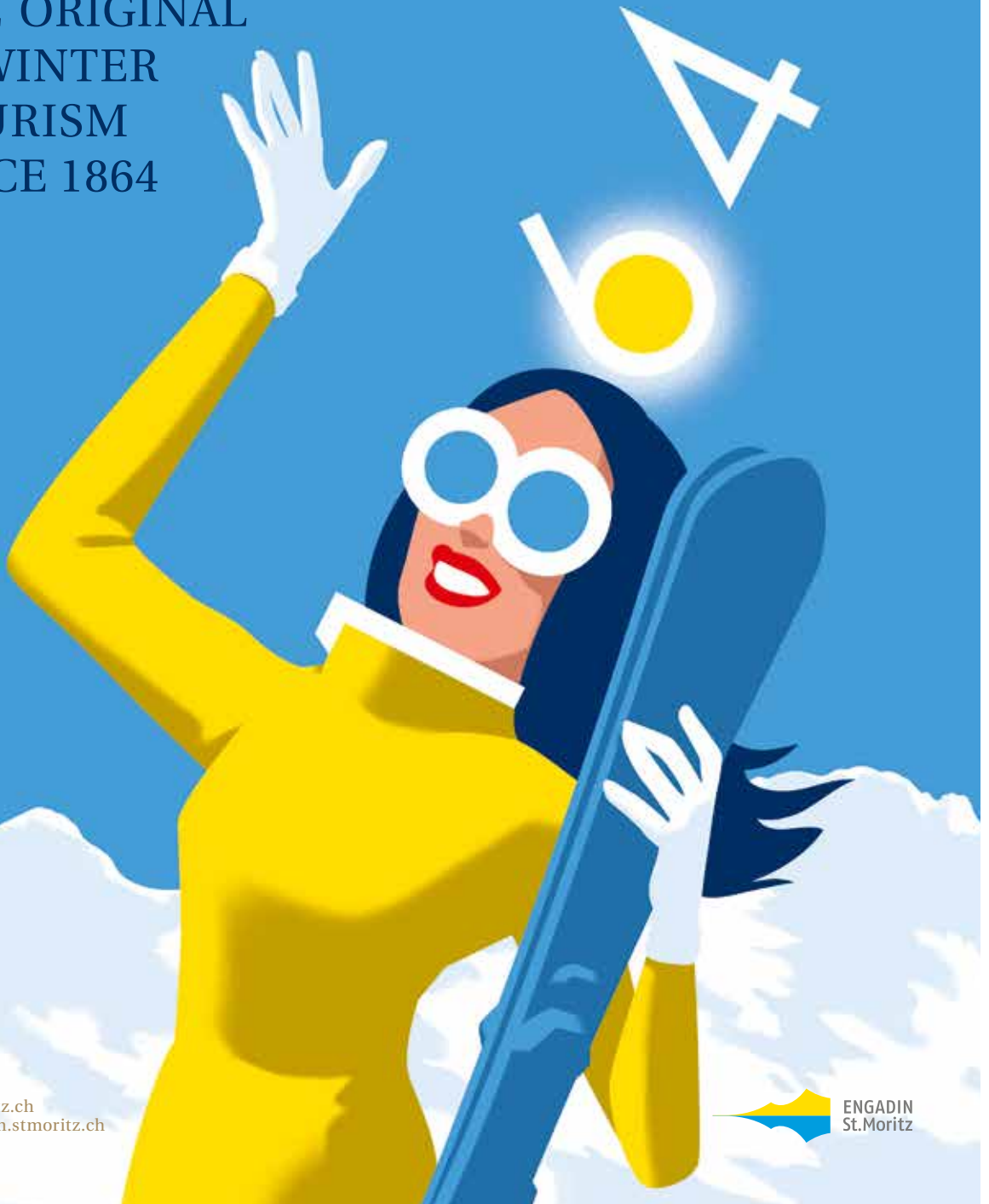




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
