Volunteers are the “eyes and ears” of Meals On Wheels, and we rely on our team of volunteers to make sure our recipients are fed and feel safe and secure.

Volunteers report possible risks and Meals On Wheels staff will alert the family or social worker so issues can be addressed before they become more serious.

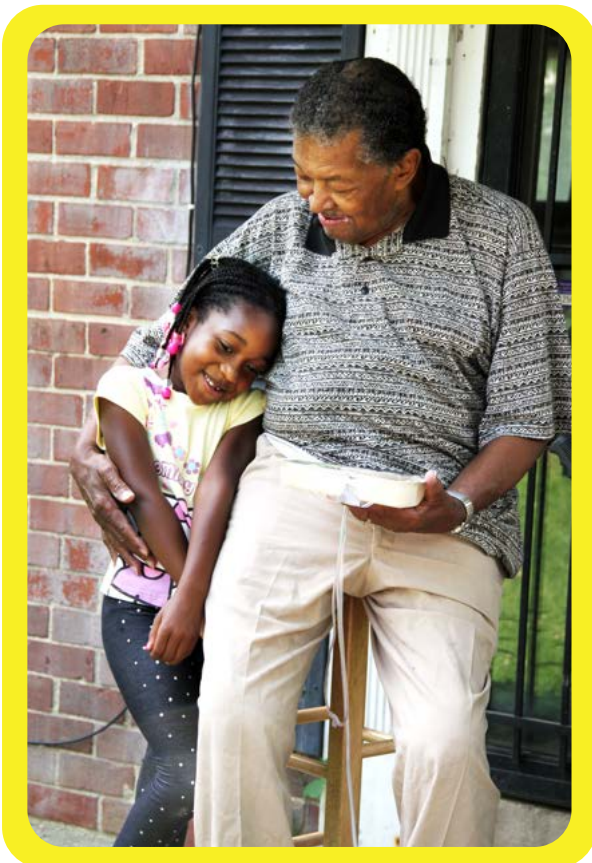

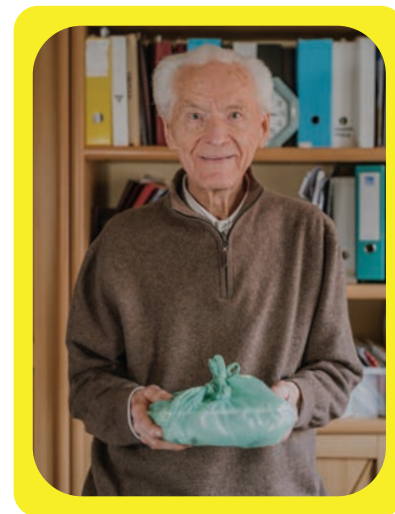

Thank you for your assistance and for your belief in this work! Every dollar you gave made an impact.



You give hope in difficult times, so homebound neighbors will not go hungry or feel alone.



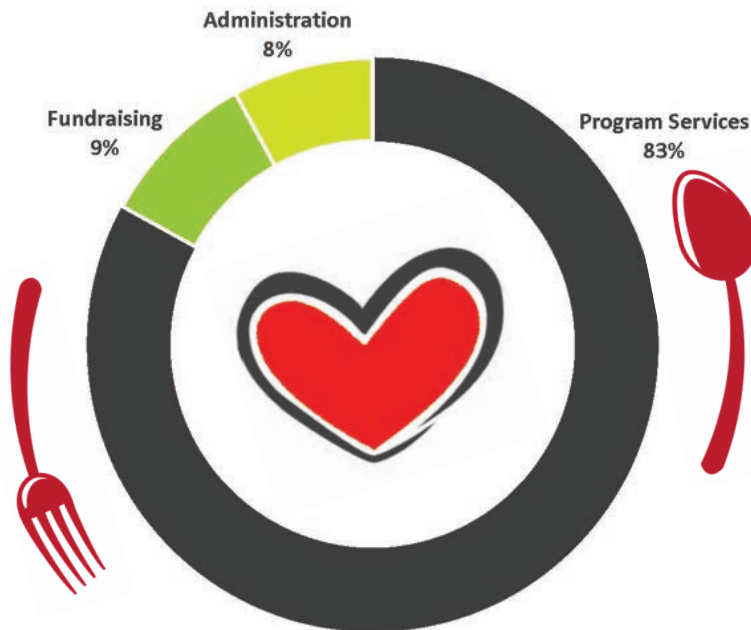
