## Middle School Reading:


- 100% of students passed English Language Arts course for the year.
- 94% of students made growth on their Reading MAP (Measure of Academic Progress) assessment.
- 87% of students exceeded their MAP growth target.

## **Middle School Mathematics:**

- 100% of students passed Math 7 for the year.
- 94% of students made growth on their grade 7 Mathematics MAP (Measure of Academic Progress) assessment.
- 81% of those students exceeded their MAP growth target.

5 Ws of Academic Coaching

**Who:** Students who show a Language Arts or Math need for additional assistance

**What:** Receive specialized instruction by a highly qualified academic coach

**When**: Each quarter, students are phased out, remain in, or enter academic coaching

**Where:** Students receive intervention in a designated classroom specifically for academic coaching

**How:** Students are assigned to academic coaching after reviewing student grades, standardized test scores and teacher reference
