Supplemental Instruction

- □ SI is a peer-led student academic enrichment program that offers free, weekly, outside of class organized group study sessions for select historically difficult courses.
- Led by SI Leaders who nominated for their leadership ability and content mastery.

Testing Services

- Administers challenge exams, provides faculty make-up exams, proctoring services, and standardized tests and serves as an information resource for many other exams.
- All exams are by appointment only.





Tutoring Services

- Offers individualized tutoring in more than 40 subject areas.
- ☐ Offers one on one sessions 45 minute sessions that is focused and centralized on the student's needs.
- Students should come to tutoring sessions with all necessary materials, and be prepared to ask specific questions.





Academic Success Coaching

- Designed to help give you the edge in the classroom and beyond.
- ☐ Students meet with a staff member who will tailor the meeting to their specific academic needs, aspirations, and goals.
- Success Coaches help students with any of the following: time management, goal setting, study skills, reading comprehension, and academic planning.




Who is CAPS?


