As we get this new school year started we want to let our families know that wearing a mask in our facility will continue until further notice. If you have any question please feel free to ask or speak with Ms Mel.



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#### Dolphins (4 &5's ) Classroom Updates

Hello Dolphin families, We are coming to the end of summer camp ventures. Wednesday the 11th is the last day for summer camp. We are concluding our summer camp with the theme " Dream Vacations" For the first week, children will create their own passport, use their creative and imaginative minds to plan their vacation, travel to Mexico and make their own tostada and also paper planes. We will also have a Luau party. For the other half of our Dream Vacation theme, children will imagine a vacation on space, taste test space food and make a volcano. For character essentials, we will talk about "We Are Strong" and dive in depth and talk about and do a role playing scenario on Confidence, persistence, assertiveness and bravery. We will begin the week by talking about confidence. What it means to be confident, what is something you're great at doing? Children will be given an opportunity to be teacher's helpers so that they feel confident. One of the important rules in our classroom is: Ms. Marina doesn't like to hear "I can't do it." Instead, be confident and say, "I can't do it yet, but I will try." Also, it's okay to make mistakes, we learn from mistakes. When I reiterate this to the children, they always have a big smile on their faces and I see the confident little children giving it a try. It's important to make them understand that as long as they're confident about themselves and don't give up, that matters the most. At home you could give your child opportunities to show confidence, like: dress themselves, pack their back pack for school, ask them what your child is learning at school.

First day of our school year 2021/2022 is Monday the 16th of August. The next few days, we will be saying good bye to our friends who are going to Kindergarten. We wish you all the best in Kindergarten my dear Dolphin graduates. I am very proud of each and everyone of you. Hopefully it won't be too hot and you can make it.

Our letters will be the alphabet. We will learn some ABC songs and games. Some sign language as well. Numbers 1-20 in English and in Spanish.

Our Character Education value is: We Are Strong! We will focus on confidence, persistence, assertiveness, and bravery.

Please remember we are a nut free facility. No nut products including Honey Nut Cheerios and almond milk. Water cups are okay. No baby bottles or sippy cups. But a hydro flask type of cup or water-cup with the flip top is fine. ONLY water, please. Please don't send pull-ups or diapers that do not come a part on the sides. No slip ons. I spend 90% of the day by myself and having to undress the children to change a diaper is very time consuming and I need to be able to change the children and watch the children at the same time. I appreciate your understanding and I do apologize if this is inconvenient. Please be sure to send a sheet a blanket EVERY week. Bedding is taken home and washed at the end of every week. Bedding is a licensing requirement and we are not allowed to loan out bedding anymore. New guidelines. No large pillows or stuffed animals or blankets due to storage space. It's best to send bedding in a backpack or a reusable shopping bag. Also with the school year beginning we would appreciate the following donations: wipes, gloves, hand sanitizers, balls, nature/garden magazines, playdough and school supplies. Thank you in advance.
