ACC NOTEBOOK

2018 Regular Season

- Ten different ACC teams have been ranked this year, including seven that made appearances in the top 10.
- This week, all six league teams in the tournament are ranked, including four that hold spots in the top 10.
- The ACC finished the regular season with a 226-101(.691) record against nonconference competition, including 15 wins against teams ranked in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
- ACC players earned NCBWA National Player or Pitcher of the Month honors three times this season.

ACC Athletic Success

- The ACC is the only conference to win National Championships in football, men's basketball, women's basketball and baseball over the last four years.
- The ACC has won four combined football and MBB national titles over the last five years, twice as many as any other conference.
- This academic year, the ACC led all conferences with 10 bowl teams, nine NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament teams and eight NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament teams.

ACC Academic Success

- The ACC's member institutions continue to lead our peer conferences by any academic measure – US News & World Report, GSR, APR, etc.
- The ACC leads the way among Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) conferences in the "Best Colleges" rankings released by U.S. News & World Report. The ACC placed eight institutions among the 50 – three more than any peer conference. With an average rank of 54.2, the ACC has led the FBS conferences in each of the last 11 years.

ACC Coaches

- Florida State's win over Clemson in May was the 1,976th career victory for Mike Martin, passing the late Augie Garrido for the most wins in NCAA history.
- Five current ACC coaches have at least 1,000 career victories, while 10 skippers have reached the 500-win milestone. No other conference has more than two 1,000-win coaches.
- The five winningest coaches by percentage in the nation are in the ACC: No. 1 Mike Martin (Florida State), No. 2 Mike

Fox (North Carolina), No. 3 Brian O'Connor (Virginia), No. 4 Dan McDonnell (Louisville), and No. 5 Jim Morris (Miami). With the addition of No. 10 Monte Lee (Clemson), the ACC has six of the top 10 winningest coaches. No other conference has more than one coach in the top 10 spots.

NCAA Tournament

- The ACC has had at least six teams in the tournament for 15 consecutive years.
- Florida State is making its 41st straight appearance in the tournament, the longest active streak in the country.
- The 55 all-time appearances by the Seminoles are the second most nationally, and Clemson is fifth with 43.
- At least two league teams have earned national seeds for nine consecutive years.

Super Regionals

- Four ACC teams have advanced to the Super Regionals in eight of the last 13 years.

College World Series

- Florida State advanced to the College World Series last year for the 22nd time in program history and 16th under Coach Mike Martin.
- Louisville made its fourth College World Series appearance last year and third in the last five seasons.
- Over the last 12 years, the ACC has made 23 appearances in the College World Series, or 24 percent of the cumulative field.
- The 14 current ACC programs have a combined 93 College World Series appearances.
- At least two ACC teams have reached the College World Series in eight of the last 12 years, and at least one ACC team has advanced to the College World Series in 12 straight years.

Major League Baseball Draft

- The 75 ACC players selected in the 2017 MLB Draft were tied for the most from any conference and topped the previous ACC record of 65 in 2014.
- Six ACC players were picked in the first round and first competitive balance round, extending a streak of 26 straight years with at least one first round pick from the conference.
- All 14 ACC programs had at least one player drafted.




